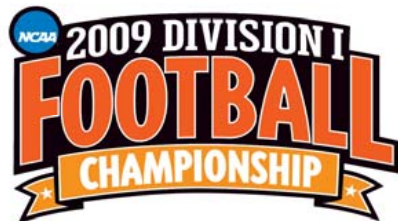

Last Game

Nov. 28 - No. 5 Appalachian State 20, No. 7 S.C. State 13

Dominique McDuffie's 50-yard fumble return for a touchdown midway through the fourth quarter proved to be the difference in No. 5 ASU's 20-13 playoff win. The decisive score was indicative of the somewhat sloppy ballgame, as the teams combined to commit 10 turnovers (each with a season-high five) that led directly to 17 of the game's 33 points.

Nov. 21 - No. 4 Richmond 16, No. 9 Elon 13

Senior QB Eric Ward racked up 276 yards of total offense but No. 4 Richmond needed to dodge a pair of missed field goals by No. 9 Elon in the final 90 seconds and held on to win 16-13. Ward had a career-best 136 yards rushing, including a 74-yard TD run in the second quarter.

Game Notes

The game is a rematch of the last four Division I football national championships and marks the third straight year that the Mountaineers and Spiders will meet in the playoffs ... A key matchup pits ASU's rushing offense which ranks 10th nationally (209.8 ypg) against Richmond third-ranked rushing defense (66.6 ypg).

SOCON News and Notes

ALL NINE HAVE POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: With Elon earning its first-ever invite to the NCAA Division I Football Championship playoffs in 2009, all nine of the current football-playing institutions in the Southern Conference have now reached the postseason at least once. This makes the SoCon the only conference to have 100-percent playoff participation among its current members.

TITLE GAME IS LATEST IN SOCON HISTORY: The Nov. 21 Southern Conference showdown between No. 6 Elon and No. 7 Appalachian State, both 6-0, featured just the second meeting of 6-0 SoCon teams since the league reclassified to the Football Championship Subdivision in 1982. On Nov. 6, 1996, eventual national champions Marshall (9-0, 6-0), led by freshman sensation Randy Moss, defeated East Tennessee State (8-1, 6-0), 34-10, in the Mini Dome in Johnson City, Tenn., to secure the SoCon title en route a 15-0 season.

Appalachian State's 27-10 win gave the Mountaineers their fifth consecutive SoCon conference championship and 10th overall. It also clinched the SoCon's automatic bid to the NCAA championship.

WELCOME BACK, DEFENSE: After the past two seasons in which SoCon offenses lit up the scoreboard, defense made a comeback across the league in 2009. In conference games, scoring was down approximately 5 points per game from a year ago and an astounding 20.9 points per game from 2007.

While scoring 30 points only resulted in a win 65 percent of the time in 2007, teams were 19-1 (.950) when scoring 30 or more points this season. In addition, after recording a 1-24 record (.040) in 2007-08 when scoring fewer than 20 points, SoCon teams were 6-18 (.250) this season when held under 20.

HUDGINS, ROBERTS REWRITING RECORD BOOKS: Elon's Terrell Hudgins and The Citadel's Andre Roberts, both seniors, have ended their careers as the top two receivers in Southern Conference history.

Hudgins holds the career records for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns. On Saturday, Oct. 3, Hudgins became the NCAA Division I (FCS and FBS) career leader in receptions, and on Nov. 7, he topped Hall of Famer Jerry Rice's career receiving yards total, pushing the mark to 5,250 yards.

APPALACHIAN BUILDS SOCON WIN STREAK: With another perfect 8-0 mark in the SoCon in 2009, Appalachian State currently boasts a 20-game conference win streak. The Mountaineers' run is the longest streak of its kind in school history and is tied for the second-longest win streak in league history. The streak is the longest SoCon win streak in the past 50 seasons.

West Virginia holds the record with 30-straight SoCon wins from 1952-59.

EDWARDS, RIDDLE RANK AS TOP SOCON QBS IN LEAGUE HISTORY: Appalachian State quarterback Armanti Edwards' 415-yard passing effort against Wofford on Oct. 17 vaulted him to the top of the SoCon's all-time passing list, and he now boasts 9,823 yards.

Edwards was then overtaken by Elon quarterback Scott Riddle, who had previously broken the record of ETSU's Greg Ryan on Sept. 26. Riddle has amassed 10,033 passing yards and holds the league's all-time passing records in completions (894) and passing touchdowns (78). Edwards is five TDs behind at 73.

Riddle also set a new SoCon standard earlier this season for pass attempts without an interception, tossing 218 straight passes without a pick prior to a second half interception against Georgia Southern on Sept. 26.

EDWARDS A DUAL THREAT: In addition to his exploits as a passer, Armanti Edwards also ranks as one of the greatest rushing quarterbacks of all time. Already the SoCon's career leader in total offense with 14,289 yards, Edwards recently moved into the eighth spot in the SoCon in career rushing with 4,256 yards.

The southpaw is currently fourth on the NCAA Division I FCS all-time chart for total offense, sitting 326 yards behind third place Ricky Santos of New Hampshire. Former Alcorn State and NFL legend Steve McNair is the all-time leader in total offense with 16,823 yards.

Edwards was the second straight SoCon QB to win the award, following Jayson Foster (Georgia Southern) in 2007. In total, five SoCon student-athletes have been honored with the award. A senior, Edwards is aiming to become the first player in the award's history to win it twice.

Elon's Terrell Hudgins, Samford's Chris Evans and The Citadel's Andre Roberts were also named the preseason watch list for the 2009 Walter Payton Award.

FACILITIES IMPROVE THROUGHOUT THE CONFERENCE: Both Kidd Brewer Stadium at Appalachian State and Seibert Stadium at Samford will look different to visitors this season as each stadium received significant upgrades during the offseason.

At ASU, a seven story, 120,000-square foot building behind the west stands at Kidd Brewer Stadium was officially opened this month. The facility is a part of ASU's \$50 million facilities enhancement campaign, which also included an indoor practice facility, baseball, softball and soccer stadiums. It provides office space in addition to locker rooms, club seating and a new press box.

Samford's home opener on Sept. 12 showcased the newly-constructed Cooney Family Field House, a \$7.5 million, 39,000 square-foot structure in the south end zone of Seibert Stadium.

Elsewhere around the league, Furman installed a new scoreboard with video replay capabilities and Wofford opened a new building adjacent to Gibbs Stadium that houses a new weight room and coaches offices.

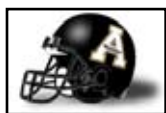
On Saturday, Nov. 14, Elon broke ground on a 30,000-square-foot field house that is scheduled to be completed by December 2010. The Alumni Field House will include a large team meeting room and locker room for football; a conference room; an advanced athletic training room, including a hydrotherapy area; a large strength and conditioning room; and space for student athletes to study. The building will also house athletics offices.

This Date in SOCON History

Dec. 5, 1987

Richie Melchor rushed for 156 yards and two touchdowns, and the Appalachian State defense shut down the high-powered Georgia Southern rushing attack as ASU eliminated the two-time defending national champions from the I-AA playoffs with a 19-0 win in frigid conditions in Boone.

Dec. 5, 1992

The Citadel's dream season came to an end as the top-ranked Bulldogs were ousted from the I-AA playoffs by Youngstown State, 42-17, in Charleston. The Penguins broke open a close game by scoring three touchdowns in the fourth quarter.

Dec. 5, 1998

Appalachian State's season came to an end as the seventh-seeded Mountaineers fell at No. 2 seed Northwestern State, 31-20, in the quarterfinals of the I-AA playoffs.

Top-ranked Georgia Southern set a new I-AA playoff record with 530 yards rushing in a 52-30 quarterfinal win over Connecticut in Statesboro. Freshman sensation Adrian Peterson rushed for 232 yards and four touchdowns.
