## **Preseason predictions**

Furman is the preseason favorite to win the 2023-24 Southern Conference men's basketball title in polling of the league's 10 men's basketball coaches and media. Western Carolina junior guard Vonterius Woolbright is the coaches' preseason player of the year selection after finishing 12th in the league in scoring (14.5 ppg). He led the conference in assists (5.1 apg) and was third in rebounding (7.4).

- The 103rd season of Southern Conference men's basketball tips off Monday with eight teams in action, followed by Western Carolina getting its season under way Tuesday. UNCG opens its season on Friday.
- · Preseason SoCon favorite Furman opens the season ranked No. 11 and UNCG is ranked No. 25 in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25, while Samford received votes in the poll.
- The Citadel hosts ACC opponent Boston College on Friday. Four SoCon teams play against ACC squads this week.
- Defending SoCon regular-season champion Samford opens its season with a tough road game at Purdue. The Boilermakers are ranked No. 2 in the USA Today Coaches Poll and No. 3 in the AP Top 25.
- · VMI visits in-state rival Richmond to begins its season for the second consecutive season.
- ETSU, Furman, Mercer, Chattanooga and Wofford open against non-Division I opponents Monday.
- · UNCG opens its season against crosstown rival North Carolina A&T at Greensboro Coliseum. The Spartans had defeated the Aggies five straight times prior to last season's win by N.C. A&T.
- · ETSU's Brooks Savage is making his debut this season as the Bucs' head coach. Savage served as an assistant under Steve Forbes in Johnson City from 2015-20. Wofford head coach Dwight Perry is in his first full season at the helm of the Terriers. Perry went 12-12 as the interim last season.
- Sophomore guard Honor Huff resumes his career at Chattanooga after spending his first freshman year at VMI. Huff averaged 10 points and 2.3 assists in the 2021-22 season with the Keydets en route to being named to the SoCon All-Freshman team.
- The SoCon will have five regular-season games on ESPNU and five on CBS Sports Network this season. The league will also continue to have select games on Nexstar affiliates during the season.

- First conducted in 1921, the SoCon men's basketball tournament is the nation's oldest college conference tournament. The 2024 tournament will be the 104th edition.
- Furman's Frank Selvy scored an NCAA-record 100 points on Feb. 13, 1954. His record still stands.
- Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr hit the first 3-point basket in NCAA history on Nov. 29, 1980.
- · Wofford's Fletcher Magee finished his career in 2019 as the NCAA Division I record-holder with 509 made 3-pointers.
- · While it currently has 10 member schools, the Southern Conference has had 44 full-time members in its illustrious history, including the schools that exited to found the Southeastern Conference (1932) at the Atlantic Coast Conference (1953). In all, 21 schools that are now members of "Power 5" conferences were once members of the SoCon.
