PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Andrew Goudelock - CofC

Goudelock averaged 27.0 points and shot 44 percent from beyond the arc as the Cougars knocked off Wofford (79-54) and Furman (73-54) last week.

The senior began the week with a game-high 25 points against Wofford. He was 8-of-19 from the field against the Terriers and added a game-high six assists as the Cougars moved to the top of the South Division standings. Two days later against Furman, Goudelock scored a game-high 29 points in 36 minutes of action against the Paladins.

Goudelock is currently on a 10-game double-digit scoring streak and leads the Southern Conference and rank among the top five nationally in points per game (4th, 23.8 ppg) and made three-pointers (4th, 3.3 3fg).

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Omar Carter, The Citadel's Mike Groselle, Davidson's JP Kuhlman, Elon's Lucas Troutman, UNCG's Brandon Evans, Chattanooga's Omar Wattad, Western Carolina's Mike Williams and Wofford's Noah Dahlman.

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Appalachian State snapped a four-game skid with close road wins at UNCG and Elon last week. The 80-78 nail biter at UNCG was ASU's first overtime contest of the season. The wins moved ASU to 4-3 against division rivals on the season.
- Donald Sims scored his 2,000th career point on Saturday at Elon. Already ASU's career scoring leader, he became just the 479th player in NCAA Division I history to eclipse the milestone. Sims ranks second in the SoCon with 21.0 points per game.
- The Mountaineers host Samford Thursday night.

ELON PHOENIX



- With nine points against College of Charleston Wednesday night, Drew Spradlin topped the 900 career point mark with 904 points. Spradlin is 10th in the conference in scoring with 14.0 points per game. He ranks ninth in the league with 1.8 made three-pointers per game.
- Elon leads the Southern Conference and ranks 11th nationally with 9.1 made three-pointers per game. Freshman guard Jack Isenbarger leads the team and is fifth in the league with 2.2 made triples per contest.
- The Phoenix visit The Citadel Saturday.

UNCG SPARTANS



- Sophomore Brian Cole scored a career-high 24 points as UNCG defeated The Citadel, 86-74 Monday night. He was 10-of-16 off the bench, including 4-of-6 from beyond the arc. Kyle Randall added 20 points for the Spartans.
- The Spartans have five players averaging double figures. Trevis Simpson leads the team with 10.8 points per game while Randall has scored 10.5 points per contest. Brandon Evans has tallied 10.3 points per game. Corey Van Dussen and Aloysius Henry average 10.2 points per outing.
- The Spartans travel to College of Charleston Saturday.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford won at Georgia Southern on Saturday, 58-50, to snap a four-game road losing streak. The Bulldogs' road triumph was their first victory away from home since a 68-64 win at UNCG on Jan. 6.
- The Bulldogs' win at Georgia Southern was their first victory in Statesboro, Ga., in over 25 years. Samford's last win at Georgia Southern was a 54-52 victory on Jan. 11, 1986. Since then, the Bulldogs had been defeated in eight straight contests held at Hanner Fieldhouse prior to Saturday's triumph.
- The Bulldogs visit Appalachian State Thursday.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS



- The Mocs are in the middle of a four-game road trip which includes three SoCon events. Chattanooga is 7-0 in league home games and 3-2 on the road.
- Chattanooga tied its second best three-point percentage for a game, shooting 63.2 percent (12-19) in last Thursday's win over Georgia Southern. The Mocs equaled the same numbers they shot at Georgia Southern on Feb. 7, 2000.
- The Mocs travel to Appalachian State Saturday afternoon. Chattanooga will visit Western Carolina Monday.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- With a win over UNCG on Saturday, WCU remained perfect at home this season, improving to 7-0 in the Ramsey Center while claiming its ninth-straight home victory dating back to last season. The Catamounts have won 34 of their last 39 home games including 23 of the last 26 Southern Conference games in Cullowhee.
- WCU plays host to Chattanooga and Samford this week. The Catamounts fell on the road to both the Mocs and Bulldogs earlier this season, suffering a two-point defeat at UTC on Dec. 4.
- Western Carolina will entertain Samford Saturday afternoon before playing host to Chattanooga Monday night.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- Senior point guard Donovan Monroe is one points shy of moving into the top 20 on the school's all-time career scoring list (13th all-time in CofC Division I history) with 1,204 career points to date. Monroe registered his 16th double-digit game this season with 13 points at Elon.
- Senior Andrew Goudelock scored a season-high 34 points in CofC's win at Elon Wednesday night. Goudelock has topped the 30-point plateau four times this season and has scored at least 20 points in 20 games this year.
- College of Charleston will host UNCG Saturday afternoon.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- Sophomore center Mike Groselle notched his fourth double-double of the season in a loss to Furman. He becomes the first Bulldog to finish with four double-doubles since 2008-09 when Demetrius Nelson accomplished the feat. The school record for most in a season belongs to Patrick Elmore who had 11 in 1989-90.
- Senior sharpshooter Zach Urbanus, already The Citadel's all-time 3-point shooter, has moved into a tie for fifth place with Western Carolina's Jake Robinson (2006-10) on the SoCon's all-time 3-point shooting list. Urbanus and Robinson now have 278 in their careers.
- The Citadel hosts Elon Saturday.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- Senior guard Brendan McKillop has moved into fourth place on Davidson's career made three-pointers made list with 195 triples to his credit. McKillop is third in the Southern Conference with 2.7 made three-pointers per game and has made 38 percent of his attempts from beyond the arc this season.
- Bob McKillop needs four victories to reach 400 for his career. He coached his 1,000th career game at Wofford Wednesday (656 at Davidson, 344 as a high school head coach).
- The Wildcats will travel to Furman Saturday. Davidson returns home to face Georgia Southern February 16.

FURMAN PALADINS



- Furman has limited its opponents to 65 points or less in six of its last eight games. The Paladins lead the Southern Conference in scoring defense as they have allowed just 64.3 points per contest this year.
- The Paladins have been the most accurate team from beyond the arc in the Southern Conference. Furman has connected on 39 percent of its attempts from three-point range. Senior Noah States leads the league in three-point field goal percentage (.479).
- Furman hosts Georgia Southern Thursday night. The Paladins will entertain Davidson at Timmons Arena Saturday.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Junior Ben Drayton reached 1,000 career points in the first half of the Chattanooga game last Thursday. He became the 37th all-time member of the club and the 19th in the Division I era. He now sits in 34th place all-time scoring with 1,029 career points.
- Georgia Southern leads the Southern Conference and ranks 11th nationally with 9.4 steals per game. Freshman Jelani Hewitt leads the league with 2.1 thefts per game. Ben Drayton is second in the SoCon with 2.0 steals per contest while Eric Ferguson ranks sixth with 1.6 per outing.
- Georgia Southern visits Furman Thursday.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Senior Noah Dahlman ranks second in the SoCon in field goal percentage at .627 this season. He led the league in field goal percentage as a freshman (.609) and sophomore (.601).
- The Terriers lead the SoCon in turnover margin at +1.8. Wofford averages a league-low 12.3 turnovers per game and has forced its opposition into 14.2 miscues per contest.
- The Terriers host Georgia Southern Saturday night at Benjamin Johnson Arena.

RECORD WATCH

Many of the impressive accomplishments from this season have placed Southern Conference teams in the league's record book.

- Samford knocked down 18 three-pointers against Auburn (Nov. 19) and UT-San Antonio (Dec. 21), which tied for the sixth-highest single-game output in league history.
- UNCG made 17 triples at Chattanooga January 27. The Spartans' 43 attempts from three-point range was the sixth highest single-game mark in league history.
- Chattanooga grabbed 60 rebounds against Reinhardt (Dec. 21). It was the sixth-highest single game rebound total in the SoCon's 90-year history.
- Western Carolina recorded 18 steals against Warren Wilson (Nov. 22), which tied for the tenth-highest steals total in the Southern Conference.
- The Mocs attempted 53 free throws against UNCG on January 27 which ranked as the tenth-highest total in the SoCon.
- Wofford's Noah Dahlman became just the ninth player in SoCon history to be perfect from the floor with at least 10 field goal attempts. Dahlman was 10-for-10 from the field against Georgia Southern on January 12.
- College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock has made 821 career field goals, the tenth-highest total in league history. He needs 23 field goals to pass West Virginia's Jerry West (1958-60) for ninth place.

MAKING THE GRADE

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in June 2010, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 950, ten points higher than the national average of 940 for Division I men's basketball programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores on October 27, 2010. Nine of the 12 SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average (65 percent) for men's basketball Division I programs. The teams scores included four-class averages taken from the 2000-2003 cohorts.

CONFERENCE NOTES

FOUR FOR 20

For the first time since the 1952-53 season, the Southern Conference had four teams win at least 20 games in 2009-10. League champion Wofford totaled 26 victories last season while North Division champion Appalachian State won 24. College of Charleston and Western Carolina each won 22 games.

- League champion North Carolina State (26), Wake Forest (22), Furman (21) and Richmond (20) all won 20 games during the 1952-53 campaign. The SoCon featured 17 teams during that season.

HEAD COACHES

Ten of the league's 12 head coaches returned to the bench in 2010-11. The current head coaches have a combined 59 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Jason Capel took the reigns at Appalachian State after serving as an assistant for the Mountaineers during the 2009-2010 season. Chuck Driesell is in his first season as head coach at The Citadel. Driesell had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant at Maryland.
- Five SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

ANNUAL LEADERS

Appalachian State has led the league in rebounding each of the past two seasons. The Mountaineers averaged 38.5 rebounds per game last season and were +7.8 on the glass. The last time a SoCon team led the league in rebounding three straight years was Davidson from 1993-1995.

The Citadel limited its opponents to just 59.8 points per game last season. It was the third-lowest single-season average in league history. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- Samford limited its opposition to 60.7 points per game last year, the eighth-best mark in league history. Wofford ranked ninth all-time in scoring defense as the Terriers held their opponents to just 61.0 points per contest.
- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

College of Charleston led the league with 326 made three-pointers in 2010. It was the third highest single-season total in league history.

- Davidson and Appalachian State each tallied 279 triples a season ago. It was the ninth-highest total in league history.

SoCON TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 4-7 in Chattanooga, Tenn. at McKenzie Arena. The conference tournament was recently held in Chattanooga in 2005 and 2009.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1921 and 2011 marks the 91st year of the post-season classic.

CONFERENCE NOTES

POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference tied its league-best mark with four teams in the postseason for 2010. The league also placed four teams in postseason tournaments in 2009.

- The Wofford Terriers made their first appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2010. Wofford fell to Wisconsin 53-49 in the first round in Jacksonville, Fla.
- Western Carolina earned a berth in the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. The Catamounts fell to former SoCon member Marshall, 90-88 in Huntington, W.Va.
- Appalachian State defeated Harvard (93-71) and Marshall (80-72) in the CIT but dropped a 64-56 decision to Pacific in the semifinal.
