Men's Soccer Players of the Week

SPARTANBURG, S.C. – The Southern Conference named its men's soccer players of the week Tuesday for games played Aug. 30 – Sept. 2. Mercer forward Trevor Martineau and goalkeeper JR DeRose were honored as the Southern Conference men's soccer offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively.

Mercer, the preseason league favorites, kicked off the season with a 2-0 victory on the road at Cincinnati. The Bears were victorious again on Monday as they took down Presbyterian 2-1 in the home opener to move to 2-0-0 on the season.

Martineau, the reigning conference freshman and player of the year, played a key role in the win over Cincinnati as he provided an assist on the Bear's second goal of the night. The Montreal, Quebec native followed up that performance by finding the back of the net for the first time this season with a flashy header by the Presbyterian keeper. His goal stretched the Mercer lead to two and would prove to be the difference after the Blue Hose scored a goal of their own later in the game.

DeRose, a redshirt junior from Peoria, Illinois, put on a stellar showing between the posts as he notched a pair of wins to begin the season and allowed just one goal. DeRose went the full 90 minutes in both contests and totaled seven saves over both games, with five coming in the shutout win over the Bearcats.

The Bears will be back in action on Friday, Sept. 6 when they travel to the University of Alabama Birmingham for an 8:00 PM nonconference clash with the Blazers.

Notes

- Furman head coach Doug Allison looks to reach the 300 win milestone for his career. Allison, who is in his 25th season in charge of the Paladins, needs just two wins to reach 300 wins. The Paladins came close in each of their first two games, with nationally-ranked Duke just escaping with a 1-0 win and Elon playing out to a thrilling 3-3 draw.
- In their second game of the season, ETSU and Old Dominion saw four penalties conceded, with two being awarded to each team. The Bucs converted both of their penalties and freshman Hauk Andreas Fossen scored the game-winner with two minutes left in 2OT to win the first match of the season.
- Mercer started the season 2-0 with wins over Cincinnati and Presbyterian. The Bears have won at least their first two games in three of the last four seasons and was the only team in the league to open the season undefeated. The duo of Trevor Martineau and JR DeRose swept this week's offensive and defensive player of the week honors.
- With the tie at Bradley on Friday, Belmont remains unbeaten in four of their last five season-opening contests. The Bruins have also notched a shutout in two of its last three season-opening matches.
- VMI head coach Charlie Hubbard became the 12th head coach in the program's 47-year when he led his men in the season opener on Friday against Winthrop. history was in charge for his first game Friday against Winthrop, Hubbard served as the Keydets' assistant coach the prior three seasons, including as associate head coach last fall before taking over as the boss in the 2019-20 campaign.
- New UNCG boss Chris Rich earned his first win as a head coach at the collegiate level as the Spartans beat George Washington in their season opener at home. The Spartans also had another first as Riley Copeland scored his first collegiate goal
- UNCG is undefeated in season-openers in the last five years (4-0-1).
