Value of race \$1,000,000. Value to winner \$450,000, second \$225,000, third \$108,000, fourth \$70,000, fifth \$50,000, sixth \$10,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000; Foal winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000.

Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's award will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited. Closed With One Supplementary Nominee, BAYAKOA-AR.

B. m. by Consultant's Bid—Arlucue, by Good Manners. Trainer McAnally Ronald. Bred by Haras Principal (Arg). BAYAKOA raced outside GO FOR WAND while vying for the lead, dueling with that rival into the stretch and was going strongly when GO FOR WAND fell just inside the final sixteenth leaving her alone on the lead. COLONIAL WATERS raced forwardly until near the stretch and bested the others without menacing the winner. VALAY MAID, wide into the stretch, passed tired horses. MISTAUROIAN showed some early foot but was finished soon after going a half. LUTHIER'S LAUNCH, outrun into the stretch while saving ground, swerved to avoid the spill. FLAGS WAVING was always outrun. GO FOR WAND reached the front along the inside just before going a quarter, remained slightly out from the rail while making it into the stretch and was narrowly in front when she broke down and fell just inside the final sixteenth. There was a stewards inquiry involving the fall before the result was made official.
