NOTES

• Conference play begins on Thursday with ETSU traveling to Western Carolina. The remaining seven squads open conference play on Friday.

• The Citadel and Chattanooga are each off to the best start in its program's history. The Bulldogs are 12-0, sitting as one of just six teams in the country that are undefeated. The Mocs are off to their best start since 1987 when the team started 6-1 en route to a SoCon Tournament championship.

• SoCon teams went 54-50 in nonconference play. Wofford's win over Virginia on Sept. 16 was the league's lone Power Five win during the year.

• Four conference teams - The Citadel, Furman, Wofford and Chattanooga - finished the first four weeks with a winning percentage above .750.

• Wofford leads the conference in opponent hitting percentage (.145), total blocks (103) and blocks per set (2.45). The Terriers duo of middle blockers, Sarah Barham and Millie Loehr, are the only conference players that average over one block per set.

• Furman finished the 2022 regular season with eight wins. The Paladins went on a run to the SoCon Tournament final last season and have rode that momentum to nine wins before league play begins.

• The Citadel's Ali Ruffin is in the top 10 in the NCAA in five categories, including total kills (206), kills per set (4.68) and points (229.5). Gracie Lynn Butler of Samford is also in the top 10 in kills per set (4.60) and total kills (198) in the NCAA.

• Wofford head coach Lynze Roos won her 300th career match against Virginia last Saturday. Two other SoCon coaches are on the verge of milestones with Furman's Michelle Young two wins away from 400 and Chattanooga's Julie Torbett Thomas four wins away from 500.

• The 2023 #SoConVB Championship, hosted by Wofford, will take place Nov. 17-19 and will feature eight league teams. There will be a match on Nov. 13 or 14 between the No. 8 and No. 9 seed to begin the SoCon tournament.

ETSU TABBED AS PRESEASON SOCON VOLLEYBALL FAVORITE

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – ETSU was picked as the favorite to win the 2023 Southern Conference volleyball title in preseason voting by the league’s nine head coaches with a selection that came down-to-the-wire. The coaches also selected an eight-member preseason all-conference team.

Coaches were not allowed to vote for their own teams or players in the balloting.

ETSU, the defending SoCon regular-season champion, received five first-place votes and 58 points to claim the top spot in the preseason poll. Samford, the defending SoCon Tournament champion, collected two first-place votes and finished only one point behind the Buccaneers with 57 points. Wofford claimed 52 points and the final two first-place votes to place third. Western Carolina’s 40 points placed the Catamounts fourth and Chattanooga finished with 35 points to come in fifth. The Citadel followed in sixth with 27 points and Mercer was seventh with 24 points. Furman (19) and UNCG (12) rounded out the field in eighth and ninth, respectively.

The Buccaneers are coming off a 21-8 overall record in 2022 and a 15-1 mark in conference play. ETSU is under the direction of first-year head coach Dr. Bruce Atkinson and will be led by preseason all-conference team members Lundyn Coffman and Brianna Cantrell. In 2022, Coffman was on the first-team all-conference squad and Cantrell, the reigning Rayna Taylor Freshman of the Year, was on the second team after last season. Coffman, a graduate student middle blocker, finished 2022 third in the conference in blocks per set (1.08) and seventh in hitting percentage (.275). Cantrell, who is a sophomore outside hitter, led ETSU in kills a season ago with 300, which was ninth in the SoCon.

Samford, who finished last season 11-5 in conference play and 19-13 overall, placed junior outside hitter Gracie Lynn Butler and junior libero/defensive specialist Kate Morgan on the preseason team. Butler, who was a second-team all-conference and all-tournament performer last season, was seventh in the conference in kills per set at 2.92. Morgan was also on the second team following the 2022 season as she was second in the SoCon in service aces (49) and digs (520).

Wofford had an 8-8 mark in conference play and a 16-13 overall record in 2022. The Terriers put senior middle blocker Sarah Barham on the preseason team. Barham, a second-team all-conference performer after the 2022 season, was second in the league in hitting percentage (.333) and blocks per set (1.11).

Western Carolina completed the 2022 season with a 10-6 record in league play and 20-13 overall record en route to an appearance in the quarterfinals of the National Invitational Volleyball Championship (NIVC). Junior outside hitter Bailey Hartsough and senior middle blocker Eden Punch represent the Catamounts on the preseason team. In 2022, Hartsough was fifth in the conference in service aces per set (0.35) and Punch was fourth in blocks per set (1.06).

Chattanooga was 10-6 in SoCon play and 17-16 overall in 2022 as the Mocs advanced to the SoCon Tournament semifinals. The Citadel, who were 11-19 overall and 4-12 in SoCon matches in 2022, placed outside hitter Ali Ruffin on the preseason team. Ruffin, a first-team all-conference member a season ago, led the league in kills per set (3.90) last season.

Last season, Mercer finished 10-19 overall and 6-10 in league action, Furman was 11-19 overall and 4-12 in conference play and UNCG was 10-20 overall and 4-12 in SoCon matches.

The 2023 regular season begins on Friday, Aug. 25, with all nine teams in action.

Following a first-round game between the No. 8 and No. 9 seeds on Nov. 13 or 14, the SoCon Volleyball Championship will be hosted by Wofford on Nov. 17-19. The quarterfinals are slated for Nov. 17 and the semifinal matches will be held on Nov. 18 with the final on Nov. 19.

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – The Southern Conference named its volleyball players of the week on Monday for matches played Sept. 11-17. Samford outside hitter Gracie Lynn Butler was named the Offensive Player of the Week and Wofford defensive specialist/libero Abbey Richman was designated Defensive Player of the Week, while Chattanooga's Elaine Redman was tabbed Setter of the Week. The players of the week are selected by the league office.

Butler averaged 4.55 kills per set as Samford went 1-2 last week. The Bulldogs defeated cross-town foe UAB in four sets on Wednesday, before dropping matches to South Alabama in three sets and 24th-ranked Auburn in four sets during the Alabama Showdown on Friday and Saturday, respectively. Against UAB, Butler had a career-high 23 kills, along with eight digs, three assists and one ace. In the contest with South Alabama, the junior finished with 13 kills, nine digs and two blocks. The Hazel Green, Alabama, product had her third career double-double against Auburn, finishing with 14 kills, 11 digs, one ace and a block. Butler is currently sixth in the NCAA in total kills (198) and ninth in kills per set (4.60).

Richman, who also received the honor on Sept. 4, anchored the Wofford defense, averaging 4.22 digs per set. The Terriers went 2-0 last weekend during the Jefferson Cup Invitational in Charlottesville, Virginia, defeating George Washington in five sets and ACC opponent Virginia in four sets. The native of Carmel, Indiana, recorded 19 digs, seven assists and one ace against George Washington on Friday. The senior followed that up with another 19 digs, two assists and an ace against Virginia on Saturday, marking the first win of any SoCon team against a Power Five opponent this season. Richman became the 18th Terrier to record 1,000 digs in their career during the match with Virginia, a contest that also gave Wofford head coach Lynze Roos her 300th career victory.

Redman averaged 10.33 assists per set to pace the Chattanooga offense as the team went 3-1 last week. The Mocs won at Jacksonville State in four sets on Tuesday before winning two matches during the Chattanooga Classic. In the contest with Jacksonville State, the junior had 41 assists, 15 digs, two aces and two kills. On Friday, the Chattanooga, Tennessee, native had 33 assists, five digs, three kills and three blocks in a sweep of Eastern Michigan. Later that day, Redman had 34 assists, 12 digs, one kill and an ace in a 3-0 win over Morehead State. In the final match of the weekend on Saturday, the Mocs fell to Gardner-Webb in five sets, with Redman logging 47 assists, five digs, four blocks, two kills and an ace.

Samford (5-7) hosts UNCG (1-10) on Sept. 22, and The Citadel (12-0) on Sept. 23. Wofford (9-2) travels to Mercer (4-7) on Sept. 22, and Chattanooga (11-3) on Sept. 23. The Mocs welcome The Citadel on Sept. 22.
