PLAYER OF THE WEEK RELEASE

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – Furman's Cole McLagan and ETSU's Josh Perryman have been named the Southern Conference men's soccer offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively, for all competition from March 16-22.

McLagan scored two goals and assisted on Shaun-Chris Joash's game-winning score in overtime to lead Furman to a 3-2 come-from-behind win at UNCG on Saturday night as Furman improved to 2-0-0 in SoCon play. After Furman fell behind early, McLagan answered with a free kick past UNCG's goalkeeper in the 40th minute. With the Paladins trailing 2-1 and just 6:30 left in regulation, the Lee's Summit, Missouri, native ripped a shot off of a Spartan defender and into the back of the net to force overtime. In the extra period, McLagan carried the ball through the midfield and into the box before passing to Josh Hosie, who crossed the ball to Joash for the match-winner.

Furman (4-1, 2-0-0 SoCon) continues SoCon action against SoCon preseason favorite Mercer (3-7-1, 1-1-1) on Tuesday at 7 p.m. in Greenville, South Carolina.

Perryman, the league's defensive player of the week, recorded his second shutout of the season and the ninth in his career in the 1-0 win against Mercer on March 16. He tallied eight saves, tying his career high that was recorded earlier this season against Marshall, and a perfect 1.000 save percentage. Perryman followed his performance with a win over Wofford on the road with four saves, including a game-winning stop in the 87th minute, to lead ETSU to its second consecutive road win.

ETSU (2-4-1, 2-1-0) hosts conference leader Belmont (5-0-1, 2-0-0) Tuesday at 3 p.m. ET at Summers-Taylor Stadium in Johnson City, Tennessee.



Notes

- Furman clinched the first-place spot after defeating Mercer 1-0 in a double overtime battle on Tuesday. The Furman/Wofford game scheduled for March 16 is rescheduled for March 25 at 7 p.m.
- Belmont (5-0-2, 2-0-1 SoCon) remains unbeaten through its first seven matches of the spring season for their best start in program history. Belmont's seven-game unbeaten streak sets the program record for consecutive results, which was last set in 2007. Belmont's 5-0 win last Tuesday against VMI came as its largest margin of victory by shutout since Sept. 18, 2001, when it posted a 6-0 victory at Lipscomb.
- ETSU (2-4-2, 2-1-1) defeated Wofford 3-2 on March 20, and settled for a draw against Belmont on March 23. The three-game unbeaten streak within the conference is the second time in the last three years ETSU has gone at least three games without a loss in SoCon play. The Bucs are scheduled to host VMI on March 30.
- Furman (5-1-0, 3-0-0) secured a 1-0 win over Mercer on Tuesday. The Paladins are currently in sole possession of first place in the league standings as they prepare to host Wofford on Thursday. Shaun-Chris Joash's game-winning goal on Tuesday ties him for second among SoCon active career leaders in the category with five. Seniors on the team will be honored on Saturday when Furman hosts VMI at 7 p.m.
- Mercer dropped its SoCon matchup to Furman in double overtime, falling to 3-8-1 overall and 1-2-1 in conference action. Mercer and Furman have gone to overtime in each of their last six meetings. The Bears will face Wofford on Saturday for a 2 p.m. kick in their final home match of the season.
- The Spartans (5-2-1, 1-1-1 SoCon) defeated VMI 4-0 in their Tuesday night matchup, which marked UNCG's first conference victory of this season, after falling to Furman by a single goal on March 20. The win over VMI was also its fifth consecutive shutout win over the Keydets dating back to 2017. The Spartans are 19-0 all-time against the Keydets.
- VMI goalkeeper Broaden Schull, who leads the NCAA DI active career leaders with 291 saves, made a season-best 10 stops in the Keydets' 4-0 loss to UNCG.
- Wofford fell short by one goal on Saturday to ETSU, 2-3. All five of Wofford's losses this season have come by one goal. The Terriers are set to battle Furman Thursday at 7 p.m.
- The 2020-21 SoCon Men's Soccer Championship is set to be contested on consecutive weekends in April. The top two seeds will host semifinal matches on either April 9 or 10, with the top remaining seed hosting the final on April 16 or 17.
