ROYAL DELTA within striking distance three wide, moved out a path into the second turn, tucked in a bit after six furlongs to follow ASK THE MOON entering the stretch, angled to the outside for the drive and closed with good energy to be clear. IT'S TRICKY close up along the inside, came out between rivals leaving the second turn, made a run a the leader with a furlong to go, gained a short lead near the sixteenth marker, was no match for the winner late but was second best. PACHATTACK within striking distance along the inside, maintained good position into the stretch, came off the rail for the drive but had no late bid. ULTRA BLEND fractious in the gate, was outrun three wide, moved out a path entering the stretch when rallying and made a late gain on the outside. PLUM PRETTY sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace along the inside, led to the final furlong and faltered. ASK THE MOON closest to the early pace three wide, angled in a bit on the backstretch, moved closer to the pace approaching the stretch but tired in the drive. SUPER ESPRESSO outsprinted early three wide, stayed in that path on the second turn and could not threaten. SATANS QUICK CHICK drifted in at the start, steadied entering the first turn then was no factor. MISS MATCH (ARG) fought restraint into the first turn, was reserved for a half and faded.
