1 1/4 MILES. (1.41%) 5th Running THE BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE FILLIES (Grade I). Purse \$1,000,000. Fillies 2-year-olds. Weight: 119 lbs. Value of race \$1,000,000. Value to winner \$450,000, second \$225,000, third \$108,000, fourth \$70,000, fifth \$50,000, sixth \$10,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000; Foal, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the

nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited. Total purse \$1,000,000. Value of race \$913,000; value to winner \$450,000; second \$225,000; third \$108,000; fourth \$70,000; fifth \$50,000; sixth \$10,000. Foal Awards \$43,500; Stallion Awards \$43,500. Mutuel pool \$637,429. Exacta Pool \$289,501.

OPEN MIND, unhurried while outrun to the far turn, came out between horses while moving after entering the stretch, loomed boldly from the outside leaving the furlong grounds and proved clearly best after taking over. DARBY SHUFFLE commenced to rally approaching the end of the backstretch, split horses to loom a threat with a furlong remaining and finished with good energy. LEA LUCINDA, outrun for six furlongs, raced very wide into the stretch and was going well at the finish. APPROVED TO FLY, outrun into the backstretch while saving ground, made a bid along the inside after entering the stretch but drifted out under pressure while weakening, bothering SOME ROMANCE nearing the finish. SEATTLE METEOR rallied while racing well out in the track after entering the stretch but failed to sustain her bid. SOME ROMANCE, prominent into the backstretch while racing between horses, moved to the inside of ELOQUENT MINISTER to take over nearing the stretch but weakened under pressure and was checked between horses approaching the finish. AFFIRMED CLASSIC failed to be a serious factor. SEQUAY moved up while saving ground nearing the far turn, remained a factor to the stretch and tired. STOCKS UP made a run from the outside midway of the far turn but was finished entering the stretch. COAX CHELSIE hesitated at the start. ONE OF A KLEIN, prominent until near the stretch, tired badly. ELOQUENT MINISTER raced well out from the rail while making the pace, made the pace until near the stretch and stopped suddenly. (THE 2nd HORSE IN EXACTA WAS THE 4TH FINISHER, APPROVED TO FLY.)
