PLAYER OF THE WEEK RELEASE

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – Furman forward Jake Raine and Belmont goalkeeper Drew Romig have been named the Southern Conference men's soccer offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively, for all competition Oct. 26-30. The weekly award is the final one of the season.

Raine recorded six points on two goals and a pair of assists as Furman went 2-0 with wins at UNC Asheville and at VMI to conclude the regular season. Against the Bulldogs in nonconference action on Wednesday, the native of Stoke, England, knotted the score at 1 on a goal in the 72nd minute of play before assisting on a goal by Miles Fenton in the 84th minute that gave the Paladins the 2-1 win. Raine's goal, which came off a rebound from a blocked shot by Fenton, was his team-leading 10th of the season. On Saturday at VMI, the senior assisted on the first goal of the contest as Conor Dowler found the back of the net in the 16th minute. Less than a minute later, Raine netted his 11th goal of the season off a pass from Josh Hosie. Raine is the first Paladin since Haris Cekic in 2007 to record double-digit goals in a season.

Raine's goals in back-to-back games extended his scoring streak to six consecutive games and, based on records available since 2004, makes him the only Furman player to accomplish the feat. The Paladins (6-8-1, 4-2-0 SoCon), who finished the regular season on a three-game win streak, earned the No. 3 seed in the Southern Conference Men's Soccer Championship and will take on No. 6 seeded Wofford (5-10-1, 1-4-1) in the quarterfinal round on Friday, Nov. 5, in Macon, Georgia.

Romig records his third Defensive Player of the Week honor of the year after helping Belmont to a 2-0 win at Eastern Illinois in the Bruins' lone game of the week. Romig posted a career-high eight saves in the win, earning his seventh clean sheet of the season in the nonconference win. The native of Midlothian, Virginia, who broke the program's single-season record for shutouts, is fifth in the nation in save percentage (.831), ninth in shutouts (7), 22nd in goals against average (0.80) and 26th in saves (64).



NOTES

- UNCG conquered its final hurdle on Saturday night with a 2-0 victory over ETSU, handing the Spartans the 2021 Southern Conference regular season crown for the second time in three years under head coach Chris Rich.

- Maycol Reyes found the back of the net for the first goal of the contest in the 51st minute. Four minutes later, Jack Birch fired a laser from deep that gave UNCG the 2-0 advantage.

- The win over the Buccaneers marked the most wins in a single season since the 2006 squad won 16 matches. UNCG ended the regular season on a four-game winning streak and finished the regular season with 51 goals.

- ETSU concludes the regular season with a 4-7-3 overall mark, including 1-3-2 in league play following Saturday's home loss. The Spartans improve to 13-3-1 overall and 5-1-0 in SoCon action, securing the regular-season league title and the number one seed in the upcoming SoCon Tournament.

- Mercer wrapped up the 2021 regular season with a 3-1 victory over Wofford on Saturday. With the result, the Bears will conclude the campaign with a 8-7-1 record, and a 4-1-1 mark in SoCon competition.

- Four Bears - Kadeem Agard, Sekou Agard, Kevin Kim and Nick Wanzer – all tallied a pair of shots on the night.

- Mercer ended the regular season having won two of their last three road contests and four of their last five.

- Wofford (4-10-1, 1-4-1) totaled 12 shots in the match while Mercer (8-7-1, 4-1-1) was just behind with 11. The Bears held the corner kick advantage, however, 6-4. Joshua Old (4-9-1) tallied two saves in goal for the Terriers. His counterpart, Trevor McMullin (6-4-1), picked up three saves for the Bears.

- Furman won its third game in a row to close out the regular season following a 3-0 victory over the VMI Keydets in Southern Conference action on Saturday afternoon at Patchin Field.

- The Paladins improve to 6-8-1 on the season and 4-2 in conference play, while VMI falls to 1-15-1 overall and 0-6 in the SoCon.

- On Monday, Nov. 1st, the Wofford men's soccer team bested the VMI Keydets, 2-0, in the first round of the Southern Conference Tournament at Snyder Field in Spartanburg, S.C. Jackson Wrobel opened the scoring when he struck from just outside the box in the 13th minute before assisting Charlie Harris in the 88th minute to put the No. 7 seeded Keydets away, 2-0.

- The win is the Terriers 16th consecutive victory over VMI. The result also marks the first SoCon Tournament victory for the Terriers since 2016, a 3-1 triumph that also came against the Keydets.
