QUICK HITS

Georgia Southern's rally from 31-3 down to take a 38-31 overtime win at Western Carolina on Saturday was the largest comeback in school history ... Friday's battle between SoCon unbeaten Appalachian State (4-0) and Wofford (4-0) is the latest matchup of undefeated teams since Marshall topped East Tennessee State, 34-10, on Nov. 9, 1996 in Johnson City ... ASU head coach Jerry Moore earned his 200th career victory on Saturday against Furman ... Moore joins Albany's Bob Ford (230) and Florida A&M's Joe Taylor (203) as the only active FCS coaches with 200 or more career victories ... Georgia Southern has now played in the last four SoCon overtime games and in six of the last seven such contests, dating back to the 2006 season.

Hudgins Rewriting Record Books: Elon junior wide receiver Terrell Hudgins continues to shatter records with his latest entry into the SoCon record book coming in the form of a career mark. With his 13-catch, 199-yard, 1-touchdown effort at Georgia Southern on Sept. 20, Hudgins became the league's all-time leader in receptions and receiving touchdowns. Hudgins also now sits in second place on the SoCon's career receiving yards list, 96 yards out of first place.

Moore's 173 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (55 victories) needs nine victories to enter the top 10.

SoCon Players Make NFL Impact: 23 players (21 on active roster, 2 on practice squads) with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Efram Hill and Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and four Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ... Appalachian State leads the way with five players while Chattanooga has three ... Rob Bironas, Jerome Felton, Courtland Finnegan, Chris Hanson, Randy Moss, Terrell Owens and Chad Pennington were all in the starting lineup during week one.

ASU QB Armani Edwards is joined on the Payton Watch List by wide receivers Terrell Hudgins (Elon) and Andre Roberts (The Citadel) ... Georgia Southern's Jayson Foster was the 2007 Payton Award winner, marking the fourth SoCon winner of that award.

Appalachian State's defense delivered head coach Jerry Moore his 200th career victory, as it forced four turnovers, including two inside the red zone. ASU recovered from a 14-13 deficit early in the fourth quarter with a pair of touchdown passes from Armanti Edwards.

Wofford and Appalachian are the SoCon's top two teams in scoring offense, rushing offense and total offense ... The series between last season's SoCon co-champions is tied 3-3 over the past six seasons with the home team winning four of the six contests ... Defensive lineman Gene Singletary scored his first career touchdown on the first play of the fourth quarter, rumbling 31 yards on an interception return that gave the Catamounts a 28-point, 31-3, cushion. However, GSU recorded 35 unanswered points including 28 in regulation to force overtime en route to a 38-31 heart-breaking loss.

Game Times Decrease with New Rule Changes in 2008

When the revised rules regarding the play clock went into effect this year, many thought game times would decrease again, much like during the 2006 season. Rules changes for the 2008 season include the institution of a 40-second play clock that begins immediately following the completion of a play, except in dead ball situations. Also, when a ball carrier runs out of bounds, the clock is stopped, but it is started again when the ball is set for play (except for the final two minutes of each half.)

Southern Conference Tiebreaker Procedure

NCAA Automatic Bid: The Conference champion shall be awarded an automatic bid to the NCAA FCS Playoffs, provided it is eligible to compete in the post-season under NCAA guidelines. In the event that co-champions are declared, the automatic bid will be awarded as follows:

- A. In the case of a two-way tie, the automatic bid will be awarded to the winner of the game between the tied teams during the regular season;
- B.
 1. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss records of the tied teams against each other is first considered (i.e., head to head concept).
 2. If the teams are still tied, then each team's record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered.
 3. If the tie is still not broken, the teams' won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken.
 4. If the tie is still not broken, the team with the fewest points allowed among the tied teams shall be considered.
 5. If this does not resolve the tie, then the automatic bid will be determined by a random draw conducted by the Commissioner;
- C. In the event of multiple ties after a three-way tie, the same procedure as used to break a three-way tie will be applied until the tie is broken.
