VERY SUBTLE sprinted to the front before going a quarter after getting away in alert fashion, quickly drew away in the upper stretch and remained well clear through the final furlong while under a drive. GROOVY pressed the early pace from along the inner rail after a good start, could not keep pace with VERY SUBTLE in the drive but held on well enough to gain the place. EXCLUSIVE ENOUGH, never far back, came into the stretch four wide and could not gain the necessary ground in the drive. ZABALETA, outrun early after veering out and being jostled and checked in the initial strides, mildly menaced from the inside early in the drive but flattened out. HIGH BRITE, in close contention early, lacked the needed response in the last quarter. TAYLOR'S SPECIAL was wide down the backstretch and six wide into the stretch. SYLVAN EXPRESS, devoid of early speed after breaking slowly and being jostled and shuffled back in the opening strides, found his best stride too late. ZANY TACTICS, outrun early, entered the stretch five wide and lacked the needed response when called upon. ON THE LINE bobbled at the start to get away slowly. PINE TREE LANE, off alertly and prominent early, gave way. SHARP ROMANCE broke slowly and was jostled and shuffled back in the initial strides. GOVERNOR GENERAL broke a bit awkwardly and was six wide into the stretch. SABONA (1) WAS WITHDRAWN. ALL WAGERS ON HIM IN THE REGULAR AND DAILY DOUBLE POOLS WERE ORDERED REFUNDED AND ALL OF HIS PICK NINE SELECTIONS WERE SWITCHED TO THE FAVORITE, GROOVY (2).
