PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Stephen Curry Davidson

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - Davidson's Stephen Curry has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games January 27-February 2 the league office announced Tuesday (Feb. 3). Curry helped the Wildcats earn victories last week over Chattanooga (92-70), Samford (55-52) and Western Carolina (89-65). He averaged 26.0 points, 6.7 assists and 5.0 rebounds. It is the seventh time this season he has won the award, setting a new single-season record since the award was created in 1968.

The junior scored a game-high 32 points in Davidson's win on the road at Chattanooga last Wednesday. He tallied 20 points at Samford before scoring 26 points at home against Western Carolina Monday night. Curry has scored at least 30 points 26 times in his career, including 11 games this season. He leads the league in scoring (28.9 ppg), assists (6.5 apg) and steals (2.9 spg). Curry has moved into 14th place on the NCAA's Division I career made three-pointers list (369).

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Donald Sims has led the team in scoring in each of the last three games, including a career-high 29 points against Georgia Southern Monday night. He averaged 22.7 points per game last week, while Isaac Butts posted two double-doubles, including 17 points and 19 boards against the Eagles.
- Appalachian State was paired against Winthrop in the 2009 ESPNU BracketBuster. The Mountaineers have participated in the event each of the past two seasons and are 1-1.
- ASU hosts The Citadel Thursday night at Holmes Center.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- Seniors Nicchaeus Doaks and Khalil Hartwell rank second and third, respectively, on the school's career rebounding list for Division I. Doaks' 723 career boards is just 24 behind all-time leader Lance Fulse's (1985-88) 747. Hartwell has 564 career rebounds.
- Senior forward Kevin Goffney has scored at least 20 points in four of his last six games. He is averaging 17.8 points, 8.3 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game over that span, while shooting 53.8 percent from the field and 84.0 percent from the charity stripe.
- The Mocs travel to face Wofford Thursday night in Spartanburg, S.C.

ELON PHOENIX



- Senior guard Brett James continues to climb Elon's career scoring chart. James now ranks 22nd in program history with 1,187 points. He ranks fourth in the conference in blocked shots (1.3 bpg) and sixth in steals (1.5 spg).
- Elon will face UNC Wilmington in the 2009 ESPNU BracketBuster on February 21. The Phoenix own a 6-3 advantage over the Seahawks in the all-time series. Elon is 0-2 in its previous BracketBuster games.
- The Phoenix visit Georgia Southern Thursday night. Elon will play host to Appalachian State Saturday afternoon.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Junior forward Ben Stywall is averaging 14.0 ppg and 10.2 rpg in 11 league games this season. Stywall is also shooting 56 percent from the floor in league play. He is averaging 11.0 points per game for the season.
- UNCG will face Davidson at the Greensboro Coliseum Thursday night. The Spartans will make the Coliseum their home floor next season using a configuration of 7,613 seats. However, as of Monday morning, more than 7,500 seats had already been issued for Thursday's game against the Wildcats and the configuration for Thursday's game had already been expanded.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford played in front of its biggest home crowd in school history Saturday as the Bulldogs squared off against the Davidson Wildcats in front of 5,116 fans at the Pete Hanna Center. The standing-room-only crowd, saw Samford fall just short, 55-52.
- So far this season, Samford owns an 8-3 record at home, but is only 3-7 when playing on the road. Despite their overall struggles away from the Pete Hanna Center this season, the Bulldogs have won two straight games on the road.
- Samford visits Furman Thursday night in Greenville, S.C.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- The Catamounts are a perfect 5-0 at home in league play and are 1-5 on the road in the conference. Western Carolina picked up a 63-54 victory over Furman last Thursday at the Ramsey Center.
- With 11 victories this season, Western has already surpassed last year's win total and has equaled the second-best win total under head coach Larry Hunter. The Catamounts are just two victories shy of tying the best record under Hunter.
- Western Carolina hosts College of Charleston Thursday.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- Senior forward Jermaine Johnson became just the fourth player in school history to score at least 1,100 points and grab at least 850 rebounds. Johnson has 1,168 career points and 863 rebounds for the Cougars.
- Guard Tony White, Jr., has continued his consistent play in the backcourt for CofC. White has hit 30 straight free throws, a new CofC NCAA Division I record. He has scored in double figures in 10 of his last 12 games. White is 10th in the league in assists (2.8 apg)
- The Cougars visit Western Carolina Thursday evening.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- With Davidson's 89-65 victory Monday night, the Wildcats have now won 42 straight Southern Conference games, the second-longest streak in league history behind West Virginia's 44 games from 1956-60.
- Davidson has won 27 straight games at Belk Arena, the third-longest active home court win streak in Division I basketball. The Wildcats last loss at home was an 81-74 decision against Appalachian State on January 20, 2007.
- The Wildcats visit UNC Greensboro Thursday evening then host College of Charleston Saturday night.

FURMAN PALADINS



- Sophomore Bryson Barnes has scored in double figures in each of Furman's last four games, including tying his career high with 13 points at Appalachian State on Saturday. He is averaging 8.5 ppg and 4.4 rpg in Southern Conference play.
- Sophomore guard Jordan Miller is 11th in the conference in scoring. Miller is averaging 14.0 points per game and also ranks fifth in the conference in free throw percentage (.831). He has been Furman's leading scorer in 13 of 20 games this year.
- The Paladins host Samford and Chattanooga this weekend.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- A game after going 0-15 from three-point range at Samford last Thursday, the Eagles rebounded for 15 triples and a season-high percentage from three-point range at Chattanooga Saturday afternoon.
- Head coach Jeff Price is just two wins shy of 300 for his career. Price, in his 16th season as a head coach, has captured 164 wins at Georgia Southern, the 13th-highest win total among all coaches to coach at a Southern Conference school.
- Georgia Southern hosts Elon and UNC Greensboro this weekend in Statesboro.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Bulldogs begin the week on a five-game winning streak, their first since the 2000-01 season under Pat Dennis. Additionally, The Citadel has won eight conference games, marking their highest win-total since going 8-8 in league play during 2001-02.
- The Citadel has protected the glass better than any other school in the conference. The Bulldogs have allowed their opponents just 31.7 rebounds per game, the lowest total in the league. The Citadel owns a +1.1 rebounding margin through 23 games.
- The Bulldogs travel to Appalachian State and Western Carolina this weekend.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Forward Noah Dahlman and guard Junior Salters are tied for the team lead with 16.6 ppg. Dahlman has led the team in scoring in eight of the last eleven games. He has scored at least 20 points in six different games.
- The Terriers are 4-0 this season when shooting over 50 percent from the field. Conversely, Wofford is 0-6 this year when allowing its opponents to shoot better than 50 percent from the floor. The Terriers are shooting 44 percent from the field this season.
- Wofford hosts Chattanooga and Samford this weekend.

CONFERENCE NOTES

RPI Strength

The Southern Conference ranks 22nd in the Men's Basketball RPI Report, released February 2. The league has garnered the most difficult strength of schedule rating among 31 Division I conferences. Three of the league's teams (Davidson, 30; Wofford, 136; College of Charleston, 144) rank in the top 150.

Streaking

Davidson owns a 42-game conference winning streak after defeating Western Carolina, 89-65, on February 2. The Wildcats won their final 10 games during league play in 2006-07, before posting a 20-0 mark last year. Davidson's streak is the third-longest conference consecutive wins streak in league history.

- West Virginia won a league-best 44 straight conference games from 1956-1960. North Carolina won 34 straight league games from 1923-25.

Two For Three

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

Non-Conference Scheduling

Southern Conference teams took on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams participated in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

- SoCon teams participated in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

BracketBusters 2009

ESPN announced the pairings for the 2009 BracketBusters event (Feb. 20-21) on February 2. Davidson will host Butler in a game to be televised on the ESPN family of networks. Georgia Southern will host Jacksonville State on February 21. Elon will visit UNC Wilmington, while Appalachian State travels to Winthrop.

- The SoCon is 8-8 all time in BracketBuster games, including a 3-1 mark in 2007.

CONFERENCE NOTES

TOURNEY TIME

The 2009 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 6-9 at The McKenzie Arena in Chattanooga. All 12 members of the Southern Conference will take part in the conference tournament. The championship game, scheduled for March 9, will be televised by ESPN2.

- The 2009 tournament will be the second time the league has held its conference championship in Chattanooga, after using the same site in 2005. The host Mocs downed UNC Greensboro, 65-62, in the final that year.

HALL OF FAME

The Southern Conference announced the inaugural Hall of Fame class for 2009. Sam Huff (Football - West Virginia), Arnold Palmer (Golf - Wake Forest), Jerry West (Basketball - West Virginia), Megan Dunigan (Tennis - Furman), Dick Groat (Basketball/Baseball - Duke), Charlie Justice (Football - North Carolina), Melissa Morrison Howard (Track & Field - Appalachian State), Adrian Peterson (Football - Georgia Southern), Frank Selvy (Tennis - Furman), and Valorie Whiteside (Basketball - Appalachian State).

- The league will induct it's inaugural class during a ceremony at the Chapman Cultural Center in Spartanburg, S.C., on May 4.

EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH

All 12 head coaches return to the bench for 2008-09. The current leage head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

- Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

EXPERIENCE ON THE COURT

The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

- Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 leagues schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season will mark the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

PRESEASON PLAUDITS

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.

NEW MEMBERSHIP

Samford University, located in Birmingham, Ala., begins its first season as a member of the Southern Conference after officially joining the league on July 1, 2008. The Bulldogs, who play their home games in the 5,000-seat Pete Hanna Center, finished last season 14-16, including a 10-10 mark in Ohio Valley conference play.
