Value of race \$1,000,000. Value to winner \$450,000, second \$225,000, third \$108,000, fourth \$70,000, fifth \$50,000, sixth \$10,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000; Foal, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500,

third \$6,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

STEINLEN had a very rough trip, was well handled but he and HIGHLANDS SPRINGS layed on each other in the run to the first turn and then again along the backstretch, lost position on second turn, was between rivals in early stretch, moved to the inside in front of QUICK CALL in midstretch causing that one to check, took over from SIMPLY MAJESTIC inside the final sixteenth and proved best. SABONA, unhurried early, moved to contention after a half, advanced slowly along the outside in the stretch run and was gaining on the winner at the finish. MOST WELCOME steadily improved position, was checked on second turn losing good position, then was gaining ground steadily at the finish. ROYAL TOUCH, unhurried to the second turn, rallied very well approaching the head of the stretch, then was checked in early stretch to avoid QUICK CALL'S heels, then finished well when clear. SIMPLY MAJESTIC vied for command early with QUICK CALL, opened a clear lead on second turn, then gave way to the winner inside the final sixteenth. ZILZAL was allowed to leave the paddock early and did not participate in post parade, was sweating profusely in warm weather and was reluctant to go to gate, delaying the start for a few minutes, failed to break alertly; improved position to midstretch then could not appreciably gain. HIGHLAND SPRINGS made contact with STEINLEN in the run to the first turn and again along the backstretch while in sharp contention, reached the attending position on second turn, then weakened inside the final eighth. QUICK CALL vied for command early, remained along the inside in contention then was taken up sharply in midstretch when STEINLEN cut in front of him. IN EXTREMIS bore out on first turn, then dropped back on second turn. LITTLE BOLD JOHN had some early speed. GREEN LINE EXPRESS was in sharp contention to the head of the stretch, then dropped back quickly.
