### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Amu Saaka - Furman

Saaka averaged 22.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and shot 68 percent from the floor as the Paladins earned wins over Samford, Chattanooga and Wofford last week.

After opening the week with 14 points against Samford, the Decatur, Ga., native poured in a season-high 30 points and added eight rebounds in Furman's victory over Chattanooga. Saaka closed the week with 22 points and six rebounds as Furman outlasted Wofford in overtime. He connected on 23-of-34 field goal attempts last week and knocked down 10-of-16 (.625) from three-point range.

Saaka leads the Paladins in scoring (17.2 ppg) and rebounding (6.5 rpg). He is the only player in the Southern Conference to rank in the top ten for both categories.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock, The Citadel's Cameron Wells, Elon's Drew Spradlin, Georgia Southern's Western Carolina's Mike Williams and Wofford's Noah Dahlman.

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Donald Sims scored a team-high 23 points in Appalachian State's 74-65 loss to Wofford Thursday night. The senior guard was a perfect 10-of-10 from the free throw line against the Terriers. Earlier this week Sims topped the 1,900-point plateau and now stands at 1,963 for his career.
- Appalachian State made 17-of-19 free throws against the Terriers. ASU is shooting 69 percent from the charity stripe this year.
- The Mountaineers will set out on the team's final Southern Conference road trip of the year as ASU visits Furman, UNCG and Elon over the next week.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Senior Chris Long poured in a game-high 21 points and added seven assists in Elon's loss at Samford Thursday. Long knocked down six triples and added three free throws in 37 minutes of action for the Phoenix.
- The Phoenix made 12 triples against Samford. Elon is second in the league with 9.3 made three-pointers per game. Elon has made at least 10 three-pointers in eight games this season.
- Elon travels to Chattanooga Saturday night. The Phoenix will host Western Carolina on Wednesday.

## UNCG SPARTANS



- UNCG has dramatically increased its offensive output during its last four games. The Spartans have averaged 70.1 points per game this season, but UNCG has scored 87.3 points per contest during its last four games.
- The Spartans lost a double-overtime thriller (111-110) at Chattanooga Thursday. UNCG knocked down 17 three-pointers which tied for the tenth highest single-game total in league history. UNCG's 110 points set a new school mark for most points since the program moved to Division I.
- The Spartans will visit Samford Saturday.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford snapped a five-game losing streak with a 69-67 victory over Elon Thursday. The Bulldogs' five-game slide matched their worst losing streak since dropping five consecutive contests against Furman, Appalachian State, Western Carolina, The Citadel and College of Charleston from Jan. 25 to Feb. 6 of last season.
- Josh Davis ranks 21st on Samford's all-time scoring list. The Bulldogs' senior forward from Lubbock, Texas, is averaging 9.4 points per game this season and has scored 1,032 points in his collegiate career.
- The Bulldogs will entertain UNCG Saturday.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Ricky Taylor scored a career-high 41 points as Chattanooga held off UNCG 111-110 in double overtime Thursday. Taylor's 41-point output is the highest single-game scoring mark by a SoCon player this season and the highest point total for a Moc in McKenzie Arena since the program moved to Division I.
- After out-rebounding just one opponent in its first six games, The Mocs have won the battle on the glass in 14 of the 16 contests. UTC owns a rebounding margin of +7.1 (41.5-34.4) during that stretch.
- Chattanooga hosts Elon Saturday night.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Mike Williams and Richie Gordon each scored 12 points as Western Carolina defeated Furman 65-41 Thursday at the Ramsey Center. Trey Sumler added 11 points for the Catamounts who have now won five of their last seven games. WCU is undefeated (6-0) at home this season.
- Western Carolina's win over Furman gave the Catamounts their fifth-straight victory over the Paladins. WCU has now won the last four meetings in Cullowhee.
- The Catamounts travel to take on Wofford Saturday night.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- Senior Andrew Goudelock scored a game-high 27 points as the Cougars escaped Georgia Southern with a 65-61 victory Wednesday night. Goudelock was 7-of-12 from the field, including 3-of-3 from three-point range. Jeremy Simmons added ten points and a game-high eight rebounds for CofC.
- The Cougars' 65 points was the second-lowest point total in a win for CofC this season. The Cougars topped Toledo 64-51 November 21. College of Charleston lead the Southern Conference in scoring with 76.9 points per game.
- College of Charleston visits Davidson Saturday afternoon. The Cougars will host Wofford on February 3.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Senior Austin Dahn became the third current member of the team to score 1,000 points. He reached the milestone with 13 points against Western Carolina on Saturday. Dahn joins Urbanus (1,219), Demetrius Nelson (1,264) and Cameron Wells (1,882) as the 15th set of teammates with 1,000 career points to play alongside each other.
- Wells scored a game-high 28 points as The Citadel earned its fifth straight victory with an 85-75 win over Davidson Wednesday. Mike Groselle added 13 points for the Bulldogs while Daniel Eykyn chipped in 12 points off the bench.
- The Citadel hosts Furman February 3.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Senior guard Brendan McKillop needs nine three-pointers to move into the top five on the school's career list. McKillop has knocked down 178 career triples. He is fourth in the SoCon this season with 2.5 made three-pointers per game.
- With 65 career blocked shots, sophomore Jake Cohen has moved in the top-10 at Davidson. Cohen currently leads the Southern Conference with 1.4 blocked shots per game. He has recorded multiple blocked shots in eight different games this season.
- The Wildcats host College of Charleston Saturday afternoon.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Furman lost at Western Carolina Thursday, but limited the Catamounts to 65 points. The Paladins are tied with Samford for the lead in the SoCon in scoring defense, as they give up just 65.5 points per game.
- Senior Justin Dehm buried his 200th career three-pointer in a 73-68 overtime win against Wofford on Monday to move into second place on Furman's career three-point list behind Eric Webb (273). Dehm is averaging 1.7 made triples per game this season and is third in the SoCon in three-point field goal percentage (.431).
- Furman will host Appalachian State Saturday afternoon.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Junior Ben Drayton III scored in double-figures for the 21st time this season with 20 points against College of Charleston to move to 975 career points. Drayton leads Georgia Southern and ranks sixth in the league with 15.5 points per game.
- Georgia Southern ranks ninth in the country with 9.6 steals per game. Jelani Hewitt leads the team with 47 steals this season while Ben Drayton III and Eric Ferguson have 46 and 35 steals, respectively.
- The Eagles will host Davidson on Monday. Georgia Southern travels to Chattanooga on February 3.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Noah Dahlman scored a team-high 23 points as Wofford won at Appalachian State (74-65) Thursday. Cameron Rundles added 14 points while Kevin Giltner chipped in 10 points off the bench.
- Wofford is 6-1 when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 11-4 when holding opponents to under 50 percent. However when opponents shoot better than 50 percent the Terriers are just 1-5.
- Wofford will host Western Carolina Saturday night. The Terriers will visit College of Charleston Thursday.

### RECORD WATCH

Many of the impressive accomplishments from this season have placed Southern Conference teams in the league's record book.

- Samford knocked down 18 three-pointers against Auburn (Nov. 19) and UT-San Antonio (Dec. 21), which tied for the sixth-highest single-game output in league history.
- UNCG made 17 triples at Chattanooga January 27. The Spartans' 43 attempts from three-point range was the sixth highest single-game mark in league history.
- Chattanooga grabbed 60 rebounds against Reinhardt (Dec. 21). It was the sixth-highest single game rebound total in the SoCon's 90-year history.
- Western Carolina recorded 18 steals against Warren Wilson (Nov. 22), which tied for the tenth-highest steals total in the Southern Conference.
- The Mocs attempted 53 free throws against UNCG on January 27 which ranked as the tenth-highest total in the SoCon.
- Wofford's Noah Dahlman became just the ninth player in SoCon history to be perfect from the floor with at least 10 field goal attempts. Dahlman was 10-for-10 from the field against Georgia Southern on January 12.
- College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock has made 821 career field goals, the tenth-highest total in league history. He needs 23 field goals to pass West Virginia's Jerry West (1958-60) for ninth place.

### MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

### HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

### ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in league history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference tied its league-best mark with four teams in the postseason for 2010. The league also placed four teams in postseason tournaments in 2009.

- The Wofford Terriers made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2010. Wofford fell to Wisconsin 53-49 in the first round in Jacksonville, Fla.
