CHIEF'S CROWN, unhurried while settling into best stride early, rallied strongly outside horses entering the stretch, gradually wore down **SPEND A BUCK**, then out finished **TANK'S PROSPECT** in the final sixteenth. The latter lacked early speed, rallied strongly between horses entering the stretch, angled inside the leaders for the final furlong but could not overtake the winner. **SPEND A BUCK** engaged for the lead outside **PROUDEST HOUR** soon after the start, moved to a clear lead at the far turn, responded when challenged again in the stretch but could not last. **SCRIPT OHIO** lacked early speed, responded when roused for the drive on the stretch turn but drifted out through the stretch and did not reach contention. **BIONIC LIGHT**, in close contention outside horses through the backstretch, gradually weakened after six furlongs. **DAUPHIN FABULEUX**, outrun for six furlongs, passed mostly tired horses in the stretch as did **CONCERT HALL**. **SPECTACULAR LOVE** engaged for the lead at once, began to tire and lug out at the far turn. **PROUDEST HOUR** vied for the lead inside **SPEND A BUCK** for a half-mile and steadily weakened thereafter. **SECRETARY GENERAL** also vied for the lead between horses to the far turn and then was finished.
