GSU's Graham and Davidson's Curry Share SoCon Honors

Georgia Southern **Louis Graham** and Davidson's **Stephen Curry** were named the Southern Conference Co-Players of the Week for the week ending February 4.

Graham averaged 26.0 points in games against Western Carolina and Chattanooga last week. He was 18-of-32 (56.3 percent) from the field and 16-of-21 (76.2 percent) from the line. He grabbed 12 rebounds and had five steals. He set a career-high with 27 points on Jan. 31 at Chattanooga.

Curry averaged 29.0 points leading the Wildcats to wins over Wofford (78-65 on Jan. 30) and Chattanooga 78-71 on Feb. 2). The sophomore made 18-of-38 (47.4 percent) from the field, 10-of-22 (45.5 percent) from three-point range and 12-of-14 (85.7 percent) from the line. Curry is fifth in the nation in scoring, averaging 24.4 points per game.

Other standout performances were turned in by Chattanooga's Kevin Bridgewaters, Western Carolina's Brandon Giles, UNC Greensboro's Dwayne Johnson, Elon's Brett James and Wofford's Drew Gibson.

Tournament Seeding Procedures

The team with the best overall conference won-loss percentage in the North and South Divisions shall receive the top two seeds in the conference tournament. Other seeds for the tournament shall be determined based on each team's overall Conference won-loss percentage regardless of division finish. In the event of a tie for a particular seed, the seed, the seed shall be determined as follows:

- A. If one team has defeated the other team twice, that team shall be awarded the higher seeded position;
- B. If each team has won one game against the other, the higher position will be awarded to the team that has the best won-loss record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie;
- C. If each team has the same record against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie, then the won-loss record against the next highest seeded team not involved in the tie, would be considered and so on down the line until the tie is broken;
- D. If the records are the same against all teams, then the tie would be broken by comparing each team's Rating Percentage Index (RPI) as published by RPIratings.com after the completion of the last regular season game;
- E. In the event of a three-way tie, the won-loss record of the tied teams against each other is first considered;
- F. If the teams are still tied, the team's records against the highest seeded team not involved in the tie is considered and so forth until the tie is broken;
- G. If there is still a tie, the seeded position of the teams will be determined by comparing each team's RPI ratings as published by RPIratings.com,
- H. For multiple ties larger than a three-way tie, the same procedure will be applied as used to break a three-way tie; and
- I. For all multiple ties, the tie is broken by first deciding the highest seeded team involved in the tie before deciding other seeding positions.



NORTH DIVISION

Appalachian State



■ After playing three of the last four games on the road, Appalachian State begins a three-game homestand with on Feb. 7 when the Mountaineers host College of Charleston in Boone, N.C. Coach Houston Fancher's team hosts The Citadel on Feb. 9 and Wofford on Feb. 11.

■ The Mountaineers have won nine of their last 10 games dating back to Jan. 3. Only three teams in the nation won more games than the Mountaineers in January.

■ Jeremy Clayton's block at Western Carolina gave him sole possession of first place in the Appalachian State record book with 194 career blocks. The 194 rejections rank seventh in SoCon history. Clayton's 49 blocks this season are the eighth-most in a season in school history.

■ Appalachian State will host Niagara in the Bracketbusters on Feb. 23 in Boone, N.C.

Elon



■ Junior guard Brett James collected his first double-double of the season with 16 points and 10 rebounds at Appalachian State on Jan. 28.

■ In two contests last week, James averaged 16.5 points and 7.5 rebounds while shooting 52.0 percent from the field (13-of-25) and 83.3 percent from the free throw line (5-of-6).

■ The Phoenix are on the road this week. Following a 74-64 loss at Davidson on Feb. 6, Elon plays with games at Wofford (Feb. 9). Elon downed Wofford in the first meeting between the two teams this year, 66-57, on Dec. 15.

■ Elon will host UT-Martin in Bracketbusters on Saturday, Feb. 23.

UNC Greensboro



■ The Spartans have won 10 of their last 12 contests. The 29-point (89-60) win over Elon was the largest margin of victory in the series since 1974-75. The Spartans play at Georgia Southern on Feb. 4 in their next outing. UNC Greensboro stopped the Eagles, 79-67, on Jan. 5 in the first meeting between the two teams this season.

■ Kyle Hines scored 21 points with 11 boards for his 41st career double-double against the Phoenix. It marked his 100th career game scoring in double figures. Hines also has 307 career blocked shots.

■ Senior guard Dwayne Johnson scored 17 points on 6-of-7 shooting from the field in the win over Elon. He was 2-for-2 from three-point range with five assists.

Chattanooga



■ Senior point guard Kevin Bridgewaters had made 21 consecutive free throws before missing against Davidson on Feb. 2. He has made 27-of-29 (93.1 percent) from the line the last three games.

■ Showing balanced scoring, the Mocs have had four or more double-digit scorers in each of the last three contests.

■ Junior forward Nichaeus Doaks scored a career-high 26 points --- with 11 boards --- against Davidson on Feb. 2.

Western Carolina



■ Sophomore guard Brandon Giles averaged 18.0 points last week, stretching his streak of double-digit scoring games to 12.

■ Western Carolina wraps up a three-game homestand by hosting Chattanooga on Feb. 4. The Catamounts have dropped 11 of the last 12 meetings with the Mocs dating back to 2000 including an 88-55 decision on Jan. 12.

■ The Western Carolina roster is down to just eight players meaning increased playing time. Brandon Giles averaged 34.5 minutes past game last week.



SOUTH DIVISION

College of Charleston



■ The Cougars enter their Feb. 4 home date with The Citadel having lost four consecutive games. They have not lost five straight since 1978-79 when the Cougars finished 11-17 under coach Alan LeForce. The Cougars have lost two consecutive home games for the first time since 1988-89.

■ Andrew Goudelock is second on the Cougars roster in scoring with 12.9 ppg. His 271 total points is the fourth highest total for a Cougar freshman since the move to Division I in 1991-92.

■ With a 63-48 win on Feb. 4, College of Charleston has won the last 15 meetings with crosstown rival The Citadel at Kresse Arena.



The Citadel

■ The Citadel lost the first two of a four-game road trip to Furman (53-51 on Jan. 31) and College of Charleston (63-48 on Feb. 4). The Bulldogs play at, Appalachian State (Feb. 9) and Elon (Feb. 11).

■ The Bulldogs are 5-8 at home and 0-7 on enemy courts this season.



Davidson

■ Davidson has won 12 consecutive games and 24 straight SoCon regular-season contests and 37 of its last 38 against SoCon competition. The Wildcats are 13-0 in league play for the third time in coach Bob McKillop's tenure.

■ Sophomore Stephen Curry averaged 29.0 points with 10 assists and eight rebounds as the Wildcats downed Wofford (78-65) and Chattanooga (78-71) last week. He scored 36 against Elon on Feb. 6.

■ Jason Richards leads the nation in assists with 8.2 per contest.

■ Winthrop will host Davidson in a nationally televised Bracketbusters game in on Friday, Feb. 22.



Furman

■ Furman claimed its 10th win in the last 11 meetings with The Citadel when the Paladins downed the Bulldogs, 53-51, on Jan. 30 in Greenville, S.C.

■ The Paladins have proven to be slow starters. Furman has failed to score in the opening minutes of three of the last four contests. Appalachian State raced to an 8-0 lead; Georgia Southern built a 9-0 advantage and Wofford scored the game's first 13 points against the Paladins.

■ Furman has topped 67 points just once in the last 10 contests.



Georgia Southern

■ Louis Graham set a career-high with 27 points on Jan. 31 at Chattanooga. Since Jan. 3, Graham is averaging 20.3 points and has scored 20 or more points six times in nine games.

■ Dwayne Foreman scored a career-high 23 points with 7-of-15 shooting from three-point range.

■ Foreman needs two assists to set a school career record in the category. He has 529 career assists, one short of Charlton Young's (1989-93) mark of 530.

■ Georgia Southern will play at Austin Peay in Bracketbusters in Saturday, Feb. 23.



Wofford

■ The Terriers completed a stretch of five games in a 10-day span by posting a 4-1 mark. Wofford plays at UNC Greensboro (Feb. 7) and hosts Elon (Feb. 9) this week.

■ Senior guard Drew Gibson shot 60.0 percent from the field (15-of-25) including 4-of-8 from three-point range in three games last week.

■ The 33-point margin in Wofford's 75-42 triumph over Furman on Feb. 2 was the largest margin of victory for the Terriers in the 100 years of the rivalry between the two teams.

Birmingham, Ala.-based Samford University will join the Southern Conference on July 1, 2008. The addition of the Bulldogs will bring league membership to 12 for all sports and nine for football. Coach Jimmy Tillette's team was 15-16 in 2006-07 with an RPI of 76. Samford currently competes in the Ohio Valley Conference. The Bulldogs are 11-12 (8-7 in the OVC) as of Feb. 4, 2008. The Bulldogs beat Eastern Illinois, 65-52, on Feb. 2 and play at Austin Peay on Feb. 9.
