PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jeremy Simmons - CofC

Simmons averaged 19.0 points and 11.5 rebounds as College of Charleston earned wins over Appalachian State (73-72) and at George Mason (85-83). The player of the week is selected by the conference office.

The junior posted a double-double with a career-high 20 points and 10 rebounds in the win over Appalachian State. Simmons shot 9-of-12 from the field against the Mountaineers and pulled down eight offensive rebounds in the win. He then scored 18 points and grabbed 13 rebounds in CofC's victory at George Mason Saturday night. It was Simmons' sixth career double-double.

The forward leads the league in blocked shots per game (2.3 bpg) and is second in the conference with 8.1 rebounds per contest. Simmons is 14th in the league in scoring with 12.3 points per game and is second in field goal percentage (.604).

TEAM REPORTS

APPALACHIAN STATE MOUNTAINEERS



- Appalachian State clinched the North's top seed and no less than a share of the division title on Monday with a 58-54 win at Elon. It is the third division title in four seasons for the Mountaineers, who own the tie-breaker with Western Carolina. Appalachian needs just one win in its last two games to win the title outright.
- With 584 points on the season, Donald Sims ranks fifth on ASU's single-season scoring list, one point behind fourth. He leads the league with 20.1 points per game and has matched last season's total of 90 three-pointers made.
- Appalachian State hosts Chattanooga Thursday night.

ELON PHOENIX



- Senior Adam Constantine recorded his seventh and eighth double-double of the season last week. Constantine scored 24 points and grabbed 14 rebounds against College of Charleston before tallying 25 points and 15 rebounds against The Citadel.
- TJ Douglas turned in a strong week for the Phoenix last week, averaging 11.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game. Douglas is averaging 7.6 points and 4.3 rebounds per game this season for Elon.
- The Phoenix visit Georgia Southern Thursday night.

UNC GREENSBORO SPARTANS



- Senior Mikko Koivisto scored 18 points at The Citadel Saturday afternoon. It was the fourth straight game and the ninth time in the last ten contests that Koivisto has scored in double figures. He has averaged 13.6 points per game over his last 10 outings, despite averaging just 8.7 points on the season.
- Ben Stywall and Kendall Toney have both played in 118 consecutive games -- having never missed a game in their careers. The school record for consecutive games played is 119 by Jay Joseph.
- The Spartans visit Davidson Wednesday night.

SAMFORD BULLDOGS



- Samford's Trey Montgomery scored 14 points against Georgia Southern and moved to within four points of reaching the historic 1,000-point plateau. The Bulldogs' senior from Destrehan, La., is currently Samford's 21st-ranked player on the all-time scoring list and will enter Thursday's game at Western Carolina with 996 career points.
- Montgomery will be making his 86th-consecutive start Thursday. The Bulldogs' three-year starting point guard has been listed among the starting five in every game since Nov. 26, 2007.
- Samford visits Western Carolina Thursday.

CHATTANOOGA MOCS




- In the last eight games, Chattanooga has committed 96 turnovers, an average of 12.0 per game. UTC was averaging 17.8 turnovers per contest with a -2.4 turnover margin and had an assist-to-turnover ratio of 0.83 entering that span.
- Over his last six games, sophomore Keegan Bell has recorded 30 assists (5.0 apg) and nine turnovers for a ratio of 3.33. In his previous 23 games, Bell had a ratio of 1.42 (104 assists to 73 turnovers).
- Chattanooga visits Appalachian State Thursday.

WESTERN CAROLINA CATAMOUNTS



- Western Carolina has won 19 games this season, matching the most wins in a single-season as a NCAA Division I program. WCU's 19 wins tie the 1981-82 Catamounts who won 19 games under head coach Steve Cottrell. The 19 victories are the most for WCU under head coach Larry Hunter.
- WCU senior Jake Robinson sits in seventh place on the SoCon's career made three-pointers chart with 267, just three shy of sixth place D.J. Thompson of Appalachian State (270).
- Western Carolina hosts Samford Thursday night.

COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON COUGARS



- The Cougars enter the final two games of the regular season looking for their 20th win. College of Charleston has posted 22 20-win seasons in its history and has done it twice in the last three years.
- Andrew Goudelock scored 15 points at George Mason and became the College of Charleston's Division I scoring leader. His 1,573 career points surpasses Thaddeaus Delaney, who had 1,564. Goudelock is fourth all-time at CofC with 1,409 career points.
- College of Charleston visits Wofford Thursday night. The Cougars finish the regular season at Furman Saturday.

THE CITADEL BULLDOGS



- The Citadel has now had back-to-back winning February's for the first time since the 1988-89 and 1989-90 seasons. The Citadel have a record of 6-1 (2008-09) and 5-1 (2009-10) under Ed Conroy the last two years. It marks the first time since the Randy Nesbit tenure with the Bulldogs that the team has finished with consecutive winning February's.
- Freshman Harrison DuPont has scored double figures in points in the second half in three of the last four games, beginning with an 11-point showing against the College of Charleston on Feb. 8.
- The Bulldogs visit Furman Thursday. The Citadel will close the regular season Saturday at Wofford.

DAVIDSON WILDCATS



- The Wildcats have won 12 of their last 18 and six of their last nine contests. Davidson finished with a 7-3 record against SoCon South Division opponents. The Wildcats close the season with five times in 11 days, including three games at Belk Arena.
- With two triples at Chattanooga, Bryant Barr moved into a tie for fifth place with Jason Zimmerman on Davidson's career made three-pointers list.
- The Wildcats host UNC Greensboro Wednesday night. Davidson will visit Elon Saturday to close out the regular season.

FURMAN PALADINS



- The Paladins are second in the league, and rank 30th nationally, in blocked shots per game (5.0 bpg). Freshman Colin Reddick is sixth in the league with 1.3 blocks per game while teammate Bryson Barnes is eighth with 1.2 rejections per contest.
- Junior Jordan Miller scored a career-high 31 points in Furman's 87-78 win at Chattanooga last Saturday. Miller and teammate Amu Saaka have combined for three of the seven 30-point games in the conference this season. Saaka is fifth in the league in scoring (16.1 ppg), while Miller ranks eighth (14.0 ppg).
- Furman hosts The Citadel Thursday night at Timmons Arena. The Paladins entertain College of Charleston Saturday.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN EAGLES



- Rory Spencer broke the Eagles single-season blocks record, surpassing Louis Graham's mark of 57 set in 2005-06 with his four-blocks at Samford. Spencer has 60 in 2009-10 and is now tied for sixth on the GSU career list with Hamp Jones (1996-2000) in his first season at Georgia Southern.
- Willie Powers recorded his first career double-double with a career-best 11 assists and 12 points at Samford, good for his 10th straight double-figure scoring game.
- Georgia Southern hosts Elon Thursday at Hanner Fieldhouse.

WOFFORD TERRIERS



- Wofford has won eight games in a row – all conference games – the longest streak of the season and the Terriers' longest winning streak since moving to Division I.
- Wofford's Tim Johnson (11 pts., 12 reb.) and Noah Dahlman (21 pts., 10 reb.) each recorded a double-double in Saturday's win at Georgia Southern. It was the first time the two have both posted a double-double in the same game since December 20, 2008 at Georgia.
- The Terriers host College of Charleston Thursday night.

CONFERENCE NOTES

ANNUAL LEADERS

Wofford junior Noah Dahlman has led the league in field goal percentage each of the past two seasons. Dahlman shot .609 from the field as a freshman and .601 last year. If he is able to lead the conference shooting percentage again, he would be the first player to lead the league in field goal percentage three straight seasons since Joe Holup of George Washington (1954-56).

Western Carolina junior Brigham Waginger led the league in steals in 2008 (69) and 2009 (81). Should he lead the league in steals again this season it would be the first time the same player has led the conference for three consecutive seasons. East Tennessee State's Keith Jennings is the only other player in league history to lead the league in steals for three seasons (1988, 1989, 1991).

Davidson has led the league in scoring each of the past four seasons. The only team to lead the conference in scoring for more than four straight years was West Virginia. The Mountaineers were the top scoring team in the league for seven consecutive seasons from 1957-1963.

ALL-DECade RECOGNITION

CollegeInsider.com recently released its All-Decade team which featured the top 25 players from the past decade (2000-2009). Davidson's Stephen Curry (2006-09) was named to the All-Decade Team. He finished his career as the league's leading scorer with 2,635 points in three years.

- Western Carolina's Kevin Martin (2001-04) and East Tennessee State's Tim Smith (2002-06) were named to the Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Martin led the league in scoring in 2003 and 2004 before being taken in the first round of the 2004 NBA Draft by the Sacramento Kings. A two-time SoCon Tourney MVP, Smith was the league's leading scorer in 2005.

SCHEDULE CHANGE

Following a 20-game league schedule each of the past two seasons, the SoCon Council of Presidents voted to move to an 18-game league slate beginning 2009-10. The last time the conference played 18 league games was during the 2006-07 season. The SoCon also played 18 games during the 1992-93 and 1993-94 seasons.

SoCon TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Southern Conference Tournament will be held March 5-8 in Charlotte. The first two round (March 5-6) will take place at Bojangles Coliseum while the semifinals and finals (March 7-8) will take place at Time Warner Cable Arena. It will mark the league's first conference tournament in Charlotte since 1971.

The oldest league tournament in the nation, the first tournament was held in 1922 and 2010 will mark the 89th year of the post-season classic.

FAMILIAR FACES

A total of 116 lettermen returned to the Southern Conference in 2009-10. No team had fewer than seven returning lettermen and seven schools boasted at least 10 returnees from last season. League teams averaged 9.7 returners from 2008-09.

- Conference teams returned 41 starters from last year, an average of 3.4 per team. Three teams (Furman, Western Carolina and Wofford) return all five starters.

HEAD COACHES

Nine of the league's 12 head coaches return to the bench in 2009-10. The current head coaches have a combined 58 years of experience within the SoCon.

- Buzz Peterson returned to Appalachian State after guiding the Mountaineers from 1997-2000. Matt Matheny took over the Elon Phoenix after spending 16 years on Bob McKillop's staff at Davidson and Charlton Young returned to his alma mater to take over the Georgia Southern Eagles.
- Four SoCon coaches have won at least 100 games at their current school. Bob McKillop is approaching the 400-win plateau at Davidson while Samford's Jimmy Tillette has topped 200 wins. UNCG's Mike Dement, Chattanooga's John Shulman and Wofford's Mike Young all have at least 100 wins at their current school.

POSTSEASON PLAY

The Southern Conference placed a league-best four teams in postseason tournaments last season. Chattanooga earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

- The Mocs made their 10th appearance in the NCAA Tournament. Chattanooga fell to Wake Forest (70-54) in the first round of the New Mexico Regional in 2005 before falling to UConn last year.
- Davidson made its fifth appearance in the National Invitational Tournament (NIT). The Wildcats are 3-5 all-time in the NIT after losing at Saint Mary's in the second round.
- College of Charleston lost at Richmond in the second round of the College Basketball Invitational. It was the eighth postseason appearance for CofC.
- The Citadel fell to Old Dominion in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.
