## SoCon PLAYER OF THE WEEK (3/20)

### Kaili Phillips, Jr., INF, Chattanooga

Chattanooga's Phillips hit .500, had an on-base percentage of .588 and slugged 1.429 over five games last week as the Mocs went 2-3 on a week-long trip to the state of Florida. On Wednesday, Phillips was 4-for-4 with two home runs, a double, three RBIs and two runs scored in a 7-6 win over Princeton. The Ooltewah, Tennessee, native hit her first homer in the fifth inning to put the team ahead 6-2 and her second of the contest would come in the bottom of the seventh in walk-off fashion to give the Mocs the victory. Later that day, Phillips drew a walk in a 3-1 win over Lehigh. The next day, the junior went 2-for-2 with two RBIs, two runs scored and another home run in a 5-4 setback at FGCU. Chattanooga and FGCU would play a doubleheader on Friday, as the Eagles took game one, 6-0, and game two 4-3. In game two, Phillips was 1-for-3 with a solo home run, a walk, two RBIs and a run scored. Phillips' homer came in the top of the seventh to tie the game at 3 before FGCU would get its second walk-off win against the Mocs in as many days.



## SoCon PITCHER OF THE WEEK (3/20)

### Rhyann Jones, Fr., UNCG

UNCG's Jones had three appearances with two starts last week. After a relief appearance against Notre Dame on Wednesday, the freshman from Daleville, Virginia, had two starts in the Spartan Classic over the weekend and surrendered zero runs. Jones threw five innings in a 9-0 shut-out of Army on Saturday, giving up just three hits and striking out one batter. The next day, Jones tossed four innings and gave up just two hits and struck out four batters as UNCG defeated Gardner-Webb 5-3. For the week, Jones had a 1.85 ERA in 11 1/3 innings pitched.



## NOTES

- Conference play begins this weekend as six of the seven SoCon squads play their first league series. Chattanooga is the lone squad that won't be playing a conference series as the Mocs travel to Virginia Tech for a weekend series.

- UNCG comes into conference play on a five-game winning streak after winning against Towson in walk-off fashion on March 23.

- Samford defeated Ole Miss on March 17 to win its first game against a SEC opponent since defeating Mississippi State on April 4, 2007. The victory was also the Bulldogs' first win against a Power Five team since a 2020 victory over Georgia Tech.

- Chattanooga junior Kaili Phillips was named SoCon player of the week after hitting .500 for the Mocs last week when the team was in Florida for the Madeira Beach Invitational and a three-game series with FGCU.

- UNCG freshman Rhyann Jones became the second Spartan to be named pitcher of the week on Monday. Jones has a 6-1 record with a 2.96 ERA this season in 13 appearances.

- Samford's Logan Champion is leading the league in doubles (10) and total bases (61). Champion is also in the top five in the SoCon in batting average (.374) and hits (34).

- Under first-year head coach Cheryl Milligan, ETSU has seven wins going into SoCon play after winning just eight games all of last season.

- Western Carolina and UNCG went a combined 4-0 versus Big South Opponent Gardner-Webb last week. The Catamounts outscored the Runnin' Bulldogs, 23-7, in a doubleheader on March 21, while the Spartans scored 19 runs to Gardner-Webb's seven in games on March 18 and March 19.

- Chattanooga leads the conference in team batting average (.279) and opposing batting average (.229).
