Davidson Wins 2007 SoCon Tournament



Davidson College defeated College of Charleston 72-65 to win its ninth Southern Conference Tournament title and the league's automatic NCAA Tournament berth.

Tournament MVP Stephen Curry led Davidson to its second-straight SoCon crown with a game-high 29 points. Boris Meno had 14 points and 10 boards and a game-sealing dunk in the final 30 seconds. Jermaine Johnson and David Lawrence each had 13 points for the Cougars who fell before a North Charleston Coliseum record crowd of 8,009.

Davidson shot just 37 percent in the win, but 82 percent from the free-throw line with 20 points scored off of CofC's 21 turnovers. The Cougars made good on 51 percent of their field goal attempts.

Davidson jumped out to a 7-3 lead to open the game before CofC scored nine-straight points to take a 12-7 lead six minutes into the contest. Davidson chipped away at the lead via a 9-0 run to briefly assume a six-point, 24-19 lead before the Cougars scored 11 of the next 13 points. Curry ended that run, scoring 10 of Davidson's final 10 points to give the 'Cats a 37-35 at halftime.

The 'Cats extended their lead to seven, 42-35, in the opening minutes of the second half on five points from Meno and maintained that lead until a 12-3 CofC run gave the Cougars brief a 50-48 lead with 12:23 left the play. The lead swapped hands three times with two ties over the next seven minutes until a three-point play from Meno gave Davidson a three-point, 62-59, advantage with 4:27 left. Two free-throws from Meno, followed by his press-breaking dunk put DC up seven with 25 seconds left to guarantee the Wildcats the 2007 SoCon Tournament title.

NCAA Tournament

No. 4 Maryland 82, No. 13 Davidson 70



BUFFALO, N.Y. — Wildcat freshman Stephen Curry poured in a game-high 30 points, but Maryland placed six players in double figures to hold off 13th-seeded Davidson, 82-70, in the first round of the 2007 NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament at the HSBC Arena in Buffalo, N.Y. The Wildcats conclude the season with a school record 29 wins against just five losses, while Maryland advances to meet Butler in the next round with an overall mark of 25-8.

A 6-1 shooting guard from Charlotte, N.C., Curry connected on 9-of-21 shots from the floor, including five jumpers from behind the arc to reach the 30-point plateau for the fourth time this year. The son of former NBA sharpshooter Dell Curry, Stephen (pronounced STEFF-in) concluded his debut season in a Wildcat uniform with 730 points (21.5 ppg.) to lead the Southern Conference, and an NCAA freshman single-season record 122 three-pointers.



Maryland's starting five each finished in double figures, led by Mike Jones' 17 points and three long-range buckets. The other starters for the Terps that added at least 10 points were James Gist (12), D.J. Strawberry (12), Ekene Ibekwe (11) and Greivis Vasquez (10), while Bambale Osby contributed 11 in 21 minutes off the bench.

Ibake led all-players with 10 boards, including seven on the offensive end, to finish with a double-double as Maryland outrebounded Davidson, 54-35.

Davidson hit just 3-of-17 (17.6 percent) from three-point range and only made 29.4 percent of its overall attempts in the second half to finish its second straight appearance in the "Big Dance" with a 34.3 field goal percentage. The Terrapins, who have now won eight straight first-round NCAA games, shot 45.6 percent and 6-of-17 (35.3 percent) from the outside.

Curry and the Wildcats began the second half with a flurry as the frosh nailed a trifecta and followed with a layup to start a 9-0 run, giving Davidson its second eight-point lead of the contest, 52-44, with 17:32 left. Just like the opening stanza, Maryland responded in a flash scoring the next eight points to tie the game for a seventh and final time.

A Boris Meno jumper with just over 10 minutes to play put the margin back in favor of the 'Cats, but that's the last time they would lead as Maryland got back-to-back buckets from Osby to go up 62-59. The Wildcats cut the deficit to one on two separate occasions, but managed just two field goals, both from Curry, over the final 8:16 of play. Trailing 27-25, Curry sparked a 10-0 Wildcat run to give Davidson its largest lead of the first half, 35-2. But the advantage lasted just under two minutes as Maryland scored 10 unanswered of its own to retake the lead, 37-35 with 4:33 to go in the period.

After the two clubs traded buckets over the next 2:33 of action, Parrish Brown's only field goal of the game, a three-pointer from the top of the key, sent the Terps into the break with a slim 44-43 advantage.

Curry led all scorers at intermission with 18 points on 5-of-9 shooting, including three buckets from deep and a perfect 5-for-5 effort at the line.

Despite all five Maryland starters picking up two first-half fouls, the Terrapins shot 50.0 percent (19-of-38) from the floor and controlled the glass, 28-17, thanks to 11 offensive rebounds in the stanza.

This back-and-forth affair featured 14 lead changes and seven ties.

Davidson point guard and All-SoCon performer Jason Richards was the only other Wildcat to reach double digits as the nation's second-leading assist man scored 11 points and handed out seven helpers.

The Wildcats forced Maryland into 22 turnovers and recorded a season-high 13 steals. This year's trip to the NCAA Tournament was the ninth for Davidson and fourth under 18th-year Head Coach Bob McKillop, whose club concluded the 2006-07 campaign winners of 25 out of their last 27 games.





National Invitation Tournament Mississippi 73, Appalachian State 59

OXFORD, MISS. — Appalachian State University men's basketball fell to Ole Miss, 73-59, in its first-round NIT game on Wednesday evening at Tad Smith Coliseum. The Rebels' defense clamped down in the second half and used a 14-0 run to pull away for the victory in front of the hometown crowd.

D.J. Thompson led the Mountaineers with 17 points in his final game in the Black and Gold. Donte Minter and Doug McLaughlin-Williams also scored in double-figures with 14 and 10 points respectively.

Ole Miss was led by Todd Abernethy's 18 points. Kenny Williams added a double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds. Ole Miss (21-12) shot 49 percent in the win, while ASU shot 37 percent after Ole Miss employed a zone in the second-half to limit ASU (25-8) to 30-percent shooting in the second half.

The Rebels began the second half with a 3-point, 38-35 lead. Seven minutes into the game, McLaughlin-Williams gave ASU its third lead of the game at 43-42 on a the three-point. The lead switched hands three times in the next four minutes until Ole Miss rattled on 14-straight points capped by an Abernethy three-point to give the Rebels a 16-point, 67-51, lead with 3:26 left in the contest. ASU would get no closer than 12 in the final minutes as the Rebels advance to face Clemson in the NIT.

Ole Miss opened the game with a 7-0 run, and lead 20-10 nine minutes into the game. ASU responded with a 13-3 run to tie the game with eight minutes left in the half. Ole Miss briefly re-established a 6-point lead on an Abernethy three-pointer with 4:30 left. The Apps pulled within one twice in the final minute of the half on buckets from Minter before the Rebels took the three-point lead into halftime.

ASU, which made just its third-ever postseason appearance, finished the season with a school-record 25 victories. In addition, Thompson's 17 points gave him 514 points this season, making him just the third Mountaineer ever, and first since 1959-60, to have two 500-point seasons in his career.
