1 1/4 MILES. (1.59%) 5th Running THE BREEDERS' CUP CLASSIC (Grade I). Purse \$3,000,000. 3-year-olds and upward. Weight: 3-year-olds 122 lbs. Older 126 lbs. Fillies and mares allowed 3 lbs. Value of race \$3,000,000. Value to winner \$1,350,000, second \$675,000, third \$324,000, fourth \$210,000, fifth \$150,000, sixth \$30,000. Nominator Awards: Stallion, winner \$75,000, second \$37,500, third \$18,000; Foal, winner \$75,000, second \$37,500, third \$18,000. Stallion awards will be paid only to the nominators of fully eligible stallions. Owners who supplement horses to Breeders' Cup Day races will be eligible for the Foal Nominator's Award in the case of a 12 per cent supplementary nomination or both the Foal Nominator's Award and the Stallion Nominator's Award in the case of a 20 per cent supplementary nomination. In accordance with the Breeders' Cup/European Breeders' Fund cross-registration agreement, nominator's awards will not be paid to horses eligible through the E.B.F. All unpaid nominator's awards will remain the property of Breeders' Cup Limited. Closed with 2 supplementary nominations, Waquoit, Cutlass Reality. Total purse \$3,000,000. Value of race \$2,739,000; value to winner \$1,350,000; second \$675,000; third \$324,000; fourth \$210,000; fifth \$150,000; sixth \$30,000. Foal Awards \$130,500. Stallion Awards \$112,500. \$18,000 reverts to Breeders' Cup Ltd. Mutuel Pool \$1,214,403. Exacta Pool \$603,254.

ALYSHEBA bumped lightly with LIVELY ONE after the start, then was allowed to follow the leaders, moved up approaching the end of the backstretch, angled out to continue his rally nearing the stretch, caught WAQUOIT near the final furlong and turned back SEEKING THE GOLD under strong handling. The latter, unhurried while outrun into the backstretch, moved up outside horses around the far turn, loomed boldly a furlong out and fought it out gamely. WAQUOIT raced well out from the rail while making the pace, held a narrow advantage into the stretch but weakened during the late stages. FORTY NINER moved within striking distance along the inside approaching the end of the backstretch, swung out after dropping back around the far turn, then passed tired horses. CRYPTOCLEARANCE, outrun for six furlongs, advanced between horses approaching the stretch but failed to sustain his bid. PERSONAL FLAG, unhurried while outrun into the backstretch, moved to the inside to loom boldly leaving the far turn but gave way under pressure. CUTLASS REALITY, never far back, came out to make a run approaching the stretch but tired during the drive. LIVELY ONE bumped lightly with ALYSHEBA after the start, was outrun early, moved up along the inside approaching the stretch but lacked a further response. SLEW CITY SLEW went right after WAQUOIT, raced outside that rival while prompting the pace to the far turn, then stopped suddenly and was not persevered with.
