## CONFERENCE NOTES

### POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference placed a league-best four teams in postseason tournaments for 2009. Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The SoCon has made 62 appearances in the NCAA Tournament and owns an overall record of 31-66 in the Big Dance.

- The Mocs are making their 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Chattanooga fell to Wake Forest (70-54) in the first round of the New Mexico Regional in 2005.
- Davidson is making its fifth appearance in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). The Wildcats are 2-4 all-time in the NIT and advanced to the third round in their most recent trip in 2005.
- College of Charleston travels to take on Troy in the College Basketball Invitational. It is the eighth time CofC is making a postseason appearance.
- The Citadel will face Old Dominion in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.

### SCORING LEADER

Davidson junior guard Stephen Curry scored 20 points against College of Charleston in the semifinals of the conference tournament to become the league's all-time leading scorer. Curry poured in 43 points against Appalachian State in the quarterfinals before passing Skip Henderson's (1983-88) career scoring mark of 2,574. Curry now has 2,577 career points in three years with the Wildcats.

- Curry also owns the league record for made three pointers in a career with 405 triples.

### RPI STRENGTH

The Southern Conference ranks 21st in the Men's Basketball RPI Report, released March 16. The league has garnered the second most difficult non-conference strength of schedule rating among 31 Division I conferences.

- Five of the 12 Southern Conference teams all rank in the top 175 of the RPI (Davidson - 69; College of Charleston - 102; Wofford - 172; Chattanooga - 174; The Citadel - 175).

### TWO FOR THREE

The Southern Conference was the first league to implement a three-point line, establishing the mark at 22 feet during the 1980-81 season. Western Carolina's Ronnie Carr made the first three-point field goal in college basketball history in a game against Middle Tennessee State on November 29, 1980.

- Georgia Southern's Willie Powers made the first three-point field goal for the 2008-09 season, knocking down a triple against Houston on November 10. It was the first made three-point field goal from the new distance of 20-feet, nine inches.
