## Quick Hits

- Davidson has clinched a first-round bye in the SoCon Tournament.
- Georgia Southern's 10-game improvement in league play is tied for the third best turnaround in league history.
- Four league teams will participate in BracketBusters on Saturday, February 18. Davidson and Appalachian State will be at home, while College of Charleston and Wofford are on the road. The SoCon is 17-12 all-time in BracketBusters.
- The Southern Conference Tournament will be held in Asheville, N.C., March 2-5 at the newly renovated U.S. Cellular Center. The league's tournament was held in Asheville from 1984-1995.

## Player of the Week

UNCG's Trevis Simpson has been named the Southern Conference Player of the Week. Simpson averaged 26.5 points per game last week as UNCG picked up road wins at Samford and Chattanooga.

Simpson poured in a game-high 25 points and seven rebounds at Samford as the Spartans came away with a two-point victory. On the road at Chattanooga, Simpson tallied 24 points on 11-of-18 shooting, including 18 points in the second half. Trailing by four with 1:29 to play, Simpson hit a three-pointer to pull the Spartans to within one before teammate Derrell Armstrong scored with 16 seconds left to lift UNCG to the win.

The sophomore has scored at least 23 points in each of his last six games and is averaging 25.7 points per contest over that stretch, while UNCG is 5-1 in those games.

Other top performers in the Southern Conference included Appalachian State's Mike Neal, College of Charleston's Antwaine Wiggins, The Citadel's Ashton Moore, Davidson's De'Mon Brooks, Georgia Southern's Eric Ferguson, Chattanooga's Omar Wattad, Samford's Tyler Hood, Western Carolina's Brandon Boggs and Wofford's Brad Loesing.



**UNCG SPARTANS**

**MOUNTAINEERS**

Appalachian State split two games on the week with a 10-point win at Furman and narrow home defeat against Wofford on Saturday. The Mountaineers close out their home slate this week against Chattanooga and Winthrop. The Winthrop contest is ASU's seventh BracketBuster appearance.

Mike Neal led ASU in scoring in both games last week with 16.5 points per contest and a career-high 18 points at Furman, including a 12-of-14 mark at the line. The freshman point guard has made 15 starts and ranks among the league leaders in assists (3.0) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.1) on the season.

**PHOENIX**

Sophomore Jack Isenbarger knocked down seven three-pointers Saturday at Samford. The guard ranks third in the league with 2.6 made triples per game and has connected on 40 percent of his attempts from beyond the arc.

The Phoenix has eight league wins, the most under head coach Matt Matheny. Elon is one win shy of tying the most overall victories under Matheny (14).

Elon travels to Wofford Wednesday night. The Phoenix host Western Carolina Saturday afternoon.

**SPARTANS**

The Spartans earned road wins over Samford (71-69) and UNCG (77-76) last week. UNCG has now won 9 of its last 10 games, its most successful 10-game stretch since the 1994-95 squad also won 9 of 10.

UNCG's nine SoCon victories are the most since the 2007-08 squad won 12 league games.

Sophomore Trevis Simpson needs just 29 points to become the ninth player in school history to score 500 points in a season.

The Spartans host College of Charleston Wednesday.

**BULLDOGS**

Since Samford switched to its matchup-zone defense on Jan. 12, the Bulldogs have compiled a 7-4 record and are only allowing opponents to score 66.2 points per game. Prior to the switch, Samford was allowing 71 points per outing. The Bulldogs' opponents are only shooting 40.5 percent from the field, as compared to 45.6 percent prior to making the defensive change.

Samford's Jeffrey Merritt will make his 37th consecutive start Wednesday in a streak that began Jan. 27, 2011, at Elon. The Bulldogs' senior guard has started in 85 of the team's last 87 games dating back to the beginning of his sophomore season in 2009-10.

**MOCS**

Senior guard Keegan Bell has 513 assists at Chattanooga. He is 17 assists from the 10th-most in SoCon history (530, Kevin Young, Western Carolina, 1979-82).

Senior guard Ricky Taylor is eight points shy of 1200 for his career.

Senior forward Jahmal Burroughs had 21 points and 20 rebounds in the last two contests after missing the previous three with a hamstring injury.

The Mocs visit Appalachian State Wednesday.

**CATAMOUNTS**

Senior Harouna Mutombo has moved into 15th-place in WCU history with 1,434 career points, passing former standouts Brandon Giles (1,424, 2006-10) and Harris Pryor (1,429, 1956-59). Mutombo is fourth in school history with 175 career steals, while senior Keaton Cole has moved into sixth in school history with 169 career 3-pointers.

Three of WCU's final four games will be played at home beginning with Thursday night's meeting with The Citadel Bulldogs.

**NORTH DIVISION****COUGARS**

The Cougars currently rank No. 29 nationally in three-point field goals per game (8.2 avg) and No. 38 in personal fouls per game (16.2 avg).

The Cougars will participate in their third consecutive ESPN Sears BracketBusters game traveling to Kent State on Feb. 18 in a rematch of the only meeting between the two in the 2003 NIT First Round.

College of Charleston is currently on a three-game winning streak and will play two on the road this week including a midweek clash with UNCG Wednesday.

**BULLDOGS**

Freshman guard Ashton Moore, who hit a perfect 10-of-10 from the free throw line against Georgia Southern (Feb. 11) became the first Citadel player to hit 10 free throws in a game, since Cameron Wells converted 11 free throws against Wofford (Feb. 5, 2011).

Mike Groselle enters the week tied with Patrick Elmore for most single season double-doubles in program history. Groselle, who has 12 this season, has tied a mark set by Patrick Elmore in 1989-90.

The Bulldogs visit Western Carolina Thursday.

**WILDCATS**

The Wildcats have won 21 of their last 24 SoCon regular-season games, dating back to last season.

Davidson has won 17 of its last 18 in Belk Arena with the lone loss coming to Vanderbilt on December 7. The Wildcats will host Samford Wednesday evening.

The Wildcats will host Wichita State in a BracketBusters game Feb. 18, at noon in Belk Arena. The game will be televised on ESPN2.

**PALADINS**

Charlie Reddick scored a game-high 16 points and Bryant Irwin added 14 off the bench as Furman held off Western Carolina 80-66, Saturday. The Paladins shot 54 percent from the field in the win.

The Paladins rank second in the conference in scoring defense, as they have yielded just 65.6 points per game. Furman leads the conference in defending the three-point arc. The Paladins' opponents are shooting just 30 percent from three-point range.

Furman travels to Samford Saturday afternoon.

**EAGLES**

Sophomore Eric Ferguson ranks fifth in the league in scoring (15.4 ppg) and is third in rebounding (7.2 rpg). He is one of just two players to rank in the top five in both categories. Ferguson is shooting 57 percent from the field which is the fourth best mark in the conference.

After winning just one league game last season, Georgia Southern has 11 conference wins through 15 games. The Eagles are currently in second place in the South Division.

Georgia Southern will host UNCG Saturday night.

**TERRIERS**

Wofford is now 16-11 following Saturday's win at Appalachian State. With just four games left in the regular season, the Terriers are assured a .500 season or better for the fifth straight season.

Senior guard Brad Loesing has led the Terriers in scoring in the last four games and leads the nation in minutes played at 38.8 mpg.

Wofford is 14-1 when leading at the half this season.

The Terriers host Elon Wednesday night.

## Conference News and Notes

### One Possession Games

The Southern Conference has played 87 league games as of February 10. A total of 29 games (33 percent) have either been decided by one possession or gone into overtime.

- There have been eight games that have gone to overtime, while 21 contests have been decided by one possession at the end of regulation.

### Moving Forward

Georgia Southern has won 11 conference games this season after going 1-15 in league play last year. The Eagles' nine-game improvement is among the best mark in league history.

### Athletes of the Month

Jake Cohen earned Player of the Month honors in January as he averaged 18.5 points, 6.4 rebounds and 1.7 blocked shots per game in a 7-1 month for the Wildcats. The junior forward had five consecutive games with 20-plus points and two double-doubles during the month. Cohen shot 59 percent from the floor, 50 percent from 3-point range and 88 percent from the free-throw line for the month.

Antwaine Wiggins was earned December Athlete of the Month honors in men's basketball. Wiggins led College of Charleston to a 5-2 record in the month. He averaged a team-and conference-leading 18.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Wiggins tied a career-high with 24 points against his home state Tennessee Vols, including 15 in the second half of play. Wiggins also reached a milestone of his own becoming the 29th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points with his jumper at the 8:32 minute mark of the first half at Louisville on Dec. 20.

The Citadel's Mike Groselle was named the SoCon Athlete of the Month for men's basketball in November. Groselle recorded five double-doubles during the month. The junior center hit at least six field goals in all five games, including a 9-for-12 shooting performance against VMI. He averaged 18.2 points and 11.2 rebounds per game in November.

### Point Production

Davidson leads the Southern Conference with 78.7 points per game.

- Either Davidson or College of Charleston has led the league in scoring every year since 2006.

## Southern Conference News and Notes

### Making The Leap

The Southern Conference has had four teams improve their win total by a minimum of nine games over the last three years.

- Furman won 22 games last year after posting just 13 wins in 2010.
- Wofford went from 16 wins in 2009 to 26 victories in 2010.
- Both College of Charleston and The Citadel made impressive jumps in 2009. The Cougars went from 16 wins in 2008 to 27 the next year. The Citadel had one of the greatest turnarounds in league history, improving from just six wins in 2008 to 20 in 2009.

### Divisional Play

The Southern Conference established the North and South divisions in men's basketball prior to the 1994-95 season. Nine of the 12 current members have won at least a share of a division championship over the last 17 seasons. The Citadel, Furman and Samford, which joined the league in 2008, have not won their division.

- Davidson leads the league with 10 division championships while Chattanooga has won eight.

### Repeat Performance

The Wofford Terriers won the conference tournament in 2011 after winning the title in 2010. It was the 16th time a team had won at least back-to-back conference tournament championships.

### Turning Two

Wofford won the league's men's basketball championship in 2011 after winning a share of the conference football crown the previous fall, becoming just the fifth school in league history to win both championships in the same year.

- Appalachian State was the last team to win both titles as the Mountaineers accomplished the rare feat during the 1999-2000 school year. Davidson won both championships in 1969-70.
- Duke won both titles in the same year three times during the 1940s, while West Virginia won the SoCon football and basketball championships in the same academic year five different times.

### Making The Grade

In addition to achieving success on the court, SoCon men's basketball teams boast impressive academic credentials. In the latest data released by the NCAA in May, Southern Conference men's basketball teams posted an Academic Progress Rate (APR) of 959, seven points higher than the national average of 952 for Division I football programs. It was the third consecutive season that the SoCon average was higher than the national rate for Division I.

- The Southern Conference's overall APR score of 978 was the ninth-highest among 31 Division I conferences.
- The NCAA released its Graduation Success Rate scores October 25. Nine of the twelve SoCon teams met or exceeded the national average for Division I men's basketball programs.

### NBA Draft

College of Charleston's Andrew Goudelock was selected in the second round (#46 overall) of the NBA draft by the L.A. Lakers. Goudelock became the 107th Southern Conference player taken in the draft and the first Cougar to be selected after competing in the league.

- Seven of the league's 12 members have had at least one player taken in the NBA draft.

### SoCon Sports Network

This summer the conference office announced a partnership with Public Television to carry an eight-game Southern Conference men's basketball package. The agreement provides state-wide distribution of SoCon games throughout Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. Additional affiliates in Birmingham, Ala., and Chattanooga, Tenn., have also signed on to carry the league package. The distribution platform will reach more than 12 million homes through 34 affiliates.

- Each of the eight games produced for public television will be streamed online live through ESPN3 as well as the respective public television websites.
- A full list of affiliates and channel locations is available on the Southern Conference website.

## Tournament History

### Postseason Play
