**Appalachian Builds SoCon Win Streak:** After starting the SoCon slate with a 20-7 win over Samford, Appalachian State enters Saturday's game at The Citadel riding a 13-game conference win streak. The Mountaineers' run is the longest streak of its kind in school history and tied for the seventh-longest win streak in the Southern Conference records.

West Virginia holds the record with 30-straight SoCon wins from 1952-59.

**Hudgins, Roberts Rewriting Record Books:** Elon's Terrell Hudgins and The Citadel's Andre Roberts will likely end their careers as the top two receivers in Southern Conference history.

Hudgins holds the career records for receptions, receiving yards and touchdowns, and he is now taking aim at the NCAA marks in each category. Hudgins is just 2 catches shy of equaling the all-time FCS record for career catches, and he needs 535 more yards to top Hall of Famer Jerry Rice's career total of 4,693 yards.

Roberts is now in the top three in each category as well, ranking second in receptions, second in receiving touchdowns and third in receiving yards.

**Riddle Unmatched Among SoCon QBs:** Elon quarterback Scott Riddle is without equal among Southern Conference QBs as the junior now owns the career records for passing yards (7,893), completions (705) and touchdowns (65).

Just 26 games into his college career, Riddle passed former ETSU great Greg Ryan in both completions and yardage in Saturday's 28-14 win over Georgia Southern.

Riddle also set a new SoCon standard for pass attempts without an interception, tossing 218 straight passes without a pick prior to a second half interception against Georgia Southern.

**Edwards, LeGree Watched for National Awards:** After stellar seasons in 2008, football writers and fans across the nation have taken note of Appalachian State's Armanti Edwards and Mark LeGree. LeGree, a junior defensive back who led the nation and tied a SoCon single-season record with 10 INTs in 2008, was named one of 62 official candidates for the 2009 Bronko Nagurski Trophy, which honors college football's top defensive player. LeGree is the only NCAA Division I FCS representative on the Nagurski Trophy's preseason watch list.

Likewise, Edwards is the sole FCS nominee for both the Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award and for the Manning Award. Both awards honor the top quarterback in collegiate football with the Unitas Award being limited to seniors.

**Edwards Vies For Payton Award Double in 2009:** Appalachian State quarterback Armanti Edwards was named as the recipient of the 2008 Walter Payton Award, which recognizes the top offensive player in FCS football. Edwards was the second straight SoCon QB to win the award, following Jayson Foster (Georgia Southern) in 2007. In total, five SoCon student-athletes have been honored with the award. A senior, Edwards is aiming to become the first player in the award's history to win it twice.

Elon's Terrell Hudgins, Samford's Chris Evans and The Citadel's Andre Roberts were also named the preseason watch list for the 2009 Walter Payton Award.

**Appalachian Joins SoCon Record Books:** Appalachian State completed a perfect 8-0 Southern Conference season in 2008, wrapping up its fourth consecutive league title. Appalachian State joins a short list of four-time champions, and if it wins the league crown again in 2009, Appalachian would become just the second-ever SoCon team to win five league titles in a row.

**SoCon Teams Set Winning Standard This Decade:** The Southern Conference boasts three of the top 10 winningest teams in FCS football (among playoff-qualifiers) this decade (2000-present). Appalachian State's 91 overall victories during that span trail only Montana (108) while Furman (80) and Georgia Southern (78) sit in the sixth and ninth spots, respectively.

**Rebuilding and Reloading:** SoCon teams return 65 percent of their starters from last season (148-of-228), up from just 57 percent returnees in 2008 ... the most experienced group are the specialists (73%) followed by defense (65%) and offense (63%) ... Elon has the most experienced group of returning starters for the second year in a row as 20-of-25 (80%) return from a Phoenix team which finished 8-4 overall and 6-2 in the SoCon last season ... Elon is the only league team to return 9 of its starters on offense while Appalachian State and The Citadel join the Phoenix with nine starting defenders back ... Wofford (46% starters returning) and Furman (52%) have the most holes to fill in the starting 25.

**SoCon Pair Among Nation's Rushing Elite:** Appalachian State senior quarterback Armanti Edwards and Samford junior running back Chris Evans are among the nation's elite when it comes to 100-yard rushing games. Through 2008, both rank in the FCS top 25 in active career 100-yard games; however, a deeper look at the rankings shows the each is tops nationally among his classmates. Edwards' 17 100-yard performances are equaled only by fellow seniors David McCarthy of Albany and Trevyn Smith of Weber State, and Evans' 11 games over the century mark are the most nationally among juniors.

**Experienced Coaches:** Appalachian State head coach Jerry Moore and Wofford head coach Mike Ayers are the deans of SoCon coaches, having combined for 274 victories while coaching in the Southern Conference ... Moore's 179 wins at Appalachian are the most in league history ... Ayers (96) is third on the list behind Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade ... Furman's Bobby Lamb (60 victories) needs five victories to enter the top 10.

**SoCon Players Make NFL Impact:** 14 players (13 on active roster, 1 on a practice squad) with SoCon ties are currently on NFL rosters ... the list includes Pro Bowl DB Courtland Finnegan of Samford who played in the OVC and three Marshall players who competed in the SoCon ... Appalachian State leads the way with three players while Chattanooga, Furman and Georgia Southern each have two ... Rob Bironas, Jerome Felton, Courtland Finnegan, Chris Hanson, Jason Hunter, Randy Moss, Terrell Owens and Chad Pennington are all expected to be in the starting lineup on week one.

**Facilities Improve Throughout the Conference:** Both Kidd Brewer Stadium at Appalachian State and Seibert Stadium at Samford will look different to visitors this season as each stadium received significant upgrades during the offseason.

At ASU, a seven story, 120,000-square foot building behind the west stands at Kidd Brewer Stadium was officially opened this month. The facility is a part of ASU's \$50 million facilities enhancement campaign, which also included an indoor practice facility, baseball, softball and soccer stadiums. It provides office space in addition to locker rooms, club seating and a new press box.

Samford's home opener on Sept. 12 showcased the newly-constructed Cooney Family Field House, a \$7.5 million, 39,000 square-foot structure in the south end zone of Seibert Stadium.

Elsewhere around the league, Furman installed a new scoreboard with video replay capabilities and Wofford opened a new building adjacent to Gibbs Stadium that houses a new weight room and coaches offices.

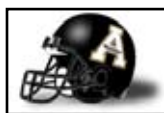

### Oct. 3, 1981

Chattanooga provided eventual league champion Furman with its first SoCon loss by amassing 431 yards of total offense in a 31-28 win in Greenville.

### Oct. 3, 1987

Chattanooga improved to 3-1 on the season by withstanding a late Louisiana Tech rally and defeated the Bulldogs, 20-18.

Tailback John Bagwell rushed for 213 yards and four touchdowns and also threw for a score in Furman's 42-36 win over Marshall in Greenville. In the loss, Marshall passed for 428 yards as a team.

### Oct. 3, 1992

No. 6 The Citadel rushed for 386 yards and forced three Appalachian State turnovers while shutting out the Mountaineers in Boone, 25-0.

Furman scored touchdowns by rushing, passing, punt return and fumble return in a 41-13 win at VMI.

### Oct. 3, 1998

No. 10 Appalachian State gave Jerry Moore his 100th career victory with a 30-27 overtime win at ACC member Wake Forest. QBs David Reaves and Daniel Jeremiah combined for 308 yards passing with Jeremiah's one-yard touchdown run in overtime clinching the win.

Chattanooga forced five Wofford turnovers en route to a 31-3 victory in Spartanburg.

A balanced rushing attack produced 221 yards and Furman intercepted three Western Carolina passes in the Paladins' 31-7 victory.

With 602 yards of offense, a punt return for a score and two fumble recoveries, Georgia Southern thoroughly dominated VMI, 63-7, in Statesboro.
