- Appalachian State visits Wofford in a matchup of last year's co-champions.
- Georgia Southern, Wofford and The Citadel are the top three rushing teams in FCS.
- Samford is eighth nationally with a +5 turnover margin.
- Furman's Chris Forcier leads the nation in passer efficiency (212.73).
- Southern Conference teams are 8-1 against FCS non-conference opponents.

AWARD CANDIDATES: The Southern Conference boasts three candidates on the Walter Payton Award Watch List and four on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List. The Payton Award is presented annually to the most outstanding player at the FCS level, while the Buchanan honors the nation's top defensive player in FCS.

- Payton Award Candidates - Eric Breitenstein (Wofford), B.J. Coleman (Chattanooga) and DeAndre Presley (Appalachian State).
- Buchanan Award Candidates - Kadarron Anderson (Furman), Ameet Pall (Wofford), Brent Russell (Georgia Southern) and Ryan Steed (Furman).

RANKINGS: Four Southern Conference teams are ranked this week in both major FCS Polls. Georgia Southern is ranked No. 1 in both the FCS Coaches Poll and the Sports Network Poll, while Appalachian State is tabbed third. Wofford is ranked sixth by the coaches and eighth by TSN. The Chattanooga Mocs are ranked 17th by the FCS Coaches and No. 15 in the Sports Network Poll.

- Elon and Furman are among the teams receiving votes in the Sports Network Poll.

THROUGH THE AIR: Elon's Aaron Mellette ranks second nationally with 147.8 receiving yards per game.

• The Southern Conference has had at least one wide receiver rank in the top five nationally for receiving yards per game in each of the last five seasons.

ON THE GROUND: Georgia Southern owns the nation's best rushing attack with 416 yards per game.

• A Southern Conference team has led the nation in rushing in seven of the last ten years.

DEFENSIVE ROTATION: Elon owns the top defensive unit in the conference as the Phoenix rank fifth in the nation for total defense. Elon has given up just 262 yards per game this season.

• Wofford led the league in total defense last season, marking the eighth straight season a different school led the SoCon in total defense. Chattanooga is the only team that has not led the league in total defense, dating back to 2003.

PLAYOFF POWER: Georgia Southern reached the semifinals of the FCS Playoffs in 2010 for the first time since 2002 when the Eagles fell to Western Kentucky 31-28, in Statesboro, Ga. The Southern Conference has had at least one team reach the semifinals 11 times in the last 13 years.

• The SoCon placed three teams in the quarterfinals last year. The league also had three teams in the quarterfinals in 2001, 1995 and 1996.

THREE FOR TEN: Three teams finished the 2010 season with 10 wins. Appalachian State and Wofford concluded the year at 10-3, while Georgia Southern was 10-5. It was the first time in history that the Southern Conference had three league teams win at least ten games in the same season.

• The SoCon has had two teams win at least 10 games on 12 different occasions (1983, 1987, 1988, 1992, 1993, 1995, 1996, 1998, 2000, 2001, 2005 and 2010).

APPALACHIAN JOINS SOCON RECORD BOOKS: Appalachian State finished 7-1 in the Southern Conference in 2010 to win a share of the Southern Conference title for the sixth consecutive season. The Mountaineers are now just the second SoCon team to win six league titles in a row.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 954, ten points higher than the national average of 944 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores last October. Seven of the nine SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (64 percent) for FCS programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

POLL POSITION: The Southern Conference placed three teams in the final top 25 poll in 2010. Appalachian State (4th), Georgia Southern (5th) and Wofford (6th) were all ranked in the top ten of both the FCS Coaches Poll and the Sports Network rankings.

- The last time the league placed three teams in the season-ending polls was in 2005. ASU was slotted first after winning the FCS National Championship, while Furman (3rd) and Georgia Southern (9th) were also ranked in the top ten.

CAUGHT IN THE DRAFT: The Southern Conference had five players taken in the 2011 NFL Draft in April. The five draftees were the most taken in the draft since 1992 when five SoCon student-athletes were also selected.

- Defensive Back Cortez Allen of The Citadel was the first SoCon player taken off the board when he was chosen 128th overall (4th round) by the Pittsburgh Steelers.
- Chattanooga's Buster Skrine (DB) was selected in the fifth round (#137 overall) by the Cleveland Browns.
- Appalachian State had a trio of players taken. Defensive Back Mark LeGree was selected in the fifth round by Seattle (#156) while offensive lineman Daniel Kilgore was taken with pick #163 by San Francisco. Linebacker D.J. Smith was chosen by the Green Bay Packers in the sixth round (#186).

SoCon Sports Network: This summer the conference office announced a three-year partnership with Public Television to carry Southern Conference football games. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon football games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry Southern Conference football games. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced this fall for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3.com, the Southern Conference website, as well as the respective public television websites.

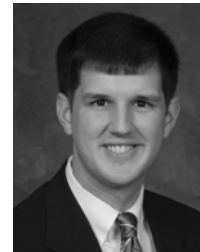
