### Quick Hits

• After winning the Southern Conference tournament last week, Wofford is making its fourth trip to the NCAA tournament in the last six years as the Terriers won the Southern Conference tournament in 2010, 2011 and 2014.

• Wofford earned the No. 12 seed in the West region. It is the highest seed for a Southern Conference team since Davidson advanced to the Elite Eight as the No. 10 seed in the Midwest region in 2008.

• Mercer finished the regular season 18-15 (12-6 SoCon). The Bears accepted an invite to the CBI and are making their fourth straight postseason appearance after playing in the CIT (2012), NIT (2013) and NCAA tournament (2014).

## Conference News and Notes

### One-Possession Games

Southern Conference teams played 90 league games during the regular season. Twenty-three games (26 percent) have been decided by one possession or went into overtime.

- In 2014 the league had 17 of 88 (19 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2013 the league had 30 of 108 (28 percent) conference games decided by one possession.
- In 2012 the league had 32 of 108 (30 percent) conference games decided by one possession.

### Athletes of the Month

Western Carolina guard James Sinclair averaged 19.3 points and 5.7 rebounds in six November games to help the Catamounts to a 3-3 mark. Sinclair opened the season with four straight 20-plus games, scoring 20 in a 10-point loss at Mississippi State to open the season. He followed that up with a career night in another close loss at an SEC opponent, scoring 31 points in an 80-74 setback at Alabama. The senior from Savannah, Ga., then led WCU to its first win of the season with 25 points and nine rebounds against Hiwassee before capping his 20-point spurt with an even 20 and another nine boards in a double-overtime win at Oakland in the CBE Hall of Fame Classic. For the month, Sinclair was second in the SoCon in scoring and steals per game (2.2). He was the SoCon Player of the Week on Nov. 18.

Furman guard Stephen Croone averaged 20.1 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game for the Paladins in December, highlighted by a season-high 33 points in a Dec. 6 win over Samford. The Covington, Ga., junior scored in double digits in all seven games, eclipsing 20 points three times. In addition to the 33 points against the Bulldogs, Croone also notched 25 and 23 in road losses to Minnesota and TCU, respectively. He had a team-high eight rebounds in contests against Liberty and Florida Gulf Coast and added six boards and five steals against Samford. Croone had at least three steals in five games in the month. For the month, he shot an even 50 percent from the floor, going 39-for-78, and was 15-for-37 (40.5 percent) from 3-point range.

Chattanooga guard Casey Jones averaged 16.4 points and 8.4 rebounds per game in January, helping the Mocs to a 7-2 record, all in SoCon play. The junior from New Orleans, La., turned in four 20-point outings in the month and had 11 or more rebounds four times, as well. Jones opened the month with consecutive 20-plus efforts, scoring 20 points and pulling down 11 rebounds in a win over Furman before dropping 21 points with seven boards in a four-point loss to Wofford. He followed that with 18 points and 13 rebounds in a win over Western Carolina that started a five-game winning streak for the Mocs. He narrowly missed another double-double with nine points and 11 boards in a win over ETSU but hit the game-winning 3-pointer from 25 feet to stun the Bucs in overtime. The junior had a monster game against Mercer, scoring a career-best 24 points and pulling down a career-high 15 rebounds in an overtime loss. He capped his month with 23 points and three blocked shots in a win over The Citadel. Jones shot 53.2 percent from the floor (58-for-109) in the month and was named the SoCon Player of the Week for games the final week of January.

### Schedule Adjustment

With ten teams in the SoCon, league teams played an 18-game double-round robin conference schedule this season. League teams played 18 conference games from 2007-13, but this year marked the first time since the 1993-94 that SoCon teams played a double-round robin schedule.

## Southern Conference News and Notes

### Sudden Impact

Furman's Devin Sibley was named the league's Freshman of the Year by the conference's coaches this season. Sibley became the first Paladin to earn the award since Quan Prowell in 2004.

### Coach of the Year

Wofford head coach Mike Young was named the league's Coach of the Year by his peers for the second consecutive season. It was the third time Young has been named the league's top coach after also winning the award in 2010.

### Defensive Presence

Chattanooga's Justin Tuoyo was named the league's Defensive Player of the Year. Tuoyo recorded 104 blocked shots this season, the second-highest single-season total in league history. It is the second time in as many seasons that a Moc has earned the award after Z. Mason took home the same honor in 2014.

### Annual Leaders

Wofford limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game this season. It was the fourth straight year the Terriers led the Southern Conference in scoring defense. The 59.8 points allowed tied for the fourth-lowest mark in league history.

### Close Encounters

Southern Conference teams lost 13 nonconference games in 2013-14 that were decided by one possession or went into overtime. Conversely, league teams won just six contests that were decided by a single possession or went into overtime.

- SoCon teams are 7-6 this season in games decided by one possession or that went into overtime.

### Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 966, 10 points higher than the national average of 956 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the sixth consecutive year that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate.

- The Southern Conference's APR score of 966 in men's basketball was the seventh-highest among all Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 28. Southern Conference men's basketball earned a 83, topping the Division I average of 72.

### Digital Network

The Southern Conference launched the SoCon Digital Network during the summer of 2014. All men's and women's basketball home games not selected for broadcast television will be available through the league's digital platform, which is available on computers, smartphones and tablets. Live games, on-demand content and features are all available at [socondigitalnetwork.com](http://socondigitalnetwork.com).

### Preseason Honors

Wofford was picked to win the 2014-15 Southern Conference championship in preseason balloting conducted by the league's head coaches. The Terriers return all five starters and 11 lettermen from last season's team that went 20-13 and earned a trip to the NCAA tournament.

- Chattanooga was picked second and earned two first-place votes while ETSU was tabbed third.
- Wofford's Karl Cochran was named the league's preseason Player of the Year and was joined on the preseason all-conference team by teammates Spencer Collins and Lee Skinner. Eight of the league's ten teams had at least one player on the preseason all-conference team.

### Conference Tournament

The 2015 Southern Conference Tournament presented by General Shale was held March 6-9 in Asheville, N.C., at the U.S. Cellular Center. The oldest conference tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2015 marked the 95th year of the postseason classic.
