1 1/4 MILES. (1.57%) 3rd Running of THE BREEDERS' CUP CLASSIC (Grade I). Purse \$3,000,000. 3-year-olds and upward. Weights, 3-year-olds, 122 lbs.; 4-year-olds and older, 126 lbs. Fillies and mares allowed 3 lbs. Value of race \$3,000,000. Value to winner \$1,350,000, second \$675,000, third \$324,000, fourth \$210,000, fifth \$150,000, sixth \$30,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$75,000, second \$37,500, third \$18,000. Foal, winner \$75,000, second \$37,500, third \$18,000.

Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

SKYWALKER, in hand while forcing the early pace, took over approaching the three-eighths pole and opened a clear advantage on the far turn, drew well clear in the upper stretch, responded to steady left handed pressure in the drive and held TURKOMAN safe. TURKOMAN, far back early after a good start, was fanned six wide into the stretch, gained strongly in the last furlong but could not reach the winner. PRECISIONIST, away alertly and an early pace factor, had to bide his time when boxed in around the clubhouse turn, moved up inside of HERAT early in the run down the backstretch to get near the lead between calls, dropped back a bit behind HERAT toward the end of the backstretch, could not close the gap on SKYWALKER on the far turn or in the drive but kept to his task to finish well enough for the show. NOSTALGIA'S STAR, devoid of early speed, made some late progress but could not gain the needed ground. ALPHABATIM was five wide into the stretch. TRYPTYCH lacked early foot and failed to menace. BOLD ARRANGEMENT broke a bit slowly. HOPEFUL WORD gave way after being close up early. MOGAMBO, outrun early, moved up to mildly menace into the far turn but lacked the necessary further response and was four wide into the stretch. IADES broke slowly. HERAT outsprinted rivals for the early advantage, established the pace to near the three-eighths pole, then faltered.
