Quick Hits

- Chattanooga's Keegan Bell leads the Southern Conference and ranks sixth nationally with 7.1 assists per game.
- The Citadel's Mike Groselle leads the league in both scoring (16.9 ppg) and rebounding (9.7 rpg).
- Wofford head coach Mike Young has 147 wins as head coach of the Terriers and is tied with Lester Hooker (Richmond, 1952-63) for 15th place on the league's all-time wins list.
- The Southern Conference Tournament will be held in Asheville, N.C., March 2-5 at the newly renovated Asheville Civic Center. The league's tournament was held in Asheville from 1984-1995.

Player of the Week

Davidson forward Jake Cohen has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week for all games played January 10-16 the league office announced Tuesday (Jan. 17). It is the second consecutive week Cohen has won the award and the third time he has claimed the honor this season. The junior averaged 23.5 points and 6.5 rebounds in two games last week.

A junior, Cohen entered Thursday's game against Western Carolina with 987 points. The Berwyn, Pa., native scored Davidson's first 13 points of the game to reach 1,000 for his career. He finished the game with 26 points and six rebounds. Saturday afternoon against

Appalachian State, Cohen tallied 21 points and seven rebounds.

Cohen shot 67 percent from the field (16-of-24) and made five of seven three-point attempts last week. Cohen added five assists, five blocked shots and a steal in the two games.

Other top performers in the SoCon included ASU's Andre Williamson, CofC's Adjehi Baru, The Citadel's Mike Groselle, Furman's Brandon Sebirumbi, Georgia Southern's Eric Ferguson, UNCG's Trevis Simpson, Chattanooga's Z. Mason, Samford's Drew Windler, and Wofford's Brad Loesing.

MOUNTAINEERS

NORTH DIVISION

Appalachian split a pair of home games last week to move to 3-3 in Southern Conference play. The Mountaineers outlasted Furman, 56-50, in a low-scoring duel. It was ASU's fewest points in a win since the 2008-09 season. ASU then erased a 10-point deficit against Davidson on Saturday before eventually falling to the Wildcats, 83-79.

Six different players scored in double figures in ASU's two games last week, led by Omar Carter's 17 points against Davidson. Isaac Butts chipped in 10 points and nine rebounds in the game, his first action since December. Andre Williamson averaged 12.0 points and 5.5 rebounds to lead the Apps on the week.



COUGARS

SOUTH DIVISION

The Cougars pulled down a season-high 55 rebounds against Elon on Jan. 14. The last time CofC grabbed 50-or-more rebounds in a single game was 51 in a win at Davidson on Feb. 7, 2009. They outrebounded Elon by 16, their highest rebounding margin of the season.

The Cougars currently rank No. 39 nationally in three-point field goals per game (8.0) and No. 14 in personal fouls per game (15.3).

CofC will face two of the top teams in the Southern Conference race, both on the road, at undefeated Davidson (6-0) on Jan. 19 and at Georgia Southern (4-2) on Jan. 21.



PHOENIX

NORTH DIVISION

Sophomore Lucas Troutman is tied for the league lead with 1.6 blocked shots per game. He also ranks 15th in the SoCon with 5.8 rebounds per contest.

Elon has limited its opponents to just 29.5 percent shooting from three-point range, the 32nd best mark in the nation. Conversely, Elon averages 7.8 triples per contest, the 55th best mark in the country.

The Phoenix host Samford Thursday night and will take on Chattanooga Saturday at Alumni Gym.



BULLDOGS

SOUTH DIVISION

Mike Groselle, who finished with 17 points and 11 rebounds against Elon on January 12, took sole possession of third place on The Citadel's all-time double-double list with 17 in his career. He is now five short of Regan Truesdale for the most in program history.

Over the course of the last five games, Citadel senior Cosmo Morabbi has established several career firsts, including game-highs in rebounds (9 vs. Elon), assists (6 vs. Samford), and points (20 vs. Elon). He has also reached the double figure mark on four occasions in a single season, a career-first.



SPARTANS

NORTH DIVISION

The Spartans snapped 11-game losing streak with a 73-66 win at College of Charleston Thursday night. The win gave interim head coach Wes Miller his first victory.

UNCG came away with a 67-66 win at The Citadel Saturday night. It was the first time the Spartans swept a SoCon road trip since the 2007-08 season and was the first time this year UNCG earned back-to-back wins.

The Spartans host Chattanooga Thursday.



WILDCATS

SOUTH DIVISION

The Wildcats have won 14 of their last 15 SoCon regular-season games, dating back to last season. Davidson is the last unbeaten team in league play this season.

Davidson, which is shooting free throws at an 80 percent clip as a team, has made 20 or more in seven games this season. The Wildcats rank second nationally in free throw percentage behind Weber State.

The Wildcats host College of Charleston Thursday at Belk Arena.



BULLDOGS

NORTH DIVISION

Samford's 81 points scored against Chattanooga on Saturday was its third best scoring total of the season. The Bulldogs' performance against the Mocs has only been bested by home victories against Spring Hill (90) and Lindsey Wilson (82).

Samford underclassmen Drew Windler, Tyler Hood and Rajion Kelly combined to score 59 of the team's 81 points versus Chattanooga on Saturday. Windler, a sophomore, paced the team with a career-high 25 points, while freshmen Hood and Kelly followed with 15 points and 19 points, respectively.



PALADINS

SOUTH DIVISION

Freshman Jordan Loyd, making his first career start in place of injured sophomore Richard Brown, connected on 4-of-4 shots to net a career-high 10 points in Furman's triumph at Western Carolina Saturday.

Furman collected a season-high 10 steals in its 58-55 victory over Western Carolina. The Paladins average 5.2 steals per contest.

Furman will play seven of its next 11 games at home. The Paladins host Wofford Saturday afternoon.



MOCS

NORTH DIVISION

Over the last 12 games, UTC is allowing its opponents to shoot just 36.9 percent from the field including 27.8 percent from beyond the arc. Those numbers were 41.6 percent from the floor and 32.9 percent from three-point range in the first seven contests.

Keegan Bell passed Tim Brooks (1992-93) at Samford to move into first place all-time at Chattanooga with 221 assists in SoCon play.

Senior guard Ricky Taylor (1,078) is 30 points shy of the top 10 in scoring during UTC's Division I era.



EAGLES

SOUTH DIVISION

Georgia Southern is 4-2 in conference play after splitting a pair of games last week. The Eagles knocked off Samford at home Thursday night before falling at Wofford Saturday.

The Eagles lead the conference in field goal shooting (.472) and three-point shooting (.387). Sophomore Eric Ferguson ranks fourth in the SoCon, shooting 57 percent from the floor.

Georgia Southern hosts College of Charleston Saturday night. The Eagles welcome The Citadel to Statesboro Monday.



CATAMOUNTS

NORTH DIVISION

Western Carolina leads the league in turnover margin. The Catamounts are +0.8 in turnovers this season and force their opponents into 15.1 miscues a game.

Sophomore Trey Sumler has made 91.9 percent of his free throw attempts this season, the fifth best average in the nation.

The Catamounts host Toccoa Falls Tuesday night. Western Carolina travels to take on Appalachian State Saturday afternoon. The game will be televised by the SoCon Sports Network and will be available on ESPN3.



TERRIERS

SOUTH DIVISION

Against GSU, Wofford shot 61.5 percent from the floor, which marked a season high. The 88 points scored was also a season high as the Terriers have won six straight over the Eagles.

The Terriers are 7-1 at home this season. They are also 10-0 when leading at the half.

Wofford hosts Appalachian State Thursday night. The Terriers will visit Furman Saturday afternoon.

Conference News and Notes

Point Production

Davidson leads the Southern Conference with 79.6 points per game. College of Charleston ranks second with 71.6 points per contest.

- Either Davidson or College of Charleston has led the league in scoring every year since 2006.

Cousy Nominees

Chattanooga's Keegan Bell, College of Charleston's Andrew Lawrence, Davidson's JP Kuhlman and Western Carolina's Trey Sumler have been named to the Cousy Award Watch List. The Cousy Award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

Athletes of the Month

Antwaine Wiggins was earned December Athlete of the Month honors in men's basketball. Wiggins led College of Charleston to a 5-2 record in the month. He averaged a team-and conference-leading 18.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Wiggins tied a career-high with 24 points against his home state Tennessee Vols, including 15 in the second half of play. Wiggins also reached a milestone of his own becoming the 29th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points with his jumper at the 8:32 minute mark of the first half at Louisville on Dec. 20.

The Citadel's Mike Groselle was named the SoCon Athlete of the Month for men's basketball in November. Groselle recorded five double-doubles during the month. The junior center hit at least six field goals in all five games, including a 9-for-12 shooting performance against VMI. He averaged 18.2 points and 11.2 rebounds per game in November.

Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the Los Angeles Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

Southern Conference News and Notes

Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

Freshman Honors

UNCG's Trevis Simpson was named to the league's all-freshman team in 2011. It was the third consecutive year that a Spartan was named to the league's all-freshman squad.

- Point guard Kyle Randall was named to the all-freshman team in 2010, while Damian Eargle was selected in 2009.

Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

Annual Leaders

Furman limited its opponents to just 64.4 points per game last season. It marked the seventh consecutive season that a different team led the SoCon in scoring defense.

- College of Charleston's 1999-2000 team had the best scoring defense in league history, holding opponents to just 58.6 points per contest.

Western Carolina's Mike Williams led the league in steals last year (2.0 spg) making it four consecutive seasons that a Catamount has led the Southern Conference in steals.

- Brigham Wager, now an assistant coach at WCU, led the league in steals three consecutive seasons (2008-10).

College of Charleston led the league with 306 made three-pointers last year, the fifth highest single-season total in league history.

- Elon connected on 285 made triples last season, which tied for the ninth-best single season total.

SoCon Sports Network

This summer the conference office announced a partnership with Public Television to carry an eight-game Southern Conference men's basketball package. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry the league package. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
- A full list of affiliates and channel locations is available on the Southern Conference website.
