## NOTES

•UNCG extended its streak of opening to nine games without dropping a conference season opener after defeating VMI 4-0 on Saturday, Oct. 12.

•Belmont has scored a combined seven goals over the last two home matches against Faulkner and Wofford, which is the most goals scored in consecutive home matches since 2011. The Bruins fired a season-high 10 shots on goal against Wofford and 17 shots total.

•With six saves against Wofford, Belmont junior goalkeeper Nicolo Dini now has the fifth-most career saves in school history (154).

•Wofford's Adrien Roseth netted a hat trick against Belmont in the conference opener on Saturday. Roseth's hat trick was the 11th in school history and just the 4th since the Terriers moved to Division I.

## MEN'S SOCCER PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

**SPARTANBURG, S.C.** – The Southern Conference named its men's soccer players of the week Tuesday for games played Oct. 8-14. Belmont forward Niccolo Dagnoni and Furman defender Cole McLagan were honored as the league's offensive and defensive players of the week, respectively.

Belmont grinded out a draw in its lone match of the week with Wofford on Saturday, Oct. 12, as both squads scored three goals in the conference opener. Furman posted a 2-0-0 record during the week, knocking off North Greenville 4-1 on Tuesday, Oct. 8, before beating ETSU 1-0 on Saturday, Oct. 12.

Dagnoni notched his first career hat trick in the draw with Wofford. The Milan, Italy, native bagged a brace in the first half with goals in the 17th and 40th minutes to give the Bruins the lead at the half. He found the back of the net again in the 55th minute with a volley from the top of the box. Dagnoni, who leads the conference with 3.27 shots per game, fired off six shots in the contest, with five of those on goal.

The weekly award is Dagnoni's first of his career.

McLagan helped anchor a Paladin back line that allowed just one goal over two wins, including a shutout against conference opponent ETSU. The Lee's Summit, Missouri, native assisted on Furman's first goal in the win over North Greenville and added another against ETSU. McLagan's assist against the Bucs proved to be the game-winner as he set up Shaun-Chris Joash with an excellent pass into the box in the closing stages of the first half.

The weekly honor is McLagan's second of his career, with both coming this season.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week: Shaun-Chris Joash (Furman), Albert Pedra (UNCG) and Adrian Roseth (Wofford).

Also nominated for defensive player of the week: Brett Royster (Belmont) and Ethan Conley (UNCG).
