- Elon is 8-4 and in first place in the North Division. The Phoenix has its most league wins (8) under Matt Matheny with six more games to play.

- Four league teams will participate in BracketBusters on Saturday, February 18. Davidson and Appalachian State will be at home, while College of Charleston and Wofford are on the road.
- The Southern Conference Tournament will be held in Asheville, N.C., March 2-5 at the newly renovated Asheville Civic Center. The league's tournament was held in Asheville from 1984-1995.

## Player of the Week

Elon's Jack Isenbarger has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games played January 31-February 6. The sophomore guard averaged 23.3 points, seven rebounds and 5.6 assists in three games for the Phoenix in three wins last week.

With teammate Austin Hamilton ill, Isenbarger started at point guard against the Cougars and scored 25 points to go with six assists in the double overtime win. Isenbarger poured in a career-high 34 points in 34 minutes Saturday night against The Citadel. He finished the week with 11 points, seven assists and just one turnover against Appalachian State.

The Zionsville, Ind., native made 56 percent (22-of-39) of his field goal attempts, including 47 percent (9-of-19) from three-point range. Isenbarger was 17-of-19 from the free throw line and added 14 rebounds, 17 assists and five steals for the week.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included College of Charleston's Andrew Lawrence, The Citadel's Lawrence Miller, Davidson's De'Mon Brooks, Georgia Southern's Jelani Hewitt, UNCG's Trevis Simpson, Samford's Raijon Kelly, Western Carolina's Keaton Cole and Wofford's Brad Loesing.

**MOUNTAINEERS**

Appalachian State dropped three straight games after downing Elon, 81-66, just a week ago. The Apps fell in home contests against Samford and College of Charleston before an 82-59 setback at Elon.

Nathan Healy led ASU in scoring in all three games with 13.3 points to accompany 5.7 rebounds per game. The former walk-on shot 54.8 percent from the field including a 4-of-7 mark from downtown.

The Mountaineers wrap up a two-game road swing at Furman on Thursday before returning home to host Wofford on Saturday. Seven of ASU's nine wins have come at home on the season.

**PHOENIX**

Elon earned an 82-59 win over Appalachian State Monday night, snapping ASU's seven-game winning streak in the series. No current member of the Phoenix had been a part of a win over ASU prior to Monday.

The Phoenix has eight league wins, the most under head coach Matt Matheny. Elon is one win shy of tying the most overall victories under Matheny (14).

Elon travels to Chattanooga Thursday.

**SPARTANS****NORTH DIVISION**

UNCG's seven-game winning streak was snapped at Furman. The streak was the second-longest of UNCG's Division I era, and its longest since winning eight straight in 1995-96.

UNCG has nine wins overall this season, two more than last year and its most since the 2007-08 season. Additionally, the Spartans have seven league wins, the most they've had since going 12-8 in 2008.

The Spartans will visit Samford Thursday night. UNCG then travels to Chattanooga Saturday night.

**BULLDOGS****NORTH DIVISION**

In Sunday's 66-61 overtime victory at Wofford, the Bulldogs received 64 of their 66 points from the starting lineup. Senior Matthew Friday scored Samford's lone bench points of the game with two. Interestingly enough, the Bulldogs still outscored Wofford in bench scoring, 2-1.

Samford snapped a five-game losing streak against Wofford that dated all the way back to Jan. 11, 1982. The Bulldogs also ended the Terriers' six-game winning streak and an eight-game home winning streak.

The Bulldogs host UNCG Thursday.

**MOCS****NORTH DIVISION**

The Mocs lead the Southern Conference in defensive field goal percentage. UTC has allowed its opponents to shoot just 39.9 percent from the field. The Mocs are the third best team in the league defending the three-point line as opponents have shot just 31 percent from beyond the arc against UTC.

Senior guard Ricky Taylor (1,156) is now eighth on the Division I era scoring list, just two points of sole possession of sixth place behind David Phillips (1,157) and Stanford Strickland (1,153).

The Mocs will host Elon Thursday.

**CATAMOUNTS****NORTH DIVISION**

Western Carolina opens a Palmetto State swing with its next three league opponents all hailing from South Carolina. The Catamounts look to snap a five-game Southern Conference road losing skid as it visits South Division foe, College of Charleston on Thursday.

WCU has not won away from home in league play since downing Samford, 75-71, in Birmingham, Ala., in its SoCon opener on Dec. 1, 2011.

The road swing continues on Saturday afternoon as WCU travels to Greenville, S.C., to face Furman.

**COUGARS****SOUTH DIVISION**

College of Charleston won two of three games on its recent road swing. Guard Andrew Lawrence averaged 28 points, 7.5 assists and shot 63 percent from the field over that stretch.

The Cougars will participate in their third consecutive ESPN Sears BracketBusters game traveling to Kent State on Feb. 18 in a rematch of the only meeting between the two which came during the 2003 NIT.

The Cougars host Western Carolina Thursday. CofC will welcome Davidson to TD Arena Saturday afternoon in a game that can be seen on the SoCon Sports Network.

**BULLDOGS****SOUTH DIVISION**

Coach Chuck Driesell started Marshall Harris III, Lawrence Miller and Jordan Robertson Saturday at Elon. They became the first three freshmen to start for the Dogs since Jan. 14, 2008, when the combination of Austin Dahn, Zach Urbanus and Cameron Wells started against College of Charleston.

The Bulldogs have used eight different starting lineups this season with Mike Groselle the only player on the roster to start in every contest.

The Bulldogs host Davidson February 9.

**WILDCATS****SOUTH DIVISION**

The Wildcats topped Wofford 76-54 at home Monday night. Davidson has won 17 of its last 18 in Belk Arena with the lone loss coming to Vanderbilt Dec. 7.

The Wildcats have won 20 of their last 22 SoCon regular-season games, dating back to last season.

Davidson will host Wichita State in a BracketBusters game Feb. 18, at noon in Belk Arena. The game will be televised live on ESPN or ESPN2.

**PALADINS****SOUTH DIVISION**

Bobby Austin scored 13 points while Brandon Sebirumbi turned in a solid all-around performance with 10 points and eight rebounds but Furman fell at Georgia Southern Monday night.

The Paladins rank second in the conference in scoring defense, as they have yielded just 65 points per game. Furman leads the conference in defending the three-point arc. The Paladins' opponents are shooting just 31 percent from three-point range.

Furman hosts Appalachian State Thursday night. The Paladins welcome Western Carolina to Timmons Arena Saturday afternoon.

**EAGLES****SOUTH DIVISION**

Willie Powers recorded 11 points and eight assists in Monday's win over Furman. Powers ranks second in the league with 5.6 assists per game and ranks fourth in the SoCon with a 1.9 assists-to-turnovers ratio.

After winning just one league game last season, Georgia Southern has nine conference wins through 13 games. The Eagles are currently in second place in the South Division.

Georgia Southern hosts Wofford Thursday night. The Eagles will travel to take on The Citadel Saturday.

**TERRIERS****SOUTH DIVISION**

The Terriers fell 76-54 at Davidson Monday night. Wofford's 15 points scored in the first half were the second-fewest this season after scoring only 12 in the first half at Wisconsin.

Wofford is 0-2 in overtime games this season after Saturday's home loss to Samford

Wofford is in a stretch of playing six of eight games on the road. The Terriers visit Georgia Southern Thursday and travel to Appalachian State Saturday afternoon.

## Conference News and Notes

### Point Production

Davidson leads the Southern Conference with 78.8 points per game.

- Either Davidson or College of Charleston has led the league in scoring every year since 2006.

### Cousy Nominees

Chattanooga's Keegan Bell, College of Charleston's Andrew Lawrence, Davidson's JP Kuhlman and Western Carolina's Trey Sumler have been named to the Cousy Award Watch List. The Cousy Award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

### Athletes of the Month

Jake Cohen earned Player of the Month honors in January as he averaged 18.5 points, 6.4 rebounds and 1.7 blocked shots per game in a 7-1 month for the Wildcats. The junior forward had five consecutive games with 20-plus points and two double-doubles during the month. Cohen shot 59 percent from the floor, 50 percent from 3-point range and 88 percent from the free-throw line for the month.

Antwaine Wiggins was earned December Athlete of the Month honors in men's basketball. Wiggins led College of Charleston to a 5-2 record in the month. He averaged a team-and conference-leading 18.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Wiggins tied a career-high with 24 points against his home state Tennessee Vols, including 15 in the second half of play. Wiggins also reached a milestone of his own becoming the 29th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points with his jumper at the 8:32 minute mark of the first half at Louisville on Dec. 20.

The Citadel's Mike Groselle was named the SoCon Athlete of the Month for men's basketball in November. Groselle recorded five double-doubles during the month. The junior center hit at least six field goals in all five games, including a 9-for-12 shooting performance against VMI. He averaged 18.2 points and 11.2 rebounds per game in November.

### Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

### Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

## Southern Conference News and Notes

### Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

### Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

### Freshman Honors

UNCG's Trevis Simpson was named to the league's all-freshman team in 2011. It was the third consecutive year that a Spartan was named to the league's all-freshman squad.

- Point guard Kyle Randall was named to the all-freshman team in 2010, while Damian Eargle was selected in 2009.

### Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

### NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the L.A. Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

### Annual Leaders

Furman limited its opponents to just 64.4 points per game last season. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 306 made three-pointers last year, the fifth highest single-season total in league history.

- Elon connected on 285 made triples last season, which tied for the ninth-best single season total.

### SoCon Sports Network

This summer the conference office announced a partnership with Public Television to carry an eight-game Southern Conference men's basketball package. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry the league package. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
- A full list of affiliates and channel locations is available on the Southern Conference website.

## SoCon Championship

The 2012 Southern Conference Men's Basketball Championship will be held March 2-5 in Asheville, N.C., at the newly renovated U.S. Cellular Center. The 2012 tournament will mark a return to Asheville, site of the men's basketball tournament from 1984-95.

The oldest conference tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2012 will mark the 92nd year of the postseason classic.
