POLL POSITION: Appalachian State is ranked No. 3 in both the FCS Coaches Poll and the Sports Network Poll. The Mountaineers held the No. 1 ranking in the coaches poll for the eighth consecutive week before falling at GSU last week.

- Wofford is ranked No. 4 by both the FCS coaches and the Sports Network.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 952, eight points higher than the national average of 944 for Division I football programs. It was the second consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27. Seven of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (64 percent) for FCS programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

AWARD FINALISTS: The Sports Network released the watch list for the Walter Payton Award and Buck Buchanan Award on October 25. The two annual awards recognize the FCS top offensive and defensive players, respectively. The Southern Conference was heavily represented on both lists.

HELMET DECAL: Throughout the 2010 season, Southern Conference football teams will show their support for those being negatively impacted along the Gulf Coast by wearing helmet decals with the initials GC.

More than 160 SoCon football players come from states that share a coastline being affected by the oil spill. The nine institutions that play SoCon football agreed to display the decals to express their support and encouragement for the people living in the region.

Use of the decal was approved by the NCAA's rules committee and supervisory officiating organization upon request by the conference.



ELITE COMPANY: Elon quarterback Scott Riddle has led the conference in passing yards each of the past three seasons. If Riddle leads the SoCon again in 2010, he will become the first player in league history to lead the conference in passing yards for four consecutive seasons. Marshall's Michael Payton (1990-92) is the only other player to lead the conference in passing three straight years.

- Samford's Chris Evans has led the league in rushing the past two years. He has a chance to join Furman's Stanford Jennings (1981-83) and VMI's Thomas Haskins (1994-96) as the only players in SoCon history to lead the league in rushing three straight seasons.

PASSING FANCY: Elon's Scott Riddle became the Southern Conference's all-time leading passer with 244 yards through the air against Shaw University on September 11. Riddle now has 12,501 career passing yards, surpassing Armanti Edwards' (Appalachian State 2006-2009) career mark of 10,392. It is one of five major career passing marks the senior signal caller owns.

DEFENSIVE ROTATION: Elon led the conference in total defense last season, yielding just 248.3 yards per game. It was the eighth straight season that a different school led the conference in total defense. Chattanooga is the only team that has not led the league in total defense at least once, dating back to 2002.

- Wofford currently boasts the top defensive unit in the conference as the Terriers rank fifth in the nation in total defense. They have held their opponents to 274 total yards per game.
- The Terriers also own the top scoring defense in the league as Wofford has held its opponents to just 18.9 points per game.

EXPERIENCED COACHES: Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 303 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 197 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers (106) is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (67 victories) has moved into eighth place.

APPALACHIAN BUILDS SOCON WIN STREAK: Appalachian State's 26-game conference winning streak came to an end November 6 when the Mountaineers fell to Georgia Southern, 21-14 in overtime. The Mountaineers' run is the longest streak in school history and is the second-longest win streak in league history.

West Virginia holds the record with 30-straight SoCon wins from 1952-59.

PAYTON AWARD PEDIGREE: Appalachian State senior quarterback Armanti Edwards became the first player to win the Walter Payton Award in back-to-back years after being named the top offensive player in FCS football in 2008 and 2009. He was the second straight SoCon quarterback to win the award, following Jayson Foster (Georgia Southern) in 2007. Five SoCon student-athletes have been honored with the award.

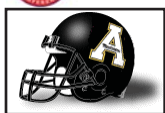
