### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Andrew Goudelock - CofC

Goudelock averaged 23.0 points, 6.0 assists and 4.0 rebounds as the Cougars defeated Elon (85-67) and UNCG (87-69) last week.

Goudelock opened the week with a career-high 34 points as the Cougars knocked off the Phoenix. The Stone Mountain, Ga., native finished 8-of-12 from beyond the arc against Elon. Goudelock chipped in 12 points and recorded a game-high eight assists and five steals against the Spartans.

The senior is currently on a 12-game double-digit scoring streak and continues to lead the Southern Conference and rank among the top five nationally in points per game (5th, 23.7 ppg) and made three-pointers (3rd, 3.4 3fg).

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Donald Simms, The Citadel's Cameron Wells, Davidson's Brendan McKillop, Furman's Darryl Evans, Georgia Southern's Ben Drayton III, Chattanooga's Ricky Taylor, Western Carolina's Trey Sumler and Wofford's Jamar Diggs.

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- In Thursday's win, Donald Sims scored 20 points to lead the Mountaineers and reach 500 points for the second season in a row. ASU players have scored 500 points just 18 times and Sims is only the fourth player to repeat. Omar Carter is just 86 points away from the milestone after scoring 22 on Saturday. Two ASU teammates have never accomplished the scoring feat in the same season.
- ASU looks for its 100th victory in the Holmes Center on Thursday when Western Carolina visits. The squad is 7-2 at home on the season and 21-6 at the arena dating back to the start of last season.

## ELON PHOENIX



- With nine points against College of Charleston last week, Drew Spradlin topped the 900 career point mark and now has 926 points for his career. Spradlin is 10th in the conference in scoring with 14.3 points per game. He ranks eighth in the league with 1.8 made three-pointers per game.
- Elon leads the Southern Conference and ranks 11th nationally with 9.1 made three-pointers per game. Freshman guard Jack Isenbarger leads the team and is fifth in the league with 2.1 made triples per contest.
- The Phoenix host UNCG Saturday night.

## UNCG SPARTANS



- UNCG has increased its scoring output in league games during the season. The Spartans are averaging 71.5 points per game this year, but have tallied 77.0 points per contest in Southern Conference games.
- The Spartans have four players averaging double figures. Trevis Simpson leads the team with 10.9 points per game while Kyle Randall has scored 10.4 points per contest. Brandon Evans has tallied 10.3 points per game and Aloysius Henry averages 10.1 points per outing.
- The Spartans visit Elon Saturday night.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- The Bulldogs have made at least one 3-point field goal in 590-consecutive games. The last time that Samford did not make a 3-point basket was Jan. 19, 1991, against Texas-San Antonio.
- Samford's Jeffrey Merritt heads into this week's games with a total of 173 rebounds. The Bulldogs' junior guard from Oklahoma City, Okla., is averaging 6.7 rebounds per contest and has already surpassed Samford's single-season totals dating all the way back to the 2000-01 campaign when former Bulldog-great Marc Salyers pulled down 180 rebounds (6.2 rpg).
- The Bulldogs host Wofford Wednesday night.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Keegan Bell has already surpassed his season assist total from last season (159) with 165 entering Wednesday's contest at Georgia Tech and is No. 5 in the school's DI era. He is nine shy of Tyrone Enoch's 174 in 1990-91 in fourth. He is already 5th on the career list with 324, 16 shy of No. 4 Maurice Head's (1984-87) 340.
- The Mocs lost their first game when giving up less than 70 points, 69 at Western Carolina last Friday, and when leading at the half at Appalachian State. UTC is now 11-1 in both cases.
- Chattanooga visits Georgia Tech Wednesday night.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- WCU remained perfect at home this season, improving to 9-0 in the Ramsey Center with wins over Chattanooga and Samford last weekend. The Catamounts have won 36 of their last 41 home games including 25 of the last 28 Southern Conference games in Cullowhee.
- The Catamounts travel to third-place Appalachian State on Thursday. WCU has dropped six-straight to ASU in Boone and will be looking for its first regular season series sweep since 2004.
- After visiting ASU, the Catamounts will host Eastern Kentucky in a BracketBuster matchup Saturday afternoon.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars are one win shy of recording their third consecutive and fourth 20-win season under Bobby Cremins. The Cougars need two more victories in league play to clinch the South Division's top seed in the conference tournament.
- Andrew Goudelock is on a 12-game double-digit scoring streak and is now tied for seventh all-time in career scoring in the SoCon record books. He surpassed ninth-place Jonathan Moore of Furman (2,299) and eighth-place Jerry West of West Virginia (2,309) and is tied with Dom Flora of Washington & Lee (2,310) on the league's all-time scoring list.
- College of Charleston visits The Citadel Thursday.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Senior guard Zach Urbanus scored a team-high 17 points against Savannah State on Monday to climb to 10th on The Citadel's all-time scoring list, passing former teammate Demetrius Nelson.
- Cameron Wells dished out 10 assists Saturday against Elon to become The Citadel's all-time assist leader and is just the second player among the 12 Southern Conference schools to represent his school as both the all-time leading scorer and all-time assist leader (Henry Logan - Western Carolina).
- The Citadel hosts College of Charleston Thursday.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Brendan McKillop has moved into fourth on Davidson's career 3-pointers made list, 24 behind older brother and current assistant coach Matt McKillop. The senior has made 199 triples. He is third in the Southern Conference with 2.7 made three-pointers per game and has made 36 percent of his attempts from beyond the arc this season.
- Bob McKillop needs four victories to reach 400 for his career. He coached his 1,000th career game at Wofford Wednesday (656 at Davidson, 344 as a high school head coach).
- Davidson returns home to face Georgia Southern Wednesday night. The Wildcats will travel to Presbyterian Saturday night.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Furman has limited its opponents to 65 points or less in seven of its last ten games. The Paladins lead the Southern Conference in scoring defense as they have allowed just 64.2 points per contest this year.
- Furman's victory over Davidson ended an 11-game skid against the Wildcats. The Paladins' 19 wins are the most by a Furman team since posting a 20-9 record during the 1990-91 campaign. Furman's next win will give the Paladins 20 victories for the ninth time in school history.
- Furman visits Samford February 19.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Junior Ben Drayton III scored a career-high 31 points against Wofford on Saturday. It was the highest single-game total since Antonio Hanson scored 39 last year against Elon. Drayton's 31-point performance was the 57th 30-point scoring night at GSU and the 33rd since 1972.
- Drayton narrowly missed a triple-double against Furman with nine points, nine rebounds and nine assists. His rebounding and assist totals against the Paladins are season highs while the nine points snapped a string of 14-straight games with at least 10 points.
- Georgia Southern travels to Davidson Wednesday night.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Wofford has clinched a winning record in league play for the third season in a row. The Terriers are 5-4 against teams from the South Division and a perfect 6-0 against competition from the North Division.
- The Terriers have used just three different starting line-ups this season in the 26 games and only seven players have started a game. Seniors Noah Dahlman and Cameron Rundles have started every game this season for Wofford.
- The Terriers travel to Samford Wednesday night.

### RECORD WATCH

Many of the impressive accomplishments from this season have placed Southern Conference teams in the league's record book.

- Samford knocked down 18 three-pointers against Auburn (Nov. 19) and UT-San Antonio (Dec. 21), which tied for the sixth-highest single-game output in league history.
- UNCG made 17 triples at Chattanooga January 27. The Spartans' 43 attempts from three-point range was the sixth highest single-game mark in league history.
- Chattanooga grabbed 60 rebounds against Reinhardt (Dec. 21). It was the sixth-highest single game rebound total in the SoCon's 90-year history.
- Western Carolina recorded 18 steals against Warren Wilson (Nov. 22), which tied for the tenth-highest steals total in the Southern Conference.
- The Mocs attempted 53 free throws against UNCG on January 27 which ranked as the tenth-highest total in the SoCon.
- Wofford's Noah Dahlman became just the ninth player in SoCon history to be perfect from the floor with at least 10 field goal attempts. Dahlman was 10-for-10 from the field against Georgia Southern on January 12.
- College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock has made 821 career field goals, the tenth-highest total in league history. He needs 23 field goals to pass West Virginia's Jerry West (1958-60) for ninth place.

### MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

### HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in league history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

## SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2011 marks the 91st year of the post-season classic.

- Western Carolina earned a berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Catamounts fell to former SoCon member Marshall, 90-88 in Huntington, W.Va.
- Appalachian State defeated Harvard (93-71) and Marshall (80-72) in the CIT but dropped a 64-56 decision to Pacific in the semifinal.
- After defeating Eastern Kentucky (82-79) in the first round of the College Basketball Invitational, College of Charleston fell at VCU (93-86) in the second round.
