**6 FURLONGS. (1.07%) 7th Running THE BREEDERS' CUP SPRINT (Grade I). Purse \$1,000,000. 3-year-olds and upward. Weights: 3-year-olds, 123 lbs. Older, 126 lbs. Fillies and mares allowed, 3 lbs. Value of race \$1,000,000. Value to winner \$450,000, second \$225,000, third \$108,000, fourth \$70,000, fifth \$50,000, sixth \$10,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500, third \$6,000; Foal, winner \$25,000, second \$12,500,**

third \$6,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited.

SAFELY KEPT, away alertly, saved ground while showing speed to the stretch, was headed inside the final furlong, then continued on with good courage to prevail when DAYJUR jumped a shadow approaching the finish. DAYJUR quickly reached contention after failing to break alertly, engaged SAFELY KEPT from the outside midway of the turn, dueled with that rival into the stretch and appeared the winner when he jumped a shadow about 40 yards from the finish and again just before the wire. BLACK TIE AFFAIR raced well out in the track into the stretch but failed to seriously menace while making up ground late. ADJUDICATING, outrun early while saving ground, came out for the drive and passed tired horses. PROSPECTORS GAMBLE rallied approaching the final furlong but lacked the needed late response. DANCING SPREE, without speed, raced eight wide into the stretch and failed to be a serious factor. DARGAI saved ground to no avail. CORWYN BAY was bothered when MR. NICKERSON fell in front of him. SENOR SPEEDY swerved to avoid MR. NICKERSON at the turn and failed to reach contention. CARSON CITY gave way leaving the turn. GLITTERMAN, sent up outside horses early was finished after going a half. POTENTIALITY was finished early, SHAKER KNIT fell over MR. NICKERSON, racing into the turn. MR. NICKERSON fell when in distress nearing the turn.
