Fillies and mares allowed 3 lbs. Value of race \$1,000,000. Value to winner \$450,000, second \$225,000, third \$108,000, fourth \$70,000, fifth \$50,000, sixth \$10,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000; Foal, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited. Supplementary Nominor: ROUSILLON

COZZENE, never far back, made a run from the outside leaving the far turn, caught AL MAMOON just inside the final furlong and drew clear under pressure. PALACE MUSIC raced wide into the stretch while moving, lugged in leaving the furlong grounds interfering with TSUNAMI SLEW and ROUSILLON and continued on gamely to gain the place. PALACE MUSIC was disqualified and placed ninth following a stewards inquiry. AL MAMOON quickly sprinted clear, saved ground while making the pace into the stretch and weakened during the drive. SHADEED, prominent to the final furlong, lacked the needed rally. DR. SCHWARTZMAN, steadied along the inside on the far turn, finished well while being forced to steady again just prior to the finish. TSUNAMI SLEW dropped back along the inside on the backstretch, came out on the far turn and was moving between horses when impeded by PALACE MUSIC during the drive. THE NOBLE PLAYER failed to be a serious factor. LATE ACT was without speed. ROUSILLON off slowly, was blocked attempting to split horses nearing the end of the backstretch, raced within easy striking distance to the upper stretch and was weakening when bothered. NEVER SO BOLD lacked room racing to the first turn. SITZMARK tired. FORZANDO II was finished leaving the far turn. CHAPEL COTTAGE was taken up along the inside on the first turn, moved up when clear approaching the far turn, but was finished nearing the stretch. CAPTURE HIM raced wide.
