PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Donald Sims - Appalachian St.

Sims averaged 27.5 points and shot better than 70 percent from the field last week as the Mountaineers earned victories over Davidson (66-56) and Georgia Southern (111-83).

Sims opened the week with 25 points against Davidson and tallied 30 points against Georgia Southern. He connected on 5-of-7 three-point attempts and was 10-for-10 from the free throw. Sims shot 71 percent from the field on 20-of-28 shooting for the week.

The Gaffney, S.C., native became just the 17th player in school history to record 500 points in a single season and ran his consecutive made free throw streak to 28.

The junior guard leads the conference in scoring with 19.8 points per game. He leads the nation in free throw shooting, having connected on 96 percent of his attempts from the charity stripe. Sims leads the league with 3.0 made three-pointers per game and is ninth in the conference in field goal percentage (.484).

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Appalachian State extended its season-long winning streak to four games last week after earning the season sweep against Davidson on Thursday, and defeating Georgia Southern on Saturday. It was ASU's first regular season sweep of the Wildcats since 2000-01.
- With a lead in the division race and the head-to-head tiebreaker with Western Carolina, the Mountaineers need just two league wins in their final four SoCon games to secure the North's top seed for the conference tournament.
- Appalachian State visits College of Charleston Wednesday.

ELON PHOENIX



- Senior Adam Constantine recorded his seventh and eighth double-double of the season last week. Constantine scored 24 points and grabbed 14 rebounds against College of Charleston before tallying 25 points and 15 rebounds against The Citadel.
- Senior guard TJ Douglas knocked down four triples last week in the games against CofC and The Citadel. Douglas is tied for tenth in the league with 2.0 made three-pointers per game. He is averaging 7.4 points per game this season and has connected on 37 percent of his attempts from three-point range.
- Elon hosts UNC Greensboro Wednesday night.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Freshman Kyle Randall narrowly missed a double-double Monday night against Western Carolina. He poured in a season-high 20 points and added nine rebounds against the Catamounts. Randall is the team's second-leading scorer with 9.5 points per game.
- Ben Stywall and Kendall Toney have both played in 116 consecutive games -- having never missed a game in their careers. The school record for consecutive games played is 119 by Jay Joseph.
- The Spartans visit Elon Wednesday night.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- The Bulldogs have attempted 27 more shots from three-point range than they have from two-point range this season. Samford has taken a total of 1,129 shot attempts this season with 578 of them coming from beyond the arc. The Bulldogs are shooting 56.3 percent from two-point range and 36 percent from beyond the arc.
- The Bulldogs have made at least one 3-point field goal in 559 consecutive games. The last time that Samford did not make a 3-point basket was on Jan. 19, 1991, against Texas-San Antonio.
- Samford hosts Chattanooga Saturday afternoon.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- In the last six games, Chattanooga has committed 72 turnovers, an average of 12 per game, and has +1.3 turnover margin. With 83 assists, that is a ratio of 1.15. Before that stretch, UTC was averaging 17.8 turnovers per contest with a -2.4 turnover margin.
- Sophomore Keegan Bell recorded seven assists against Furman on Saturday which is his most since finishing with 10 in UTC's home win over Mississippi Valley State (Dec. 23).
- Chattanooga visits Samford Saturday afternoon.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina won its 19th game of the season Monday night, matching the most wins in a single-season as a NCAA Division I program. WCU's 19 wins tie the 1981-82 Catamounts who won 19 games under head coach Steve Cottrell. The 19 victories are the most for WCU under head coach Larry Hunter.
- WCU senior Jake Robinson moved into seventh place on the SoCon's career made three-pointers chart with 264, just six shy of sixth place D.J. Thompson of Appalachian State (270).
- Western Carolina visits The Citadel Thursday night.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars are 8-3 in their last 11 games and have averaged 80.7 points per game, while limiting their opponents to 74.0. College of Charleston is shooting 39.9 percent from beyond the three-point arc in the last 11 contests.
- Andrew Goudelock is just one point away from moving into the top five on the school's all-time scoring list. The junior guard is currently in sixth place with 1,540 career points. He has made 238 career three-pointers and recently eclipsed Marion Busby's school record of 220.
- College of Charleston will host Appalachian State Wednesday.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Citadel has won four consecutive Southern Conference games in back-to-back seasons for just the third time in school history. The two previous times came in 1938-39 and 1939-40 under coaches Rock Norman and Ben Parker. More recently the Bulldogs had a pair of four straight SoCon victories in the 1959-60 and 1960-61 campaigns.
- Freshman Harrison DuPont set new season highs in back-to-back games with 15 points against College of Charleston, and 18 points at Elon in the last two games.
- The Bulldogs host Western Carolina Thursday.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- The Wildcats have won 11 of their last 16 games and five of their last six contests. Davidson will close the season with a stretch in which they play five times in 11 days, including three games at Belk Arena.
- With 10 points at Appalachian State Thursday, senior Will Archambault became the 38th Davidson player to score 1,000 for his career. He is averaging 11.5 points per game, the 18th best mark in the league.
- Davidson hosts Wofford Wednesday night. The Wildcats will welcome Furman to Belk Arena Saturday afternoon.

FURMAN PALADINS



- The Paladins lead the league, and rank 30th nationally, in blocked shots per game (5.3 bpg) after recording five blocks against Chattanooga Saturday night. Freshman Colin Reddick is third in the league with 1.4 blocks per game while teammate Bryson Barnes is seventh with 1.3 rejections per contest.
- Junior Jordan Miller scored a career-high 31 points in Furman's 87-78 win at Chattanooga. Miller and teammate Amu Saaka have combined for three of the five 30-point games in the conference this season. Saaka is fifth in the league in scoring (16.0 ppg), while Miller ranks seventh (14.6 ppg).
- Furman will visit Georgia Southern Wednesday night.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Willie Powers III has scored in double figures in seven straight games which includes three 20-point performances. Powers has sparked Georgia Southern's comebacks with double digit scoring in the second half in five of those seven games and nine games overall this season.
- The Eagles scored 54 points in the first half against the Appalachian State, the second-highest total in a half this season. Georgia Southern scored a season-best 58 first-half points in its season-opening win vs. Reinhardt.
- Georgia Southern will host Furman Wednesday night.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Noah Dahlman has scored in double-figures in all 27 games this season. In the last 55 games, he has scored ten or more points in 54 of them. Dahlman is fourth in the league in scoring with 17.1 points per game.
- Wofford was behind at the half in both games last week (at Furman and at Samford), but came back to win both. Wofford is 6-6 on the season when trailing at the half and 13-2 when leading at the break.
- The Terriers visit Davidson Wednesday.

CONFERENCE NOTES

ANNUAL LEADERS

Wofford junior Noah Dahlman has led the league in field goal percentage each of the past two seasons. Dahlman shot .609 from the field as a freshman and .601 last year. If he is able to lead the conference shooting percentage again, he would be the first player to lead the league in field goal percentage three straight seasons since Joe Holup of George Washington (1954-56).

Western Carolina junior Brigham Waginger led the league in steals in 2008 (69) and 2009 (81). Should he lead the league in steals again this season it would be the first time the same player has led the conference for three consecutive seasons. East Tennessee State's Keith Jennings is the only other player in league history to lead the league in steals for three seasons (1988, 1989, 1991).

Davidson has led the league in scoring each of the past four seasons. The only team to lead the conference in scoring for more than four straight years was West Virginia. The Mountaineers were the top scoring team in the league for seven consecutive seasons from 1957-1963.

ALL-DECade RECOGNITION

CollegeInsider.com recently released its All-Decade team which featured the top 25 players from the past decade (2000-2009). Davidson's Stephen Curry (2006-09) was named to the All-Decade Team. He finished his career as the league's leading scorer with 2,635 points in three years.

- Western Carolina's Kevin Martin (2001-04) and East Tennessee State's Tim Smith (2002-06) were named to the Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Martin led the league in scoring in 2003 and 2004 before being taken in the first round of the 2004 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings. A two-time SoCon Tourney MVP, Smith was the league's leading scorer in 2005.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

Following a 20-game league schedule each of the past two seasons, the SoCon Council of Presidents voted to move to an 18-game league slate beginning 2009-10. The last time the conference played 18 league games was during the 2006-07 season. The SoCon also played 18 games during the 1992-93 and 1993-94 seasons.

SoCon TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 5-8 in Charlotte. The first two round (March 5-6) will take place at Bojangles Coliseum while the semifinals and finals (March 7-8) will take place at Time Warner Cable Arena. It will mark the league's first conference tournament in Charlotte since 1971.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2010 will mark the 89th year of the post-season classic.

Appalachian State's Donald Sims scored 44 points on January 9 at Davidson. It was the highest scoring output for a SoCon performer since Davidson's Stephen Curry tallied 44 points at Oklahoma on November 18, 2008. It was just the 10th 40-point performance in a league game dating back to 1999.

FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2009-10. No team had fewer than seven returning lettermen and seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 41 starters from last year, an average of 3.4 per team. Three teams (Furman, Western Carolina and Wofford) return all five starters.

HEAD COACHES

Nine of the league's 12 head coaches return to the bench in 2009-10. The current head coaches have a combined 58 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Buzz Peterson returned to Appalachian State after guiding the Mountaineers from 1997-2000. Matt Matheny took over the Elon Phoenix after spending 16 years on Bob McKillop's staff at Davidson and Charlton Young returned to his alma mater to take over the Georgia Southern Eagles.
- Four SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference placed a league-best four teams in postseason tournaments last season. Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

- The Mocs made their 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Chattanooga fell to Wake Forest (70-54) in the first round of the New Mexico Regional in 2005 before falling to UConn last year.
- Davidson made its fifth appearance in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). The Wildcats are 3-5 all-time in the NIT after losing at Saint Mary's in the second round.
- College of Charleston lost at Richmond in the second round of the College Basketball Invitational. It was the eighth postseason appearance for CofC.
- The Citadel fell to Old Dominion in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.
