### Two-Minute Drill

• Three teams represent the Southern Conference in the Sports Network Poll, all three in the top 10. Furman is in the No. 4 spot in the poll with Appalachian State checking in at No. 6. Georgia Southern jumps two spots to No. 8 this week. Chattanooga also received votes. It marks the eighth time in the past two seasons that three SoCon teams have been ranked in the top 10 in the same week.

• The ESPN/USA Today Poll has three SoCon Schools ranked in the Top 25. Furman climbs back to No. 4 with Appalachian State at No. 6. Georgia Southern enters the top 10 at No. 9.

• Six student-athletes were named to the national award watch lists. Appalachian State's Richie Williams, Furman's Ingle Martin and Georgia Southern's Jermaine Austin are among the players on the Payton Award watch list. Appalachian State's Marques Murrell, Elon's Chad Nkang and Furman's William Freeman are all on the Buchanan Award watch list.

• ASU's Richie Williams became just the fourth player in SoCon history to throw at least 50 touchdown passes in a career. Williams is also 41 yards from becoming the fifth quarterback in league history to pass for 7,000 yards. He is 286 yards of total offense shy of becoming the league's all-time leader in that category.

• GSU's Jayson Foster tied a single-season league record by rushing for a touchdown in his 11th consecutive game. Foster leads the league with 19 rushing TD's, the sixth most in one season in conference history. It is also the third most in a year by a signal caller.

# Around the SoCon This Week

## Appalachian State (7-3, 5-1 SoCon)

Appalachian State clinched at least a share of the Southern Conference regular season title and the league's automatic bid to the NCAA playoffs this past Saturday with a 35-7 win over Western Carolina...It is the Mountaineers' first part of the conference crown since 1999 and they can win it outright for the first time since 1995 with a win over Elon on Saturday...ASU's four offensive touchdowns came on drives of 72, 86, 99 and 98 yards...The annual battle for the "Old Mountain Jug" drew 25,584 fans, setting an ASU record...QB **Richie Williams** became the school's career leader in touchdown passes after tossing two, bringing his career total to 51...Williams is one of only four players in league history to pass for 50 or more TDs in a career...RB **Kevin Richardson** rushed for a game-high 102 yards and scored a pair of TDs, registering his fourth 100-yard game of the season...Williams, who passed for 164 yards, also rushed for 84...DB **Corey Lynch** led the ASU defense with 11 tackles, while DL **Marques Murrell** and LB **Zodd Kelly** each had a pair of sacks.

## The Citadel (3-7, 2-5 SoCon)

The Citadel snapped a five-game losing streak with a 21-0 win over Elon...It was the school's first shutout victory since blanking Western Carolina to end the 2004 season...The win also improved The Citadel's record to 33-20 in Homecoming games...The Bulldogs outgained the Phoenix 259-230 despite running 14 fewer offensive plays...The Citadel scored on two of the team's three chances in the red zone...QB **Ben Carnell** was 14-for-20 for 152 yards and two touchdowns in his first career start...RB **Nuru Goodrum** led the ground attack with 97 yards on 24 carries...The defense limited Elon to 14 first downs and only 76 yards on the ground...The Bulldogs close out the season at VMI on Saturday for the Military Classic of the South.

## Chattanooga (6-4, 3-3 SoCon)

Chattanooga was idle last week and finishes out the regular season at home against Furman... The Mocs, two weekends ago, ended a two-game losing streak with a 31-21 win at home over The Citadel, giving the Mocs their first winning season since 1997...RB **Eldra Buckley** had a game-high 187 yards on the ground, his fifth 100-yard game of the year – and fourth in the past five weeks...Buckley also rushed for three touchdowns, all coming in the first half...Buckley moved past 1,000 yards rushing on the season, becoming the first Moc to surpass 1,000 yards since Tyrone Coleman rushed for a school-record 1,191 yards in 1998...In his last two games, Buckley has rushed for 397 yards, the ninth-highest two-game total in league history...QB **Antonio Miller**, who was 6-of-13 for 73 yards, also carried the ball nine times for 54 yards and a TD...WR **Emanuel Hassell** had three receptions for 43 yards...LB **Jeff Phillips** and DB **Lonnie McCowan** tied for team honors with nine tackles apiece...The Mocs' game with Furman will be aired on CSS.

## Elon (3-7, 0-6 SoCon)

Elon lost its sixth in a row on Saturday, dropping a 21-0 decision at The Citadel...RB **Reggie Hall** led the Phoenix with 77 yards on the ground on 27 carries...QB **Kye Hamilton** was 19-for-35 for 154 yards and one interception...WR **Michael Mayers** caught a game-high seven passes for 49 yards...WR **Bo Williamson** added five catches for 37 yards...The Phoenix closes out its season on Saturday hosting Appalachian State.

## Furman (8-2, 4-2 SoCon)

Furman moved to 8-2 on the season with a 34-21 win over Wofford...QB **Ingle Martin** was 16-of-24 for 180 yards and one touchdown...Martin completed passes to eight different receivers...The Paladins recorded 243 yards on the ground and were led by RB **Brandon Mays**' 91 yards...RB **Daric Carter** added 68 yards rushing and scored two touchdowns...A total of 13,764 fans attended the game, the second-highest Furman crowd of the season...K **Scott Beckler** kicked a season-long 43-yard field goal in the third quarter...LB **Andrew Jones** recorded a team-high nine tackles...The Paladins close out the regular season on Saturday at Chattanooga...The game will be televised on CSS.

## Georgia Southern (8-3, 5-2 SoCon)

Georgia Southern completed the regular season on Saturday with a 63-17 win over Morehead State...The Eagles scored 21 points in each of the first three quarters and finished the game with 526 yards of offense...Of the 526 yards, 455 of them came on the ground...RB **Jermaine Austin** led the Eagles with 118 yards and one touchdown...Three QBs played in the game for the Eagles and finished with 205 yards rushing and three touchdowns...Redshirt freshman QB **Melvin Greer** had 91 rushing yards while QBs **Darius Smiley** and **Jayson Foster** added 66 and 48 yards, respectively...Foster scored twice on the ground and also threw a pair of TDs to WR **Teddy Craft**...P **Dan Jordan** averaged 52.5 yards on two punts, with one of them going 69 yards...LB **John Mohring** had seven tackles, including one sack and two total for losses.

## Western Carolina (5-4, 4-3 SoCon)

Western Carolina concluded its regular season with a 35-7 loss at Appalachian State...The Catamounts lost for the 11<sup>th</sup> straight time to the Mountaineers in Boone...RB **Darius Fudge** led the Catamounts with 81 yards rushing...QB **Justin Clark** was 9-of-15 for 104 yards and had two interceptions...Reserve QB **Josh Lee** went 5-of-7 for 47 yards and accounted for the team's lone score, a five-yard strike to WR **Michael Hines**...Hines finished the game with three catches for 57 yards, tying with Fudge for team honors in receptions...LB **Lamar Barnes** paced the defense with a career-high 12 tackles, including one for loss...DB **Mitchell Dukes** added 10 tackles

## Wofford (5-5, 3-4 SoCon)

Wofford ended its league schedule with a 34-21 loss at Furman...The Terriers registered 383 yards of total offense and recorded 21 first downs...QB **Josh Collier** had a career-high 101 yards on the ground and scored a touchdown while also passing for another 69 yards on a career-best eight completions...RB **Adrian Young** added 68 yards on 16 carries, while RB **Dane Romero** accumulated 52 yards on only five rushes...Backup QB **Ben Widmyer** completed all four of his passes and tossed his first career TD, a 32-yard pass to WR **Andy Strickland** – also Strickland's first career TD reception...HB **Aaron Johnson** led the Terriers with four catches for 29 yards...LB **Jim Thurman** had a game-high 11 tackles, eight of which were solo...The Terriers close out the season on the road at Gardner-Webb.

**Wofford (5-5, 3-4 SoCon) at Gardner-Webb (5-5, 2-2 Big South), Noon**  
Spangler Stadium (9,500) • Boiling Springs, NC



**THE GAME:** This is the 19th meeting between the two schools...Wofford leads the series 12-6 and the Terriers have won the last two meetings, including a 49-17 win last year in Spartanburg...Gardner-Webb has won the last three games on its home field...Wofford is coming off a 34-21 loss to No. 6 Furman, while the Bulldogs won last week at Savannah State, 31-21...SoCon schools are 5-1 vs. teams from the Big South this year...Wofford QB Josh Collier rushed for a career-high 101 yards against Furman last week for his first 100-yard game of his career...A win for the Terriers would give the school a winning record for the fourth straight season and sixth time in the past seven years.

**THE COACHES:** Mike Ayers (Georgetown (KY) '74) is Wofford's all-time winningest coach with a record of 115-85-1 in his 17 years at the helm...Ayers is 2-0 vs. GWU while at Wofford...Steve Patton (Furman '77) is in his ninth season at GWU and has an overall record of 61-36.

**THE GAME:** This is the 64th meeting between two the military schools...The Bulldogs defeated the Keydets 27-23 two seasons ago in Charlotte...This is the first time since 2001 that the game is being played on either of the two campuses...The Citadel shut out Elon last week 21-0 to end a five-game losing streak...VMI lost 28-26 to then-No. 13 Lehigh...VMI head coach Cal McCombs is a 1967 graduate of The Citadel...QB Ben Carnell made his first career start for the Bulldogs and completed 14-of-20 passes for 152 yards and two touchdowns...RB Nuru Goodrum is averaging 69.4 ypg, eighth in the SoCon...WR Ta'Mar Jernigan leads the Bulldogs with 37 catches for 349 yards...Jernigan is tied for fourth in the league averaging 3.7 receptions per game...The Bulldogs have closed out the season on a winning note in two of the past three campaigns and four times in the last eight years.

**THE COACHES:** Kevin Higgins (West Chester '77) is in his first season as coach of the Bulldogs and is 3-7 overall... Higgins was 56-26-1 at Lehigh from 1994-2000, his first collegiate head coaching position...Cal McCombs (The Citadel '67) is in his seventh season at VMI and has a 19-59 record during his tenure at VMI.

**THE GAME:** The 35th meeting between the two schools, with Furman holding a 21-13 advantage...The Paladins have won the past 10 encounters with the Mocs, including a 51-31 victory last year in Greenville...Furman is averaging 41.5 points a game during its last 10 games with UTC...The Paladins are coming off a 34-21 win at home over Wofford, while the Mocs were idle last week...A win by Furman and an Appalachian State loss would give the Paladins a share of the league title for the 13th time -- 7 outright titles and 5 shared...Prior to the bye week, the Mocs pulled out a 31-21 win over The Citadel on Nov. 5...QB Ingle Martin is 127 yards shy of becoming only the second Furman quarterback to pass for 5,000 yards in a career...Martin's 5,306 yards of total offense ranks fifth in the Paladin record books and needs only 48 yards to move up to second...RBs Jerome Felton (63.1 ypg) and Daric Carter (56.3) rank ninth and tenth, respectively, in the SoCon in rushing yards per game and have accounted for 17 of the team's 30 rushing TDs...LB William Freeman is ten tackles shy of reaching 300 for his career...UTC RB Eldra Buckley is 100 yards short of tying Tyron Coleman's single season record of 1,191 rushing yards...WR Emanuel Hassell leads the league with 48 receptions...UTC is 3-1 this year at home and is averaging 26.5 points a game on its home field.

## This Date in Southern Conference History

**Nov. 19, 1983:** Eventual Southern Conference Player of the Year Stanford Jennings spoiled The Citadel's homecoming festivities, rushing for 143 yards and two touchdowns, as the Paladins of Furman beat their rival, 49-21, before 17,890 at Johnson Hagood Stadium. In his first collegiate start at quarterback, The Citadel's Lee Glaze passed for 202 yards in the loss.

**Nov. 19, 1977:** The Citadel scored seven points in the fourth quarter to defeat Furman 10-3 in Charleston. The Paladins were held under 98 net yards rushing for only the second time in 1977 in the loss to the Bulldogs.

**Nov. 19, 1977:** UTC's freshman running back tandem of Gwain Durden and Mike Smith made sure that they both reached 1,000 yards in 1977 in their 37-20 win over Marshall. Smith rushed for 150 yards and a touchdown in the win, while Durden rushed for 120 yards and two touchdowns to become the first freshmen couplet in NCAA history to gain over 1,000 yards a piece in a single season. The win over Marshall also gave Southern Conference Coach of the Year Joe Morrison and his team a share of the SoCon title with VMI in 1977.

**Nov. 19, 1994:** In a game that the Eagles could not score a touchdown, Georgia Southern placekicker Reed Haley set new school records by making the first five of his of six field goal attempts in the Eagles' 17-15 loss to The Citadel. The seventh try by Haley on the game's final play - a 36-yard attempt - let the Bulldogs escape with a win after the ball sailed wide right.

**Nov. 19, 1994:** Sam Scadlock gave The Citadel a dramatic win over their archrival Furman when he scored from seven yards out with 25 seconds left in the contest to give the Bulldogs a 10-3 season-ending win over the Paladins.

**Nov. 19, 1983:** Western Carolina locked up an NCAA Division I-AA playoff bid with an impressive 41-15 win over archrival Appalachian State. The win ended the Cats regular season with nine straight wins.

**Nov. 19, 1994:** UTC made sure that they added a dagger to Furman's first losing season in 15 years by defeating the Paladins 34-20 in the season finale for both teams. The win for the Mocs gave Buddy Green a 3-8 record in his first season as coach of the Mocs, while the loss by the Paladins gave current Vanderbilt coach Bobby Johnson a 3-8 overall record in his first year in charge of the Paladins program.
