GOODBYE HALO moved to the outside of WINNING COLORS while racing forwardly into the backtretch, remained a factor to the stretch and continued on gamely while drifting out slightly into PERSONAL ENSIGN during the late stages. SHAM SAY edged out into PERSONAL ENSIGN racing to the first turn, remained well out from the rail while racing fowardly to the upper stretch and gave way. CLASSIC CROWN, outrun for six furlongs, moved a little closer along the inside nearing midstretch but lacked a further response. HAIL A CAB was always outrun. EPITOME saved ground to no avail. WILLA ON THE MOVE tired badly while racing wide. INTEGRA showed brief speed while racing wide.
