STEINLEN, reserved early, moved up along the inside racing into the far turn, came out between horses to continue his rally nearing the stretch and outgamed SIMPLY MAJESTIC for the place. SIMPLY MAJESTIC raced in closest attendance to MASTER CHRISTO-PHER, made a run between horses on the far turn, dueled for the lead until inside the final furlong and weakened. NICCOLO POLO, never far back, moved boldly from the outside to gain a narrow lead nearing the stretch but tired during the drive. MOHAMED ABDU, well placed into the backstretch, was steadied slightly while moving between horses on the far turn and gave way readily. POSEN, fractious in the gate, was never close. RAVINELLA saved ground to no avail. BET TWICE was always outrun. MILL NATIVE failed to be a serious factor. BLUSHING JOHN was always outrun. WARNING had no apparent excuse. MASTER CHRISTOPHER stopped badly after showing speed until near the stretch.
