- Conference play begins this weekend for every team except Furman, which will kick off SoCon action next weekend. The seven league teams will play the other six teams for a three-game series.
- UNCG was tabbed to win the 2021 SoCon title in voting by the league's head coaches and currently sit atop the league at 14-7 overall.
- Chattanooga infielder Emily Coltharp was named the preseason player of the year, Chattanooga's third-straight preseason POTY selection. Samford pitcher Abby Swaney was selected as the preseason pitcher of the year.
- UNCG is fifth nationally with 2.00 home runs per game & sixth in walks (101).



SOCON 100TH ANNIVERSARY

The SoCon is celebrating its 100th anniversary in 2021. The fifth-oldest NCAA Division I college athletic association, the SoCon contested the first-ever collegiate conference basketball tournament in 1921, tackled freshman eligibility in 1922, became the first conference to adopt the 3-point field goal in basketball in 1980 and developed women's championships in 1984.


