Playoff Notes

Furman advanced to the second round of the FCS Playoffs with a 30-20 win at South Carolina State last weekend, while the Samford Bulldogs fell at Jacksonville State, 55-14.

Furman's victory over South Carolina State gave the Southern Conference its 100th playoff victory. The SoCon has the most wins (100) and highest winning percentage (.617) in the postseason among all FCS conferences.

Southern Conference teams are 45-22 in second round of the playoffs.

All nine Southern Conference programs have appeared in the FCS playoffs.

The Paladins are making their 17th playoff appearance and their first since 2006. Furman is 18-14 all-time in the postseason.

- Furman visits top-seeded North Dakota State in the second round of the FCS Playoffs.
- Southern Conference teams are 12-7 (.632) against Missouri Valley opponents in the playoffs.
- The Southern Conference played 36 league games this season. Sixteen of those 36 contests were decided by one possession.
- Home teams went 21-15 in conference play this season and have gone 19-17 in league games each of the last two years.

RANKINGS: Two Southern Conference teams were ranked in both major FCS Polls at the end of the regular season.

Samford is ranked 16th by the FCS Coaches and 18th by the Sports Network.

- Chattanooga is No. 21 in the the Sports Network poll and No. 21 according to the coaches.
- Furman, Georgia Southern and Wofford are among the teams receiving votes.

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES OF HOME: Southern Conference teams were 8-7 at home in nonconference games this season.

- League teams went 13-2 at home in nonconference games in 2012 and were 15-1 in 2011. SoCon teams own a record of 47-13 (.783) in nonconference home games since the start of the 2010 season.

DEFENSIVE ROTATION: All nine SoCon teams have led the league in total defense at least once since 2003.

- At the conclusion of the regular season, Chattanooga owned the top overall defensive unit in the league. The Mocs gave up 328.9 yards per game which ranks 17th nationally.

GROUND ATTACK: A Southern Conference team has led the nation in rushing in nine of the last 12 years.

- The Citadel ranks fourth in FCS with 273.3 rushing yards per game.
- Georgia Southern led all of FCS with 399 yards per game on the ground in 2012.

BROKEN RECORDS: Southern Conference teams have turned in record-setting performances during the regular season in 2013:

- Savannah State at Georgia Southern - August 31
 GSU's 576 rushing yards was the eighth best single-game total in SoCon history. GSU's 10 rushing TDs was tied for the second best mark in league history.
- The Citadel at Old Dominion - September 21
 Ben Dupree accounted for six touchdowns which tied for the fifth-best single-game output in league history.
- Georgia Southern at Samford - October 5
 Andy Summerlin passed for 495 yards which was the fifth-highest single-game total in league history.

AWARD CANDIDATES: The Southern Conference one finalist for the Walter Payton Award, two Buck Buchanan award finalists and two Jerry Rice Award Watch finalists. The Payton Award is presented annually to the most outstanding player at the FCS level, while the Buchanan honors the nation's top defensive player in FCS. The Jerry Rice Award is given to the top freshman in FCS.

MAKING THE GRADE: In addition to achieving success on the gridiron, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference football teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 960, ranking sixth nationally and third among FCS conferences. It was the fourth consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- Eight Southern Conference's sports (football, men's basketball, men's cross country women's basketball, women's cross country, women's indoor track & field, women's outdoor track & field and women's tennis) ranked among the top 10 of Division I for their four-year average.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 24. Six of the league's nine teams met or exceeded the national average for FCS programs.

CONFERENCE CROWN: Furman, Samford and Chattanooga all shared the Southern Conference crown with identical 6-2 records.

- It is UTC's first conference title since 1984 and the first for Samford since joining the league in 2008.
- Furman has won its 13th conference title with Appalachian State having won or shared the league crown on 12 occasions.

CAREER MILESTONES: Appalachian State's Jamal Londry-Jackson is tied for eighth place on the league's all-time list of 300-yard passers. Londry-Jackson threw for 300 yards in six games as a Mountaineer.

- Elon's Scott Riddle (2007-10) leads all SoCon QBs with 23 career 300-yard passing performances.
- Samford's Kelsey Pope sits in fourth place on the league's career list for pass receptions. Pope finished his career with 250 career catches.
- Samford's Fabian Truss finished third on the league's career all-purpose yardage list with 6,640 yards. VMI's Thomas Haskins (1993-96) owns the SoCon record with 7,355 all-purpose yards.
- Georgia Southern's Jerick McKinnon finished just 251 yards shy of 10th place on the league's career rushing list.

EXPERIENCED COACHES: Wofford head coach Mike Ayers is the dean of SoCon coaches. Ayers has tallied 130 wins at East Tennessee State and Wofford while coaching in the Southern Conference. He ranks third on the league's all-time wins list behind Appalachian State's Jerry Moore and Duke's Wallace Wade.

- Mercer and VMI will begin competing in football in the SoCon in 2014 while ETSU joins the league on the gridiron in the fall of 2016.
- Mercer is spending the 2013 season in the Pioneer League while VMI competes in the Big South.
