Playoff Notes

The Southern Conference has the most wins (96) and highest winning percentage (.623) in the postseason among all FCS conferences.

Southern Conference teams are 43-21 (.642) in the round of 16.

All nine Southern Conference programs have appeared in the FCS playoffs.

Appalachian State is making its 20th appearance in the playoffs. The Mountaineers are 24-16 in the playoffs and have won three national titles.

Georgia Southern earned its 19th postseason berth. The Eagles are 43-12 in the playoffs and have won six national championships.

Wofford is making its sixth postseason appearance. The Terriers have earned five playoff berths in the last six years.

Quick Hits

- Appalachian State, Georgia Southern and Wofford earned a share of the SoCon Championship. The last time three teams tied for the league title was 1999.
- Georgia Southern earned the league's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs by winning a tiebreaker. Appalachian State and Wofford earned at-large selections to the postseason.
- Home teams were 19-17 in league games this season after going just 18-18 in 2011.
- Southern Conference teams are 10-2 against FCS nonconference opponents.

RANKINGS: Three Southern Conference teams are ranked in both major FCS Polls at the end of the regular season. Georgia Southern is ranked sixth by the FCS Coaches and seventh by the Sports Network. Appalachian State is seventh according to the coaches and sixth in the Sports Network poll. Wofford is ranked No. 9 by both the coaches and the Sports Network.

THROUGH THE AIR: The Southern Conference has had at least one wide receiver rank in the top five nationally for receiving yards per game in each of the last six seasons.

- Elon's Aaron Mellette led the league and ranks second nationally with 127 receiving yards per game.
- Appalachian State's Sean Price ranks sixth nationally with 114 receiving yards per contest.

ON THE GROUND: A Southern Conference team has led the nation in rushing in eight of the last 11 years.

- The Citadel, Georgia Southern and Wofford all rank in the top five of FCS for rushing yards per game.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 958, ranking sixth nationally and third among FCS conferences. It was the fourth consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- Ten Southern Conference's sports (football, men's basketball, men's indoor track & field, men's outdoor track & field, women's basketball, women's cross country, women's indoor track & field, women's outdoor track & field, women's tennis and volleyball) ranked among the top 10 of Division I for their four-year average.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores in October. Five of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for FCS programs.

EXPERIENCED COACHES: Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 339 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 215 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers (124) is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade.
