Quick Hits

- Saturday's game between UNCG and Furman will be televised on the SoCon Sports Network and will be available on ESPN3.
- Larry Hunter earned his 100th win as head coach at Western Carolina Thursday night, becoming the sixth SoCon coach to have at least 100 victories at his current school.
- Georgia Southern won just one league game last season but already has seven victories through 11 conference games this year.
- After dropping 11 straight games, UNCG has won seven in a row and leads the North Division by a half-game over Elon.

Player of the Week

Derrell Armstrong has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for the second consecutive week. The junior averaged 25 points, seven rebounds and three assists in two games last week as the Spartans picked up overtime wins over Appalachian State (77-73) and Western Carolina (89-86).

Armstrong scored 50 points in two games off the bench for the Spartans last week. He tallied a game-high 27 points in UNCG's win over Appalachian State on Thursday night. Armstrong scored 19 points in the second half and overtime against the Mountaineers and was 10-of-20 from the field.

The Mechanicsville, Md., native posted 21 of his 23 points in the second half and overtime against the Catamounts on Saturday. The junior scored 12 of UNCG's 20 points in the extra frame. Armstrong added six rebounds, four assists, three steals and a blocked shot against WCU.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Omar Carter, College of Charleston's Antwaine Wiggins, The Citadel's Mike Groselle, Furman's Brandon Sebirumbi, Georgia Southern's Jelani Hewitt, Chattanooga's Drazen Zlovaric, Samford's Drew Windler, and Wofford's Brad Loesing.

**MOUNTAINEERS**

Nathan Healy scored a team-high 14 points but Appalachian State lost 53-52 to Samford Thursday night. The Mountaineers recorded 15 assists on 20 made baskets against the Bulldogs.

Appalachian State leads the SoCon in three-point field goal percentage (.358). ASU ranks sixth in the league with 7.4 made triples per game.

The Mountaineers host College of Charleston Saturday afternoon. ASU will visit Elon Monday night.

**PHOENIX**

Lucas Troutman and Jack Isenbarger combined for 51 points as Elon held off College of Charleston 99-98 in double overtime Thursday. Troutman scored 26 while Isenbarger added 25. The Phoenix shot 54 percent from the field in the win.

Elon is second in the SoCon in field goal percentage defense (.412) and ranks fifth in defending the three-point line as opponents are shooting just 32 percent from beyond the arc.

The Phoenix welcome The Citadel to Alumni Gym Saturday evening.

**SPARTANS**

UNCG stretched its winning streak to seven games by topping The Citadel 81-72 Thursday. UNCG's seven-game winning streak is the Spartans' longest since the 1995-96 season.

After winning seven games last season, the Spartans have already won nine games in 2011-12.

UNCG travels to Furman Saturday afternoon. The game can be seen on the SoCon Sports Network and will be available on ESPN3. Following the trip to Greenville, S.C., the Spartans will visit Samford Thursday night.

**BULLDOGS**

Tyler Hood scored a game-high 18 points while Jeffrey Merritt narrowly missed a double-double with nine points and 10 rebounds as Samford beat Appalachian State 53-52 Thursday. Merritt also added six assists in the win.

The Bulldogs have made at least one 3-point field goal in 617 consecutive games. The last time that Samford did not make a 3-point basket was on Jan. 19, 1991, against UTSA.

Samford travels to Wofford Saturday afternoon. The Bulldogs host UNCG Thursday.

**MOCS**

Four Mocs scored in double figures in Chattanooga's 82-76 loss at Western Carolina Thursday. Omar Wattad led UTC with 18 points, while Keegan Bell and Dontay Hampton each scored 13. Lance Stocked chipped in 11 points and five rebounds for the Mocs.

Senior guard Ricky Taylor (1,149) is now eight on the Division I era scoring list, just nine points of sole possession of sixth place behind David Phillips (1,157) and Stanford Strickland (1,153).

Chattanooga will travel to Davidson Saturday afternoon. The Mocs will host Elon Thursday.

**CATAMOUNTS**

Brandon Boggs scored 21 points and Tawaski King pulled down 14 rebounds as Western Carolina beat Chattanooga (82-76) Thursday. The Catamounts connected in 15 three-pointers in the win.

Thursday's win gave Larry Hunter his 100th victory as head coach at Western Carolina. Hunter became the sixth SoCon coach to have at least 100 victories at his current school.

The Catamounts welcome Georgia Southern to the Ramsey Center Saturday. WCU travels to College of Charleston February 9.

NORTH DIVISION**COUGARS**

Andrew Lawrence scored a game-high 32 points and Trent Wiedeman added 17 points and 17 rebounds but the Cougars lost in double overtime at Elon, 99-98 Thursday. Matt Sundberg added 13 points off the bench for CofC.

The Cougars will participate in their third consecutive ESPN Sears BracketBusters game traveling to Kent State on Feb. 18 in a rematch of the only meeting between the two which came during the 2003 NIT.

CofC will visit Appalachian State on Saturday. The Cougars host Western Carolina February 9.

**NORTH DIVISION****BULLDOGS**

Mike Groselle scored 20 points and Lawrence Miller added 15 off the bench as The Citadel fell at UNCG, 82-71 Thursday. The Bulldogs connected on 18 of 25 free throw attempts.

Groselle has posted 11 double-doubles this season, moving him within one of Patrick Elmore's single-season school record, 12, that was set during the 1989-90 season.

The Citadel visits Elon Saturday night. The Bulldogs host Davidson February 9.

**NORTH DIVISION****WILDCATS**

De'Mon Brooks scored 19 points and JP Kuhlman added 13 points and five assists as Davidson beat Furman 71-53 Wednesday.

Davidson will host Wichita State in a BracketBusters game Feb. 18, at noon in Belk Arena. The game will be televised live on ESPN or ESPN2.

The Wildcats have won 18 of their last 20 SoCon regular-season games, dating back to last season.

The Wildcats host Chattanooga Saturday night.

**NORTH DIVISION****PALADINS**

Charlie Reddick scored 13 points and Brandon Sebirumbi tallied eight points, eight rebounds and four blocked shots in Wednesday's loss to Davidson.

The Paladins, winners of four of their last six games, have won three consecutive Southern Conference road games for the first time since the 2006-07 season.

Furman plays four of its final seven games at home. The Paladins welcome UNCG to Timmons Arena Saturday afternoon.

**SOUTH DIVISION****EAGLES**

Jelani Hewitt's three-pointer at the buzzer gave GSU a 75-72 win over Chattanooga on Saturday night. Hewitt's three gave him 16 points for the game as he was 4-of-8 from beyond the arc.

The Eagles lead the Southern Conference in field goal shooting (.466). Eric Ferguson leads GSU and ranks fourth in the conference from the floor (.571).

Georgia Southern travels to Western Carolina Saturday night. GSU will then host Furman Monday.

**NORTH DIVISION****TERRIERS**

Wofford has won six games straight to improve to 15-8 on the season. The 15 wins are tied for the most among SoCon teams this season.

Wofford has had a different player lead the team in scoring in the last four games – Kevin Giltner, Karl Cochran, Brad Loesing and Drew Crowell have all paced the Terriers in scoring.

The Terriers host Samford Saturday afternoon. Wofford visits Davidson Monday night.

Conference News and Notes

Point Production

Davidson leads the Southern Conference with 78.5 points per game.

- Either Davidson or College of Charleston has led the league in scoring every year since 2006.

Cousy Nominees

Chattanooga's Keegan Bell, College of Charleston's Andrew Lawrence, Davidson's JP Kuhlman and Western Carolina's Trey Sumler have been named to the Cousy Award Watch List. The Cousy Award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

Athletes of the Month

Jake Cohen earned Player of the Month honors in January as he averaged 18.5 points, 6.4 rebounds and 1.7 blocked shots per game in a 7-1 month for the Wildcats. The junior forward had five consecutive games with 20-plus points and two double-doubles during the month. Cohen shot 59 percent from the floor, 50 percent from 3-point range and 88 percent from the free-throw line for the month.

Antwaine Wiggins was earned December Athlete of the Month honors in men's basketball. Wiggins led College of Charleston to a 5-2 record in the month. He averaged a team-and conference-leading 18.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Wiggins tied a career-high with 24 points against his home state Tennessee Vols, including 15 in the second half of play. Wiggins also reached a milestone of his own becoming the 29th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points with his jumper at the 8:32 minute mark of the first half at Louisville on Dec. 20.

The Citadel's Mike Groselle was named the SoCon Athlete of the Month for men's basketball in November. Groselle recorded five double-doubles during the month. The junior center hit at least six field goals in all five games, including a 9-for-12 shooting performance against VMI. He averaged 18.2 points and 11.2 rebounds per game in November.

Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

Southern Conference News and Notes

Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

Freshman Honors

UNCG's Trevis Simpson was named to the league's all-freshman team in 2011. It was the third consecutive year that a Spartan was named to the league's all-freshman squad.

- Point guard Kyle Randall was named to the all-freshman team in 2010, while Damian Eargle was selected in 2009.

Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the L.A. Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

Annual Leaders

Furman limited its opponents to just 64.4 points per game last season. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 306 made three-pointers last year, the fifth highest single-season total in league history.

- Elon connected on 285 made triples last season, which tied for the ninth-best single season total.

SoCon Sports Network

This summer the conference office announced a partnership with Public Television to carry an eight-game Southern Conference men's basketball package. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry the league package. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
- A full list of affiliates and channel locations is available on the Southern Conference website.

The oldest conference tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2012 will mark the 92nd year of the postseason classic.
