IN THE WINGS, unhurried early, raced well back while between horses for a half, gradually worked his way forward along the backstretch, was shuffled back slightly when blocked behind a wall of horses on the far turn, regained stride rapidly and closed ground between horses to reach contention midway on the turn, responded to strong handling and drew alongside WITH APPROVAL to challenge nearing the sixteenth pole then edged clear under brisk urging in the final seventy yards. WITH APPROVAL was content to settle well off the pace after breaking in the air slightly at the start, angled to the outside along the backstretch, made a strong run outside CACOETHES to challenge midway on the turn, surged to the front approaching the top of the stretch, shook off CACOETHES to gain a clear advantage in upper stretch, fought it out gamely inside the winner through the final furlong then yielded grudgingly while drifting out in the late stages. EL SENOR, under a snug hold early, gradually worked his way forward while racing wide along the backstretch, continued five wide advancing into the stretch then finished willingly in the middle of the track to best the others. ALWUHUSH, up close early, dropped back slightly on the far turn, responded when roused and made a mild run from the outside to reach contention nearing the top of the stretch then lacked a strong closing bid. SAUMAREZ raced in close contention along the rail for six furlongs, steadied sharply along the inside leaving the far turn then failed to seriously threaten thereafter. COLCHIS ISLAND, reserved for a half, rallied boldly to gain a narrow advantage on the far turn then gradully tired thereafter. FRENCH GLORY raced within striking distance while between horses for much of the trip and faded in the stretch, PLEASANT TAP saved ground and tired. CACOETHES set the pace along the inside for a little more than a mile and gave way. SHY TOM was never close. SKY CLASSIC was used up pressing the early pace.
