## Quick Hits

- All nine Southern Conference teams will be on the field October 22. Georgia Southern hosts Presbyterian in the lone non-conference game this weekend.
- Visiting teams have won 9 of 18 league games in 2011.
- Samford's Fabian Truss leads the nation in all-purpose yardage (209.2 ypg).
- Furman's Kadarron Anderson is ninth in the country in tackles per game (11.3 tpg).
- Southern Conference teams are 9-1 against FCS non-conference opponents.

**AWARD CANDIDATES:** The Southern Conference boasts three candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List and four on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List. The Payton Award is presented annually to the most outstanding player at the FCS level, while the Buchanan honors the nation's top defensive player in FCS. Western Carolina's Shaun Warren was named to the Jerry Rice Award Watch List. The Rice Award will be given to the nation's best FCS freshman.

- Payton Award Candidates - Eric Breitenstein (Wofford), B.J. Coleman (Chattanooga) and DeAndre Presley (Appalachian State).
- Buchanan Award Candidates - Kadarron Anderson (Furman), Ameet Pall (Wofford), Brent Russell (Georgia Southern) and Ryan Steed (Furman).

**RANKINGS:** Three Southern Conference teams are ranked this week in both major FCS Polls. Georgia Southern is ranked No. 1 in both polls, while Wofford is ranked fourth by the coaches and fifth in the Sports Network Poll. Appalachian State is ranked sixth in both polls.

**THROUGH THE AIR:** Elon's Aaron Mellette ranks third nationally with 141.4 receiving yards per game.

- The Southern Conference has had at least one wide receiver rank in the top five nationally for receiving yards per game in each of the last five seasons.

**ON THE GROUND:** Georgia Southern owns the nation's best rushing attack with 373 yards per game.

- A Southern Conference team has led the nation in rushing in seven of the last ten years.

**DEFENSIVE ROTATION:** Wofford owns the top defensive unit in the conference as the Terriers rank third in the nation for total defense. Wofford has given up just 279 yards per game this season.

- Wofford led the league in total defense last season, marking the eighth straight season a different school led the SoCon in total defense. Chattanooga is the only team that has not led the league in total defense, dating back to 2003.

**PLAYOFF POWER:** Georgia Southern reached the semifinals of the FCS Playoffs in 2010 for the first time since 2002 when the Eagles fell to Western Kentucky 31-28, in Statesboro, Ga. The Southern Conference has had at least one team reach the semifinals 11 times in the last 13 years.

- The SoCon placed three teams in the quarterfinals last year. The league also had three teams in the quarterfinals in 2001, 1995 and 1996.

**APPALACHIAN JOINS SOCON RECORD BOOKS:** Appalachian State finished 7-1 in the Southern Conference in 2010 to win a share of the Southern Conference title for the sixth consecutive season. The Mountaineers are now just the second SoCon team to win six league titles in a row.

**ALL NINE HAVE POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** All nine of the current football-playing institutions in the Southern Conference have now reached the postseason at least once. The SoCon is the only conference to have 100 percent playoff participation among its current members.

**MAKING THE GRADE:** In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 954, ten points higher than the national average of 944 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference’s overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores last October. Seven of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (64 percent) for FCS programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

**CAUGHT IN THE DRAFT:** The Southern Conference had five players taken in the 2011 NFL Draft in April. The five draftees were the most taken in the draft since 1992 when five SoCon student-athletes were also selected.

- Defensive Back Cortez Allen of The Citadel was the first SoCon player taken off the board when he was chosen 128th overall (4th round) by the Pittsburgh Steelers.
- Chattanooga’s Buster Skrine (DB) was selected in the fifth round (#137 overall) by the Cleveland Browns.
- Appalachian State had a trio of players taken. Defensive Back Mark LeGree was selected in the fifth round by Seattle (#156) while offensive lineman Daniel Kilgore was taken with pick #163 by San Francisco. Linebacker D.J. Smith was chosen by the Green Bay Packers in the sixth round (#186).

**SoCon Sports Network:** This summer the conference office announced a three-year partnership with Public Television to carry Southern Conference football games. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon football games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry Southern Conference football games. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced this fall for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3.com, the Southern Conference website, as well as the respective public television websites.
