PRIZED, well placed early along the outside, was rated along nicely for over a mile, rallied approaching the head of the stretch, closed through the final eighth with SIERRA ROBERTA and bested that one to the finish. SIERRA ROBERTA steadily improved position, was checked while racing along the inside after the mile, remained inside, rallied with the winner through the final eighth and just missed. STAR LIFT raced along the outside in a good position, responded to pressure approaching the head of the stretch, reached sharp contention in midstretch and continued to gain to the finish. BEHERA, never far back, rallied at the head of the stretch and was gaining ground slowly to the finish. CALTECH allowed ILE DE CHYPRE to take the early lead, stalked the pace, gained command turning into the stretch, then weakened a sixteenth out. PLEASANT VARIETY, unhurried for over a mile, improved position in the stretch run. EL SENOR, taken in hand at the start, failed to respond to pressure in the drive. GREEN BARB was in sharp contention for a mile and one-quarter, was checked at the head of the stretch, then steadily gave ground. ILE DE CHYPRE, rank early while setting the pace, continued on well to inside the final eighth, then faltered. MILESIUS improved position slowly to the head off the stretch, then weakened, SCENIC, racing between rivals, had traffic problems after a mile, then steadily fell back. LADY IN SILVER was a factor from the inside for a mile, then gave way. HODGES BAY showed little. SUNSHINE FOREVER was never prominent.
