PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Demetrius Nelson The Citadel

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - The Citadel's Demetrius Nelson has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games February 3-9 the league office announced Tuesday (Feb. 10). Nelson led the team in scoring in wins over Appalachian State (74-72) and Western Carolina (75-66). He averaged 25.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and made 63 percent of his field goal attempts last week.

The senior center tallied a career-high 29 points in The Citadel's win at Western Carolina Saturday. Earlier in the week he posted a team-high 22 points at Appalachian State. Nelson was one rebound away from a double-double in both games. He connected on 16-of-27 (.593) field goal attempts and shot 83 percent from the free throw line. Nelson is sixth in the league in scoring (15.8 ppg) and 14th in rebounding (6.1rpg). He ranks second in the league in field goal percentage (.596) and tenth in free throw percentage (.785).

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- The Mountaineers have won four of their last six games after Saturday's 77-63 triumph at Elon. Donald Sims has averaged 15.7 points per game over that stretch, while Kellen Brand scored 16.7 points per contest. Isaac Butts has pulled down 11.5 boards per game.
- Appalachian State was paired against Winthrop in the

2009 ESPNU BracketBuster. The Mountaineers have participated in the event each of the past two seasons and are 1-1.

- ASU visits The Citadel Thursday night. The Mountaineers then travel to take on Western Carolina Saturday afternoon.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Chattanooga is now 10-2 this season when leading with five minutes to play and just 2-11 when trailing at that juncture. Both wins while trailing came on the last road trip at Wofford and Furman, while one of the two losses when leading happened at Furman last week.
- Senior Stephen McDowell made his 100th three-

pointer of the season at Samford. He is one three pointer (208) shy of breaking the Mocs career mark for treys made of 209 by Keddrick Mays (2006-07). McDowell is the only Moc to make at least 100 triples in more than one season.

- The Mocs Elon and UNC Greensboro this week.

ELON PHOENIX



- Senior guard Brett James continues to climb Elon's career scoring chart. James now ranks 17th in program history with 1,220 points. He ranks second in the conference in blocked shots (1.5 spg) and fourth in steals (1.7 spg).
- With Elon's 57-54 victory at Georgia Southern last

week, the Phoenix won back-to-back road games for the first time since Jan. 4 and 9, 2006 when Elon won at Wofford (64-61) and Chattanooga (92-74).

- The Phoenix will travel to Chattanooga and Samford this week.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Junior forward Ben Stywall is averaging 15.1 ppg and 9.7 rpg in 14 league games this season. Stywall is also shooting 59 percent from the floor in league play. He is averaging 12.1 points per game for the season.
- The Spartans have been one of the top teams in the league defensively this season. UNC Greensboro is

fourth in the conference in three point field goal defense, allowing its opponents to shoot just 34 percent from beyond the arc. The Spartans are second in the conference in blocked shots, averaging 3.7 blocks per game.

- UNC Greensboro visits Samford and Chattanooga this week.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- In Monday's loss to Chattanooga, Josh Davis tallied a season-high 21 points and connected on a career-high seven three-pointers. All of the Davis' points came from beyond the arc as he finished 7-of-17 from 3-point range. He also scored 15 of his 21 points in the first half.

- Samford has only played in three games this season that were decided by five points or less. The remaining 20 games featured an outcome of at least six points or more.
- Samford hosts UNC Greensboro and Elon this week.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- The Catamounts are 6-1 at home in league play and are 1-5 on the road in the conference. Western Carolina is tied with Davidson for the best home mark in league play this season.
- The Catamounts lead the conference and are 10th in the nation in steals per game (9.5 spg). Junior Brigham Waginger (2.3 spg) and freshman Harouna Mutombo (2.0 spg) rank second and third, respectively, in steals in the league.

- Western Carolina visits College of Charleston Wednesday night. The Catamounts will host rival Appalachian State Saturday.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- College of Charleston has one of the top offenses in the league. The Cougars rank second in scoring (78.4 ppg), second in scoring margin (+4.4), and lead the league in field goal percentage (.477).
- Sophomore Andrew Goudelock is fourth in the league

in scoring (16.6 ppg). He has led the Cougars in scoring 12 times this season. Goudelock also ranks fourth in the conference in three-point percentage (.440)

- The Cougars host Western Carolina Wednesday night.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- With 2,350 career points, junior Stephen Curry is fifth all-time on the Southern Conference's career scoring list. Curry needs 74 points to move past Gay Elmore (VMI, 1983-87) into fourth place.
- Davidson has been one of the top defensive teams in the league this season. The Wildcats yield just 66.4

points per game to their opponents and have limited the opposition to just 40 percent shooting from the field.

- The Wildcats visit Wofford Thursday night. Davidson then travels to face Furman Saturday afternoon.

FURMAN PALADINS



- Sophomore Bryson Barnes has scored in double figures in five of Furman's last seven games, including a personal-best 16 points at Elon Monday night. Barnes is averaging 9.2 points and 4.4 rebounds per game in Southern Conference play.
- Sophomore guard Jordan Miller is 12th in the confer-

ence in scoring. Miller is averaging 14.0 points per game and also ranks seventh in the conference in free throw percentage (.819). He has been Furman's leading scorer in 14 of 23 games this year.

- The Paladins host Georgia Southern Thursday night in Greenville, S.C.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Freshman Ben Drayton is shooting 54.9 percent from the field in league play and 53.2 percent from three-point range against conference opponents. He is averaging 12.9 points per game in league play.
- Head coach Jeff Price is just two wins shy of 300 for

his career. Price, in his 16th season as a head coach, has captured 164 wins at Georgia Southern, the 13th-highest win total among all coaches to coach at a Southern Conference school.

- Georgia Southern visits Furman Thursday night. The Eagles travel to face Wofford Saturday.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Citadel has won seven straight games for the first time since the 1978-79 season. The Bulldogs have also strung together seven consecutive wins in league play, the first time that has happened in school history.
- The last time the Bulldogs won at 10 conference games was

during the 1984-85 season under head coach Les Robinson, who guided the team to an 11-5 mark. With one more conference victory the Bulldogs will tie the school record for the most league wins.

- The Bulldogs host Appalachian State Thursday. The Citadel visits College of Charleston Saturday.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- After being out-rebounded in six of its last seven games, Wofford has held a rebounding advantage in back to back wins over Samford and UNC Greensboro to move to +1.6 on the season.
- The Terriers are 6-0 this season when shooting over 50 percent from the field. Conversely, Wofford is 0-7 this

year when allowing its opponents to shoot better than 50 percent from the floor. The Terriers are shooting 45 percent from the field this season.

- Wofford hosts Davidson Thursday night. The Terriers welcome Georgia Southern Saturday.

CONFERENCE NOTES

RPI STRENGTH

The Southern Conference ranks 22nd in the Men's Basketball RPI Report, released February 2. The league has garnered the most difficult strength of schedule rating among 31 Division I conferences. Davidson (50) and College of Charleston (120) rank in the top 150.

STREAKING

Davidson had its 43-game conference winning streak snapped by College of Charleston, 77-75, on February 7. The Wildcats won their final 10 games during league play in 2006-07, before posting a 20-0 mark last year. Davidson's streak of 43 games was the second-longest consecutive wins streak in league history.

- West Virginia won a league-best 44 straight conference games from 1956-1960. North Carolina won 34 straight league games from 1923-25.

TWO FOR THREE

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Southern Conference teams took on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams participated in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

- SoCon teams participated in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

BRACKETBUSTERS 2009

ESPNU announced the pairings for the 2009 BracketBusters event (Feb. 20-21) on February 2. Davidson will host Butler in a game to be televised on the ESPN family of networks. Georgia Southern will host Jacksonville State on February 21. Elon will visit UNC Wilmington, while Appalachian State travels to Winthrop.

- The SoCon is 8-8 all time in BracketBuster games, including a 3-1 mark in 2007.

CONFERENCE NOTES

TOURNEY TIME

The 2009 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 6-9 at The McKenzie Arena in Chattanooga. All 12 members of the Southern Conference will take part in the conference tournament. The championship game, scheduled for March 9, will be televised by ESPN2.

- The 2009 tournament will be the second time the league has held its conference championship in Chattanooga, after using the same site in 2005. The host Mocs downed UNC Greensboro, 65-62, in the final that year.

HALL OF FAME

The Southern Conference announced the inaugural Hall of Fame class for 2009. Sam Huff (Football - West Virginia), Arnold Palmer (Golf - Wake Forest), Jerry West (Basketball - West Virginia), Megan Dunigan (Tennis - Furman), Dick Groat (Basketball/Baseball - Duke), Charlie Justice (Football - North Carolina), Melissa Morrison Howard (Track & Field - Appalachian State), Adrian Peterson (Football - Georgia Southern), Frank Selvy (Tennis - Furman), and Valorie Whiteside (Basketball - Appalachian State).

- The league will induct its inaugural class during a ceremony at the Chapman Cultural Center in Spartanburg, S.C., on May 4.

EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH

All 12 head coaches return to the bench for 2008-09. The current league head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

- Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

EXPERIENCE ON THE COURT

The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

- Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 leagues schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season will mark the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

PRESEASON PLAUDITS

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.

NEW MEMBERSHIP

Samford University, located in Birmingham, Ala., begins its first season as a member of the Southern Conference after officially joining the league on July 1, 2008. The Bulldogs, who play their home games in the 5,000-seat Pete Hanna Center, finished last season 14-16, including a 10-10 mark in Ohio Valley conference play.
