PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Amu Saaka - Furman

Saaka averaged 17.0 points and 7.8 rebounds as the Paladins went 3-1 over the holidays.

Saaka led the Paladins to a 91-75 win over South Carolina on December 22 with a team-high 20 points and eight rebounds. Following a loss to nationally-ranked Central Florida, Furman came away with a 75-62 victory over Northeastern in the UCF Holiday Classic. Saaka scored 17 points and added eight rebounds against the Huskies en route to all-tournament honors. He finished the two-week stretch with 21 points and eight rebounds as Furman captured an 82-55 win over UVA-Wise Monday night.

Saaka is fourth in the Southern Conference in scoring (15.7 ppg) and ranks fifth in rebounding (6.9 rpg).

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Donald Sims, College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock, The Citadel's Zach Urbanus, Elon's Chris Long, Georgia Southern's Ben Drayton III, Western Carolina's Richie Gordon and Wofford's Noah Dahlman.

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Donald Sims scored 24 points in the win against Milligan on December 30 to bump his career total to 1,803 points, surpassing Don King for the program's career scoring record (1,794), which had stood since the 1960-61 season. Sims also owns the career records for most three pointers made and attempted, as well as free throw percentage.
- ASU looks to make it three wins in a row over Davidson when conference play resumes on Wednesday. The Mountaineers swept the season series from DC last year for the first time since 2000-01.
- After visiting Davidson, ASU will Georgia Southern on Saturday.

ELON PHOENIX



- Senior Chris Long needs just 44 points to reach the 1,000-point plateau for his career. Long is averaging 13.7 points per game this season which ranks 14th in the Southern Conference. He is second in the league with 4.8 assists per contest.
- Elon has seen an increase in its scoring from last season to 2010-11. The Phoenix lead the league with an average of 75.9 points per contest, nine points better than 2009-10 when Elon averaged 66.9 points per game.
- The Phoenix take on N.C. State Wednesday night.

UNCG SPARTANS



- Sophomore guard Kyle Randall has proven to be a threat for the Spartans in the backcourt. Randall is second on the team in scoring (10.9 ppg) and leads UNCG in assists (3.8 apg). He also owns a 1.4 assist-to-turnover ratio which ranks in the top 10 of the conference.
- UNCG has displayed a balanced offensive attack this season. Aloysius Henry, Korey Van Dussen and Randall all average double figures in scoring for the Spartans. The trio has led UNCG in scoring in eight of 12 games this season.
- The Spartans host Samford Thursday night.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- With Samford's 55-51 victory against Eastern Michigan on Dec. 31, the Bulldogs tallied their third straight victory at home and improved to 5-2 on the season when playing at the Pete Hanna Center. In the month of January, Samford will only play a total of three games at home.
- Samford guards Josh Bedwell and Josh Davis have combined to shoot 89.6 percent from the free-throw line this season. Davis is currently ranked first in the conference with a 93.8 percentage, while Bedwell is tied for fourth place in the SoCon at 85.7 percent.
- Samford visits UNCG Thursday night.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- The Mocs carry a 3-0 conference mark into league play when they travel to UNCG Saturday. The last time the Mocs started 3-0 in conference play was the 2007-08 season which was a 7-0 start.
- The Mocs have won three games when trailing at the half this season. The biggest comebacks have come from 10 points down during the first half at Marshall and at Elon. Chattanooga has come back from second half deficits of seven at Kennesaw State, eight at Marshall, five at home against Appalachian State and five at Elon.
- After visiting UNCG, the Mocs travel to The Citadel on January 13.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- WCU returns to Southern Conference action at Georgia Southern on Wednesday night in Statesboro. It will end a seven-game road stretch that spanned the entire month of December and represents the longest stretch away from home since WCU joined the SoCon in 1977-78.
- WCU is currently in the middle of a six-game losing skid, the longest winless drought since an eight-game slide during the 2004-05 season. Since joining the SoCon, the Catamounts have had three winless Decembers – 1986-87, 1994-95 and 2010-11.
- The Catamounts visit UNC Asheville December 28.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- CofC currently leads the SoCon in field-goal percentage (.468) which ranks 55th nationally. The Cougars have three players who are shooting better than 50 percent from the floor including senior Jeremy Simmons (.684), senior Andrew Goudelock (.512) and freshman Trent Wiedeman (.556).
- The Cougars pulled off a 91-78 upset at Tennessee on Dec. 31 which marked their first road victory at a major conference school since 1995. CofC made a season-high 14 three-pointers in the contest which tied for the seventh-highest total in school history.
- CofC visits Furman Thursday night.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- After the first weekend of Southern Conference action against Wofford (Jan. 6) and Furman (Jan. 8) the Bulldogs will have traveled 6,049 miles over their last eight games including meetings with Colorado, New Mexico, S.C. State and SIU-Edwardsville which took place in Las Vegas and Clemson.
- Senior Austin Dahn has moved within 52 points of becoming the 29th player in Citadel history with 1,000 points. Dahn, currently 35th on The Citadel all-time scoring list is making a strong push to join Urbanus (1,076), Demetrius Nelson (1,264) and Cameron Wells (1,642) as the 15th set of teammates with 1,000 career points to play alongside each other.
- The Citadel travels to Wofford Thursday night.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Senior guard Brendan McKillop needs 22 three-pointers to move into the top five on the career list. McKillop has knocked down 165 career triples. He ranks fourth in the SoCon this season with 2.8 made three-pointers per game.
- Head coach Bob McKillop is 10 wins away from his 400th career victory. A total of 353 of his 390 wins have come while Davidson has been a member of the Southern Conference, making him the all-time wins leader in league history.
- The Wildcats host Appalachian State Wednesday night. Davidson will visit Western Carolina on Saturday.

FURMAN PALADINS



- With an 82-55 win over UVA-Wise on January 3, Furman improved to 10-3 on the season. It marked the earliest date in school history that a Paladin team had reached 10 wins. Furman also earned its first victory over intrastate foe South Carolina since the 1979-80 season.
- Senior Justin Dehm has moved into third in Furman history with 188 career three-pointers. Dehm is averaging 1.7 made three-pointers per game and has made 49 percent of his attempts from beyond the arc.
- The Paladins host College of Charleston Thursday.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Three Eagles rank in the top six of the SoCon steals-per-game chart as GSU is 12th in the nation and first in the league (10.0 spg). Eric Ferguson and Ben Drayton III are tied for 51st nationally and fourth in the SoCon with 2.1 steals per game, while Jelani Hewitt averages 1.9 thefts per game.
- Three Eagles have recorded a double-double this season with Eric Ferguson capturing his second double-double of the season at Auburn on Dec. 29th. Marvin Baynham and Cameron Baskerville recorded double-doubles earlier in the season.
- The Eagles host Western Carolina Wednesday.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- The Terriers have used just three starting lineups through 13 games this season. Only seven Terriers have cracked the starting lineup in 2010-11. Noah Dahlman, Cameron Rundles and Brad Loesing are the only three players to start every game this season for Wofford.
- Wofford allowed just 61.2 points per game last season, which ranked third in the Southern Conference. This year the Terriers are giving up 73.5 points per contest which ranks eighth in the league.
- Wofford hosts The Citadel Thursday.

CONFERENCE NOTES

COUSY CANDIDATES

The Southern Conference boasts four candidates for the 2011 Bob Cousy Award, given to the nation's top point guard. The Award is presented through the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in Springfield, Mass. The Southern Conference Candidates Include:

RECORD WATCH

Many of the impressive accomplishments from this season have placed Southern Conference teams in the league's record book.

- Samford knocked down 18 three-pointers against Auburn (Nov. 19) and UT-San Antonio (Dec. 21), which tied for the sixth-highest single-game output in league history.
- Elon grabbed 54 rebounds against Hampden-Sydney (Nov. 22). It was the tenth-highest single game rebound total in the SoCon's 90-year history.
- Western Carolina recorded 18 steals against Warren Wilson (Nov. 22), which tied for the tenth-highest steals total in the Southern Conference.

MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2010-11. Seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 35 starters from last year, an average of 2.9 per team. Furman is the only team in the league to return all five starters from last season. Wofford and The Citadel each return four starters.
- Eight of the ten members from the 2010 Coaches All-Conference team returned for 2010-11.

CONFERENCE NOTES

FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in league history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2011 marks the 90th year of the post-season classic.

CONFERENCE NOTES

POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference tied its league-best mark with four teams in the postseason for 2010. The league also placed four teams in postseason tournaments in 2009.

- The Wofford Terriers made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2010. Wofford fell to Wisconsin 53-49 in the first round in Jacksonville, Fla.
- Western Carolina earned a berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Catamounts fell to former SoCon member Marshall, 90-88 in Huntington, W.Va.
