Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through E.B.F. PROUD TRUTH, unhurried while outrun for six furlongs, circled horses leaving the far turn, loomed boldly a furlong out and responded gamely to wear down **GATE DANCER**. The latter made a run from the outside leaving the far turn, gained a clear lead near the final furlong and held on stubbornly. **TURKOMAN**, steadied while moving along the inside on the far turn, came out for room entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. **CHIEF'S CROWN**, reserved into the backstretch, made a bold run between horses nearing the stretch but was finished with a furlong remaining. **TRACK BARRON** hustled to the front soon after the start, saved ground while showing speed to the stretch but had nothing left for the drive. **IMPERIAL CHOICE** moved fast from the outside to gain a brief advantage nearing the stretch but tired badly during the drive. **VANLANDINGHAM** moved to the outside of **TRACK BARRON** when outrun for the lead going to the first turn, remained prominent for a mile, then gave way readily when steadied when between **TRACK BARRON** and **CHIEF'S CROWN** entering the stretch. **BOUNDING BASQUE** had no apparent excuse.
