### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### Stephen Curry Davidson

SPARTANBURG, S.C. - Davidson's Stephen Curry has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games January 13-19 the league office announced Tuesday (Jan. 20). Curry helped the Wildcats earn wins over Elon (83-68) and Georgia Southern (89-68) last week. He averaged 33.5 points, 4.5 assists and connected on 46 percent of his field goal attempts. It is the fifth time this season he has won the award, tying the record he set during the 2007-08 season. The player of the week is selected by a vote of the league's basketball sports information directors.

Curry scored a game-high 39 points in Davidson's victory over Elon, marking the 23rd time in his career he has scored at least 30 points. He followed up that performance with a game-high 28 points against Georgia Southern. Curry leads the nation with 29.1 points per game. He also leads the league in assist (6.5 apg) and steals (3.0 spg). He is tops among all Southern Conference performers in minutes played (34.1).

# TEAM REPORTS

## APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- The Mountaineers fell to Chattanooga in overtime, 78-74, which marked the fourth overtime game this season for the team. The last time ASU played four overtime games was during the 1998-99 season.
- Appalachian State leads the conference in three-point field goal defense. The Mountaineers have limited their opponents to just 31 percent shooting from beyond the arc.
- The Mountaineers visit College of Charleston on Wednesday before hosting Western Carolina Saturday afternoon on SportSouth.

## CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- The Mocs are currently riding a four-game win streak. The last time Chattanooga won five in a row was during head coach John Shulman's first season from Jan. 3, 2005-Jan. 15, 2005. The Mocs have not won five straight regular-season SoCon games since Feb. 23, 2002-Jan. 13, 2003.
- Stephen McDowell is one of just three players ranked in the top 10 nationally in both three-pointers made per game (4.5) and percentage (.460). He is tied for the third longest active streak at 39 games making a three-pointer. He scored his 800th point (803) in his two-year career in the win over Western Carolina.
- Chattanooga visits UNC Greensboro Thursday night then travels to face Elon Saturday evening.

## ELON PHOENIX



- Senior guard Brett James continues to climb Elon's career scoring chart. With 1,100 career points, James has moved into 24th place on the school's all-time scoring list.
- Ola Atoyebi continues to be a consistent offensive threat for the Phoenix. Atoyebi has scored in double figures in 11 of the team's last 13 games. He is sixth in the league in scoring, as he averages 14.5 points per game.
- The Phoenix host Samford Thursday night before welcoming Chattanooga to Alumni Gym Saturday night.

## UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- UNCG's 89-72 win at Elon last week was its third straight win at Alumni Gym after having lost in nine of the first 10 trips.
- Junior forward Ben Stywall has three straight double-doubles and five on the season – four of those coming in Southern Conference games. Stywall is third in the conference with 9.1 rebounds per game.
- The Spartans host Chattanooga Thursday then take on Samford Saturday at Fleming Gym.

## SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- In Samford's last three games against College of Charleston, Western Carolina and Appalachian State, the Bulldogs have scored an average of 72.7 points per contest. Prior to those three games, Samford was only averaging 57.4 points per outing.
- Samford is 7-1 when playing at the Pete Hanna Center. The Bulldogs are averaging 67.4 points per game and are shooting 51.9 percent from the field. Conversely, Samford is 1-7 on the road this season and is only scoring 53.1 points per road contest. The Bulldogs are only shooting 39.8 percent from the floor away from home.
- Samford travels to face Elon (Jan. 22) and UNC Greensboro (Jan. 24) this week.

## WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina sits atop the North Division with a record of 4-2. The Catamounts are a perfect 3-0 at home in league play and are 1-2 on the road in the conference.
- WCU is second in the league with a +3.6 rebounding margin. The Catamounts are tops in the conference with 15.3 offensive rebounds per game.
- Western Carolina visits The Citadel Thursday then travels to take on Appalachian State Saturday.

## COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- College of Charleston visits Appalachian State Thursday. Bobby Cremins began his coaching career at ASU posting a 100-70 (.588) record over six seasons. He led the Mountaineers to the 1979 SoCon Tournament title by defeating Furman, 86-83.
- Guard Tony White, Jr., has continued his consistent play in the backcourt for CofC. White has scored in double figures in seven of his last eight games. White averages 11.4 points per game, good for 20th place in the league.
- After travelling to face Appalachian State, College of Charleston visits The Citadel Saturday night.

## DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Davidson picked up wins over Elon and Georgia Southern last week. The Wildcats have now won 37 straight Southern Conference games, and 24 straight games at Belk Arena, the fifth-longest active streak in Division I basketball.
- Senior Andrew Lovedale is the third-leading career rebounder among active players in the SoCon. Lovedale is fourth this year with 9.1 rebounds per game and has 600 for his career.
- Davidson hosts Furman Wednesday night (Jan. 21). The Wildcats then take on Wofford Saturday (Jan. 24) at Belk Arena.

## FURMAN PALADINS



- Freshman Brandon Sebirumbi matched a career-high with 12 points in Furman's loss to The Citadel before contributing 11 points and his second straight five-rebound effort in a 78-71 loss to the College of Charleston.
- Furman tallied 71 points in Saturday's loss to the College of Charleston to reach 70 points for the first time since a 73-63 victory at The Citadel on February 28, 2008. The Paladins, who average just 60.9 points per game for the season, have tallied 69 and 71 points in their last two games.
- Furman visits Davidson Wednesday night. The Paladins then travel to Georgia Southern Saturday.

## GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Georgia Southern drew a crowd of 4,360 for Saturday's home game against Davidson. It was the sixth-largest crowd in Hanner Fieldhouse history, and the largest since the Fieldhouse underwent a renovation in 1995.
- Julian Allen recorded his fourth career double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds against Davidson on Saturday. It was his second double-double of the season.
- Georgia Southern hosts Wofford Thursday night (Jan. 22). The Eagles then host Furman on Saturday at Hanner Fieldhouse.

## THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Freshman Cosmo Morabbi recorded a career-high 12 points in Saturday's loss at Wofford. Morabbi connected on four three-pointers.
- Sophomore Zach Urbanus is second in the league with a 2.2 assist-to-turnover ratio. Urbanus ranks eighth in the conference in assists (3.1 apg) and 10th in made three pointers per game (1.9 3fg).
- The Citadel hosts Western Carolina Thursday evening before welcoming College of Charleston to McAlister Field House Saturday.

## WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Sophomore Noah Dahlman has scored in double figures in each of the last 13 games and has led the team in scoring in five of the last six games. Dahlman is fourth in the league with 16.8 points per game. He ranks eighth in rebounding with 7.1 rebounds per contest.
- The Terriers are 6-0 when leading or tied at the half this season, but just 1-7 when trailing at the half.
- Wofford visits Georgia Southern on Thursday (Jan. 22) then travels to Davidson Saturday afternoon.

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### RPI STRENGTH

The Southern Conference ranks 12th in the Men's Basketball RPI Report, released January 19. The league has garnered the second toughest strength of schedule rating among 31 Division I conferences. Three of the league's teams (Davidson, 32; College of Charleston, 112; Wofford, 127) rank in the top 150.

### STREAKING

Davidson owns a 37-game conference winning streak after defeating Georgia Southern, 89-68, on January 17. The Wildcats won their final 10 games during league play in 2006-07, before posting a 20-0 mark last year. Davidson's streak is the third-longest conference consecutive wins streak in league history.

- West Virginia won a league-best 44 straight conference games from 1956-1960. North Carolina won 34 straight league games from 1923-25.

### TWO FOR THREE

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.

### NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULING

Southern Conference teams took on some of the top competition across the country. Seven of the 12 SoCon teams participated in at least one exempt tournament this winter, spanning from Cancun, Mexico (The Citadel) to Alaska (Western Carolina).

- SoCon teams participated in the Air Force Classic, Cancun Challenge, Charleston Classic, Coaches vs. Cancer Tournament, Drake Invitational, Great Alaska Shootout, Jimmy V Classic, NIT Season Tip-Off, Puerto Rico Tip-Off and Wooden Tradition.

### BRACKETBUSTERS 2009

Four Southern Conference teams will take part in the 2009 ESPNU BracketBusters event February 20-21. The event will feature 13 nationally televised games - on either ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU - selected from a pool of 102 teams.

- Davidson and Georgia Southern have been designated as home teams during the event, while Appalachian State and Elon will take to the road. The matchups for the 13 nationally televised games will be announced Feb. 2.

# SOUTHERN CONFERENCE NEWS AND NOTES

## CONFERENCE NOTES

### TOURNEY TIME

The 2009 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 6-9 at The McKenzie Arena in Chattanooga. All 12 members of the Southern Conference will take part in the conference tournament. The championship game, scheduled for March 9, will be televised by ESPN2.

- The 2009 tournament will be the second time the league has held its conference championship in Chattanooga, after using the same site in 2005. The host Mocs downed UNC Greensboro, 65-62, in the final that year.

### HALL OF FAME

Southern Conference Commissioner John Iamarino announced the formation of the SoCon Hall of Fame for 2009. The league will induct its inaugural class during a ceremony in Spartanburg, S.C., on May 9. The Southern Conference is in its 88th season of intercollegiate competition and will begin recognizing many prominent student-athletes, coaches and administrators from the 43 current and former institutions that have been a part of the league's distinguished history.

- Among the nominees for consideration from Southern Conference men's basketball are Dick Groat (Duke), "Hot" Rod Hundley (West Virginia), Frank Selvy (Furman) and Jerry West (West Virginia).

### EXPERIENCE ON THE BENCH

All 12 head coaches return to the bench for 2008-09. The current league head coaches have a combined 84 years of experience within the Southern Conference.

- Davidson's Bob McKillop is the longest tenured coach in the SoCon, entering his 20th season on the bench for the Wildcats. Bobby Cremins (College of Charleston), Ed Conroy (The Citadel) and Jeff Jackson (Furman) are all in their third season with their current school.

### EXPERIENCE ON THE COURT

The 12 Southern Conference schools combined to return 105 lettermen from the 2007-08 season, an average of 8.75 returners per team. Eleven of the 12 SoCon teams returned at least eight lettermen from 2007-08.

- Three schools (College of Charleston, The Citadel and Furman) returned all five starters for 2008-09. Ten of the 12 leagues schools returned at least three starters from 2007-08.

### SCHEDULE CHANGE

The 2008-09 season will mark the final year of the 20-game conference schedule in the Southern Conference. The SoCon Council of Presidents decided in early November to move to an 18-game conference schedule beginning with the 2009-10 season.

### PRESEASON PLAUDITS

The Davidson Wildcats were ranked 20th in both preseason polls released by the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today. It was the first time a SoCon team has appeared in the preseason rankings since Davidson was ranked fifth to start the 1969-70 season.

### NEW MEMBERSHIP

Samford University, located in Birmingham, Ala., begins its first season as a member of the Southern Conference after officially joining the league on July 1, 2008. The Bulldogs, who play their home games in the 5,000-seat Pete Hanna Center, finished last season 14-16, including a 10-10 mark in Ohio Valley conference play.
