Davidson to Play Maryland in NCAA Tournament

Southern Conference champion Davidson will take on 17th-ranked Maryland on Thursday, March 15 in the opening round of the 2007 NCAA Tournament.

Davidson is the 13th seed and Maryland the fourth seed in the Midwest Regional which will be played at the HSBC Arena in Buffalo, N.Y.

The Wildcats earned the league's automatic berth by sweeping to the tournament crown. The tournament's No. 1 seed, Davidson beat No. 8 seed Chattanooga, 78-68, at the

North Charleston Coliseum on March 1 in the tournament quarterfinals. After stopping No. 5 seed Furman, 91-68, on March 2 in the semifinals, coach Bob McKillop's team defeated College of Charleston 72-65 to win its ninth Southern Conference crown.

The Wildcats enter the NCAA Tournament winners of 12 consecutive games.



Appalachian State Plays at Ole Miss in NIT

Appalachian State (25-7) will play at Mississippi (20-12) in the opening round of the NIT.

The Mountaineers are the tournament's fifth seed and will take on the No. 4 seed Rebels in Oxford, Miss. on Wednesday, March 14 at 8:00 p.m.

Appalachian State earned a berth in the NIT by posting a school-record 25-7 overall mark and winning the Southern Conference's North Division with a 15-3 record.

It marks the first time the Mountaineers have earned an invitation to the NIT.

The winner will take on the winner of No. 1 seed Clemson vs. No. 8 seed east Tennessee State on the higher seeded team's court on Wednesday, March 21. The NIT Final Four is scheduled for Madison Square Garden on March 27 and 29.

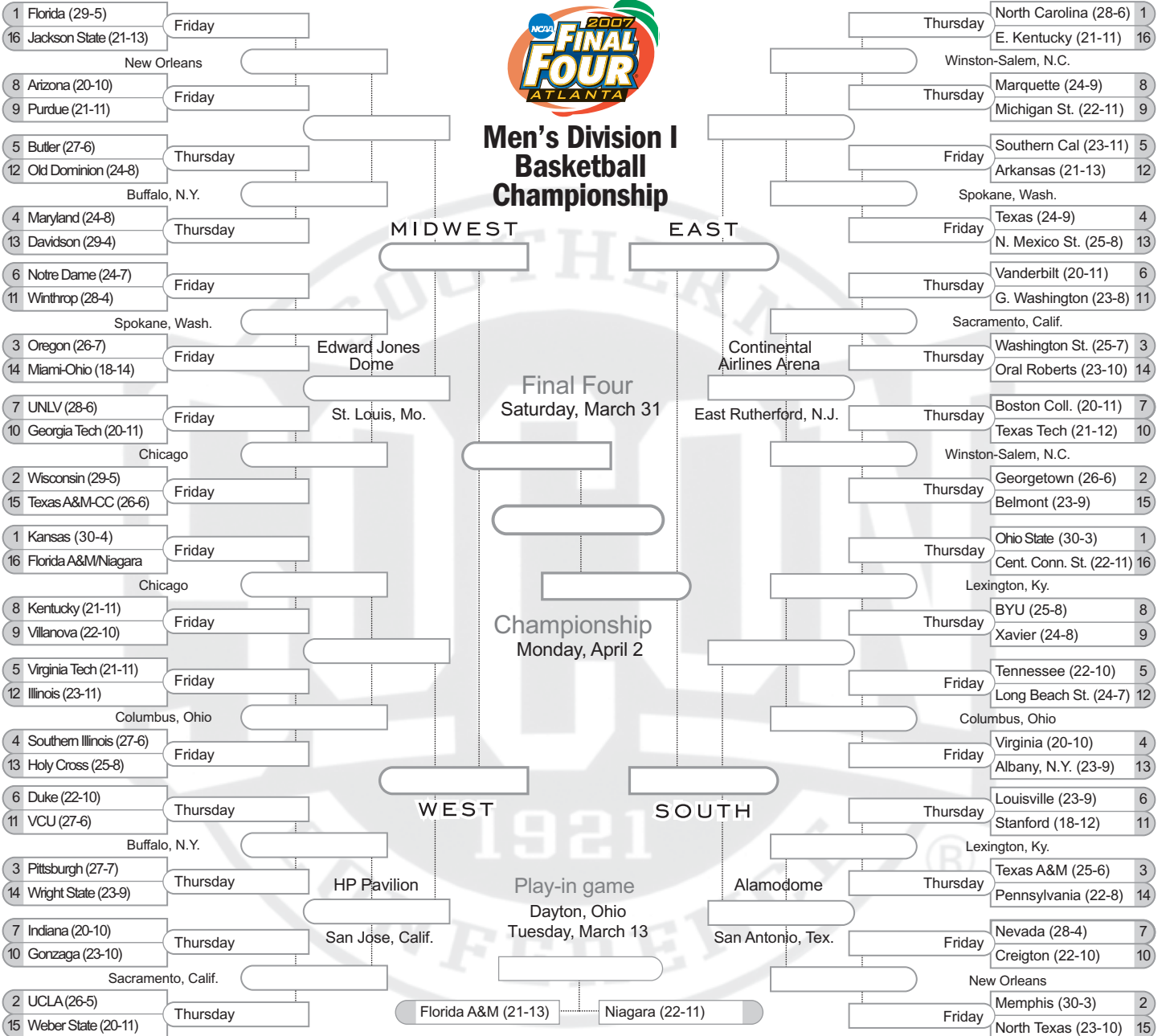

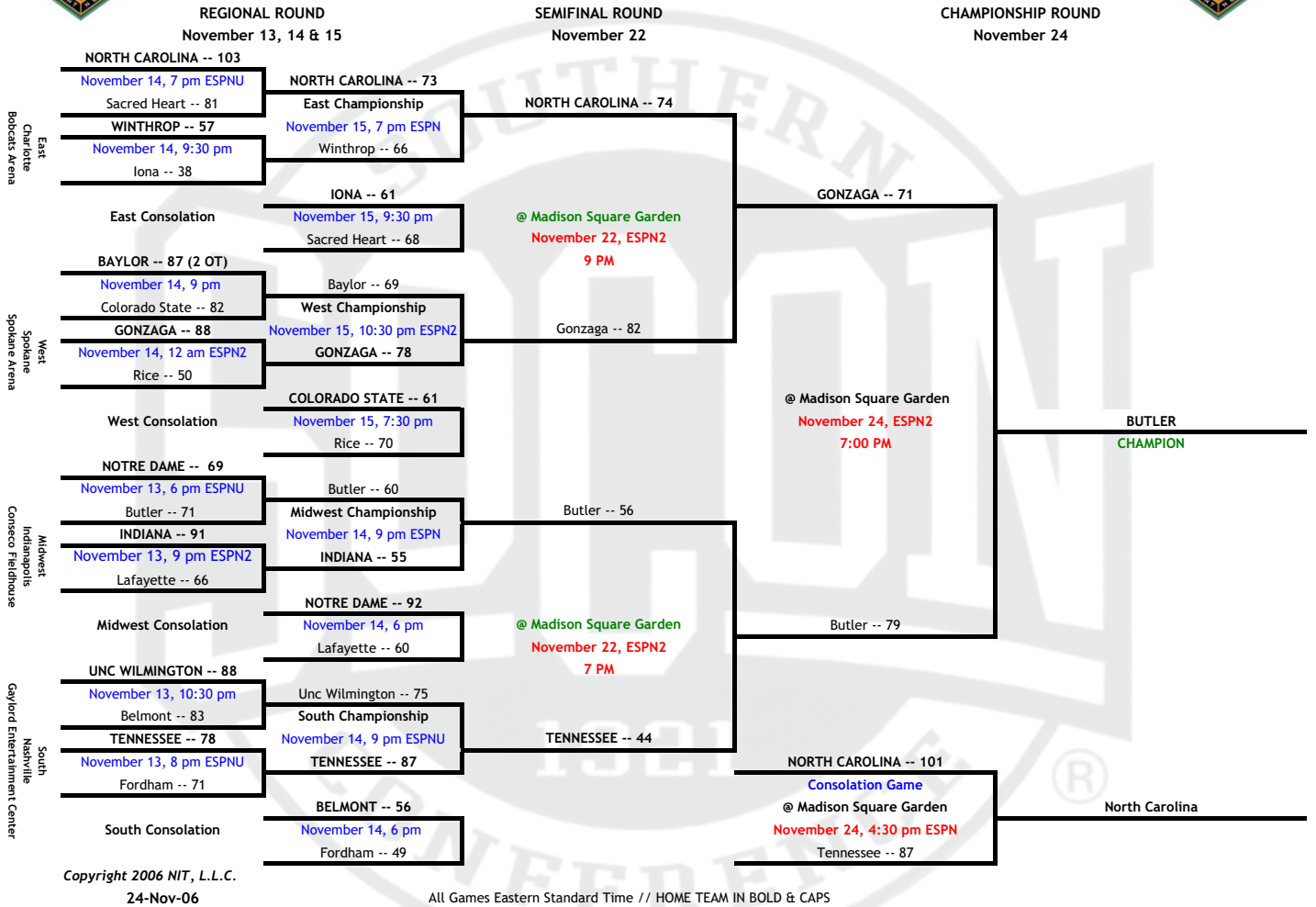

Davidson Wins 2007 SoCon Tournament



Davidson College defeated College of Charleston 72-65 to win its ninth Southern Conference Tournament title and the league's automatic NCAA Tournament berth.

Tournament MVP Stephen Curry led Davidson to its second-straight SoCon crown with a game-high 29 points. Boris Meno had 14 points and 10 boards and a game-sealing dunk in the final 30 seconds. Jermaine Johnson and David Lawrence each had 13 points for the Cougars who fell before a North Charleston Coliseum record crowd of 8,009.

Davidson shot just 37 percent in the win, but 82 percent from the free-throw line with 20 points scored off of CofC's 21 turnovers. The Cougars made good on 51 percent of their field goal attempts.

Davidson jumped out to a 7-3 lead to open the game before CofC scored nine-straight points to take a 12-7 lead six minutes into the contest. Davidson chipped away at the lead via a 9-0 run to briefly assume a six-point, 24-19 lead before the Cougars scored 11 of the next 13 points. Curry ended that run, scoring 10 of Davidson's final 10 points to give the 'Cats a 37-35 at halftime.

The 'Cats extended their lead to seven, 42-35, in the opening minutes of the second half on five points from Meno and maintained that lead until a 12-3 CofC run gave the Cougars brief a 50-48 lead with 12:23 left the play. The lead swapped hands three times with two ties over the next seven minutes until a three-point play from Meno gave Davidson a three-point, 62-59, advantage with 4:27 left. Two free-throws from Meno, followed by his press-breaking dunk put DC up seven with 25 seconds left to guarantee the Wildcats the 2007 SoCon Tournament title.

Tournament Quarterfinals: No. 1 Davidson 78, No. 8 Chattanooga 68



North Charleston, S.C. – Jason Richards and Stephen Curry both scored 20 points each to lead the Davidson Wildcats to the 78-68 win over the Chattanooga Mocs in the Quarterfinals of the Southern Conference Men's Basketball Tournament being held this week at the North Charleston Coliseum in North Charleston, S.C. Davidson improves to 27-4 and advances to face the winner of the #4 UNC Greensboro/#5 Furman match Friday, Mar. 2nd at 6:00 p.m. Chattanooga ends the season at 15-18. With the score tied at 14 with 10:28 to go in the first half, Chattanooga used an 8-0 run to pull ahead 22-24 with just 8:06 left before intermission. Bryant Barr answered for Davidson, scoring all seven of his first half points as part of an 11-2 run the next three minutes to put the Wildcats up by one, 25-24, with 5:07 to go. A Bernard Lowndes' lay-up with 4:26 put the Mocs back on top and a three-pointer by Kevin Bridgewaters increased the margin to for with 4:13 to go. It was Bridgewaters' second of three in the half, which tied his career-high. Chattanooga led by one, 32-31, with 54 seconds left, but a three-pointer by Stephen Curry gave the Wildcats back the lead and Davidson went into the lock room leading 34-32. The second half remained close in the beginning and at the 11:41 mark, Chattanooga led by one, 49-48. That would be the last lead for the Mocs as a three-pointer by Richards put Davidson up for good at 51-49 with 10:54 to go. Davidson led by only two, 56-54, with 7:50 to go but a 9-2 run over the next two-and-half minutes increased the margin to nine, 65-56. Chattanooga was able to cut the margin to six but could get no closer as Davidson outscored the Wildcats 13-9 down the stretch to secure the 78-68 win. Davidson shot 51.7 percent from the field in the second half to end the game with a 42.6 percent. Chattanooga shot 41.9 percent in the second half to end with 37.5. Davidson was nine-for-26 in three-pointers, while Chattanooga was eight-for-25. Following Richards and Curry's 20 points was Boris Meno with 14. Thomas Sanders led in rebounds with 10. Marcus Watts led Chattanooga with 13 points.



Tournament Semifinals: No. 1 Davidson 91, No. 5 Furman 68



North Charleston, S.C. - Stephen Curry scored 30 points, which included six three-pointers to break the freshman NCAA record for three-pointers with 113 total this season, to lead the Davidson Wildcats to the 91-68 win over the Furman Paladins in the semifinals of the 2007 Southern Conference Tournament being held this week at the North Charleston Coliseum in North Charleston, S.C. Davidson (28-4) advances to face the winner of the #3 College of Charleston/#2 Appalachian State semifinal game Saturday, March 3rd at 6:00 p.m. The Wildcats are defending SoCon Tournament Champions, having defeated Chattanooga, 80-55, in last year's tournament championship to earn the NCAA automatic bid. Furman ends its season with a 15-16 record. Davidson took advantage in the first half as Furman struggled from the field, shooting only 23.8 percent from the field, to build a 15-point lead, 30-15, going into the locker room. The Wildcats shot 37.9 percent for the half. Furman trailed by only two, 14-12, with 11:32 to go but was outscored 16-3 down the stretch. In the first half Davidson was three-for-12 from the three-point line, while Furman was two-for-nine. The Wildcats out-rebounded the Paladins, 26-15, as well. Furman picked up its shooting percentage in the second half, hitting a 57.1 shooting percentage, but could not come back as Davidson remained hot from the floor, firing at 58.1 in the half, including a nine-for-16 effort from beyond the arc. Furman was seven-for-15 from long range. Following Curry and his 30 points, was Jason Richards with 20. Boris Meno and Andrew Lovedale paced the Wildcats with seven rebounds. Furman was led by Eric Webb with his 16 points on the night. Moussa Diagne followed with 15. Robby Bostain and Diagne pulled down six rebounds each to lead the Paladins. Furman shot 42.0 from the field for the game, compared to 48.3 for Davidson.

CofC clawed back within two on a Philip McCandies free throw inside the two-minute mark, but that was as close as the squad got before a backdoor cut and layup from Jason Richards reasserted Davidson's control of the contest. Two free-throws from Meno, followed by his press-breaking dunk put DC up seven with 25 seconds left to guarantee the Wildcats the 2007 SoCon Tournament title.



Tournament Quarterfinals; No. 2 Appalachian State 78, No. 7 Western Carolina 68

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Appalachian State University benefited from 49 points off the bench as it went on to defeat Western Carolina, 78-59, Thursday evening in the quarterfinals of the Southern Conference Men's Basketball Tournament at North Charleston Coliseum. With the win the Mountaineers improved to 25-6 overall and advance to take on the winner of the game between No. 3 College of Charleston and No. 6 Georgia Southern in the semifinals, Friday at 8:30 p.m. The Catamounts ended their season at 11-20. Three of No. 2 Appalachian's double-digit scorers came off the bench, led by Doug McLaughlin-Williams' 12 points as he tied a season-high with three three-pointers on four attempts. Eduardo Bermudez and Donte Minter each added 11 points, with all of Bermudez's points coming in the second half. D.J. Thompson scored a game-high 15 points. The seventh-seeded Catamounts were led by Nick Aldridge with a game-high 24 points as the only WCU player to score in double figures. Western Carolina got just 14 points from its bench. Appalachian shot well throughout the game, finishing at 48 percent from the field, including 40 percent from beyond the three-point arc, and at an 80 percent clip from the charity stripe. Western Carolina struggled from the field at 38 percent and a mere 13 percent from three-point. After two points by the Catamounts, Thompson nailed his third three-pointer of the game to open the second half for the Mountaineers as they took a 37-29 lead just 30 seconds in to the final period. Western Carolina pulled within three at 37-34 on a steal and dunk by Aldridge before Thompson's fourth three gave ASU a six-point, 40-35, lead at the 18-minute mark. ASU extended its lead 12, 47-35, with 15:30 remaining. An 11-4 Appalachian run, led by nine points from Bermudez, gave ASU a 52-39 lead with 11 minutes to go. Kellen Brand added a free throw for ASU before WCU used a 7-0 run to pull within 11 points at 59-48 with 7:12 remaining. Bermudez stopped the run with his fifth and sixth free throws of the evening, giving him 11 of ASU's previous 14 points and ASU a 61-48 lead. A Minter jumper extended the lead to 63-48 with 6:30 to play. Appalachian continued its second-half dominance as it outscored Western Carolina by a total of 44-32 in the second half as it went on to a 78-59 victory. Tied at five apiece, Western Carolina scored five unanswered points to lead 10-5 three and a half minutes into the game. ASU tied the score at 10, but WCU built a 16-12 lead with 12:44 to go. Appalachian followed with an 11-0 run to take a 23-16 lead with just under seven minutes to go in the half. The Catamounts cut the lead to two points led by back-to-back buckets by Aldridge, before a layup by Minter extended the lead back to four at 27-23 with 3:34 left in the period. Four more unanswered points by ASU stretched the lead to 31-23 with just under two minutes to play. McLaughlin-Williams hit his second three of the game at the 54 second mark as Appalachian went into halftime with a 34-27 lead.



Tournament Semifinals: No. 3 College of Charleston 89, No. 2 Appalachian State 87 (OT)

North Charleston, S.C. - Dontaye Draper scored a career-high 38 points, including eight in overtime, to defeat the Appalachian State Mountaineers, 89-87, in overtime of the final Quarterfinal match of the 2007 Southern Conference Men's Basketball Tournament being held in the North Charleston Coliseum in North Charleston, S.C. The Cougars (22-10) advance to face #1 Davidson in the Championship Game, Saturday, March 3rd at 6:00 p.m. It is the first appearance in the finals for the Cougars since the 2000 Championships. Both Appalachian State and the College of Charleston met in the tournament finals that season with the Mountaineers coming away with the 68-56 decision to earn the automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. Despite shooting 45.2 from the field in the first half, the Cougars trailed by most of it as the Mountaineers capitalized on 10 Cougar turnovers, posting 15 points off them. Appalachian State turned the ball over seven times, resulting in six CofC points. ASU shot 39.4 from the field. Charleston shot 57.1 percent from the field in the second half, while Appalachian State shot 45.2. Down by four points with 44 seconds to go in regulation, Appalachian State used two timely free throws and a lay-up by Clayton to tie the game for the 10th time of the night. Draper made two free throws after being fouled by ASU but on the ensuing possession, leading by two, 73-71, the Cougars failed to put Clayton on the line shooting two. He missed the second shot, but the Mountaineers recovered the rebound with four seconds to go and Charleston was called with another foul, sending Donte Minter to the line. He missed the potential game-winner after tying it at 73 by making the first free throw. CofC rebounded with three seconds but a last second shot was short and the game went into overtime. Down 81-80 with 1:13 left in overtime, the Cougars scored seven unanswered points to take the 87-81 lead with 16 seconds to go. ASU nailed a three-pointer at the 12 second mark to cut the margin to one, but Charleston answered with a break-away dunk to send the margin to five. The Mountaineers connected on another three-pointer in the closing seconds but they could not get any closer as the Cougars came away with the two-point 89-87 win. Draper's team-leading 38 points is a College of Charleston Division I record for most points scored in a game and his eight three-pointers tied his career-high. Jermaine Johnson followed Draper with 11 points and 12 rebounds for his seventh career double-double. Leading Appalachian State was Minter with 21 points. Demetrius Scott followed with 20 points. Clayton's nine rebounds also paced the team. Charleston shot 50 percent from the field for the game, while Appalachian State shot 43.2. Charleston edged ASU, 43-42, in rebounds but had 17 turnovers, compared to 10 for the Mountaineers. Appalachian State was 16-for-28 from the free-throw line, while Charleston was 18-for-30.
